Top three in each bracket get overall awards. Teams play other teams in their bracket only.

Friday teams

6 rds. / 8 bds. Min. groups of 7; balanced based on entries and field strength. Top

bracket may be handicapped.

• Sunday teams <sup>2</sup>Eight is Enough

7 rds. / 7 bds. Min. groups of 8; balanced from bottom (top group may be larger). Team members assigned points based on individual masterpoints: 0-499 = 1; 500-

1999 = 2; 2000 + = 3. No team may exceed 8 total points.
