College Bridge Tournament To Do List

- 1. HAVE FUN!!! Mistakes are not the end of the world
- 2. Bring your computer, not phone to play on.
- 3. Bring a charger for your computer
- 4. Disable any notifications on your computer for any apps that include texting, voice, or phone calls. Shut down all background apps that may cause a popup.
- 5. If you bring a phone, it must be completely turned off.
- 6. Bring something to drink and/or eat
- 7. At the beginning of each round, greet the opponents with a short message (names, basic system like for example "Hi opps 2/1 UDCA 4th best leads Chip and Mandy from Faber College."
- 8. If they don't have a convention card and don't greet you with their bidding and carding system before playing the first board, ask them to kindly provide that info.
- 9. If you need a bathroom break and it can't wait until a round is complete, call the director and message "urgent bathroom break brb"
- 10. Refrain from discussing hands during or between hands.
- 11. Use the alert section to self alert Jacoby and Texas transfer bids, reverse Bergen, your NT range even if it is 15-17, and any other alertable calls.
- 12. If an opponent questions a bid, don't name the convention if there is one, but simply explain the bid. (e.g. responding 5D to partner's 4NT bid ... simply response 1 or 4 keycards)
- 13. When they ask about leads or carding, don't answer "standard", but be descriptive ("4th best" or "UDCA", for example)
- 14. Remember, that the opponents bids may not mean the same thing as yours, simply click on their bid and await an explanation.
