

Changes in Code of Disciplinary Regulations November, 2006

2.1.2 A District has jurisdiction over:

- (a) Persons participating in a sanctioned event or other activity sponsored by a Unit, District or ACBL held within its geographical boundaries (District Disciplinary Committee).
- (b) ~~Those residing within the District,~~ Decisions of a tournament disciplinary committee from a tournament held in the district's geographical area, a member unit's disciplinary committee and the district's disciplinary committee and the charged person or persons in each for appellate purposes only (District Appellate Committee).
- (c) Cases involving alleged violations by Units referred to in CDR 9.1 (District Disciplinary Committee).

Discussion: As written, 2.1.2 (b) conflicted with 7.1.1. Additionally, there needed to be a section giving the district disciplinary committee jurisdiction over units to comply with 9.1. See 2.2.3 (c) for jurisdiction over Districts in 9.2 cases.
