

# 2♠ Opening Showing a Minor Suit preempt

**Rating: Minimum 6 boards per segment/round**

## Defense:

Double = 13-15 HCP, or good 18+ HCP, balanced or unbalanced.

*Note: No direct bid for a 3-suiter exists, usually pass and make a takeout double later. However, with an 18+ 3-suiter, double directly to guard against a pass of 2♠*

2NT = 16-18  
Responses as to a 2NT opening

3♣ = Majors (5-4 or 5-5)  
3♦ asks for 5-card suit or bid singleton with 5-5 and extras

3♦ = Hearts.  
3♥ = To Play  
4♣ = Cue bid

3♥ = Spades.  
3♠ = To Play  
4♣ = Cue bid

3♠ = Shaped hand with minor  
3NT = To play.  
4♣ = Pass or correct to 4♦.  
4♦ = Asks for minor.  
4♥ = clubs  
4♠ = diamonds.

3NT = Natural, to play (running minor suit, with stopper)

After 2♠ - Double – Pass (Showing spades)

Bid as after a takeout double of a weak 2♠.

After 2♠ - Double – 3♣/3♦:

Pass = Non-forcing on a 13-15 HCP doubler.  
Double = Responsive.  
Suit = Natural and invitational.  
4♣/4♦ = Cuebid.

After 2♠ - Double - 3♣/3♦ - Pass - Pass: or 2♠ - Double - Pass - Pass - 3♣/3♦:  
Double = 18+ HCP

Suit = Natural, 18+ HCP.  
Cue bid = 3-suiter, short in their suit, 18+ HCP.

After 2♠ - Pass - 3♣/3♦ - Pass - Pass or 2♠ - Pass - 2NT/3♣ - Pass - 3♣/3♦:  
Double = Takeout of suit doubled, 11-17 HCP.

After 2♠ - Pass - Pass:

All bids are the same as in immediate position except that point count is a bit lower. Similar continuations apply.

After 2♠ - Pass - 2NT:

Bid as to a 2NT which shows a minor preempt.

After 2♠ - Pass - natural suit:

Bid as to an opening 3-bid.

After 2♠ - Pass - 3 or 4 of minor (pass or correct):

Double = Takeout

Suits = Natural.
