LEAGUE COUNSEL REPORT

SPENCER V. ACBL

Facts

On February 28, 2012 Cynthia Spenser and Richard Spencer filed a lawsuit in Providence, Rhode Island Superior Court against the League, Marriott and various other persons and entities, claiming that she was injured in a fall at a bridge tournament "operated" by the League. In fact, the tournament was a 2009 Massachusetts Regional operated by the District 25. District 25 is not currently listed as a defendant. Insurance counsel in Providence, Rhode Island has been appointed to represent the ACBL.

Insurance counsel reports that "...it does not appear that plaintiff has any documentation that would support a theory against the insured [the ACBL]. Further, counsel will file jurisdictional motions to dismiss the matter from the Rhode Island Superior Court based on the facts that the plaintiff is a Massachusetts resident, the League is a New York corporation, based in Mississippi, and the tournament was held in Massachusetts. Insurance counsel has filed a Motion to Dismiss with the Rhode Island Superior Court and is awaiting the Judge's decision.

<u>Status</u>

The Judge has requested additional information before he makes his decision on the Motion to Dismiss. In the meantime, defendant has submitted interrogatories to the League.
