CHANGES TO CDR March 2006

At its first meeting subsequent to an ACBL Management decision to impose discipline, the Appeals and Charges Committee shall make an automatic review of the decision discipline imposed by ACBL Management. Such reviews shall be consistent with the procedures at appellate review, except that the accused party shall be entitled to present evidence and witnesses at the review hearing.

Discussion:

It was determined that, after an investigation, to have an automatic review of a decision exonerating a person or a decision to warn (which is not considered discipline) was unnecessary. The only review is of a discipline imposed by Management.
