**Flights:**

A: Open to any player, B: 0–2500, and C: Non-Life Master < 500 as of the June 2024 masterpoint cycle. The June 2024 masterpoint cycle is run by ACBL data processing on May 6, 2024. Any points won but not included in this cycle do not affect masterpoint eligibility.

**Flight A: Open**

District Final will be held in Charlotte, NC, Saturday, September 21, 2024, 10:00 and 2:30 p.m.

National Final in Memphis TN, Spring NABC, Mar. 13 & 14 (dates subject to change).

The top three highest overall percentage pairs will qualify for the NABC NAP Finals. District Final participation and table counts will determine if a fourth pair will also be selected.

**Flight B: 0–2500**

District Final will be held in Charlotte, NC, Sunday, September 22, 2024, 10:00 a.m. and 2:30. The top four pairs in Flight B and C will receive an invitation to the NABC Final in Memphis, TN, Mar 21-22 (dates subject to change).

### **Flight C: Non-Life Master <500**

District Final will be held in Charlotte, NC, Saturday, September 21, 2024, 10:00 am & 2:30 pm. Flight C players remain eligible to enter Flight B district competition. The top four pairs in Flight C will receive an invitation to the NABC Final in Memphis, TN, Mar 21-22 (dates subject to change).

### **Conventions Authorized:**

**Clubs:** Individual club decision

### **District Finals:**

Flight A, Open +

Flight B and C: Basic + in B and Basic + in C.

### **Special Qualification:**

At the Club level, when 4 or fewer pairs enter a scheduled qualifying event, all players who pay their entry fee are qualified to District Final.

### **Club Qualifying Strata:**

Open, 0–2500, and NLM< 500 mandatory... except a standalone NLM < 500 event, which may be stratified at club's discretion, but only those who qualify in the NLM< 500 strata will become qualified for Flight C.

Each player who finishes 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup> will receive a subsidy to defray travel costs while attending in person the NABC National Finals. You will receive this after providing proof of NABC NAP event participation. If the event is cancelled and played online, no money will be given to play online by District 7.

### **The subsidy is as follows:**

**1st Place:** Qualifiers will receive \$700.00 per person from ACBL & \$ 200.00 from District 7.

**2nd Place:** Qualifiers will receive \$700.00 per person from ACBL & \$ 200.00 from District 7.

**3rd Place:** Qualifiers will receive \$300.00 per person from ACBL & \$600.00 from District 7.

**4<sup>th</sup> Place:** Qualifiers will be invited to participate in the national level finals, and will not receive money from ACBL but \$900.00 from District 7.

No individual may collect two concurrent subsidies.

**Multiple Flight Qualifications:**

Any player who qualifies to represent District 7 in multiple Flights in the National Finals must decide in which Flight they will compete no later than Tuesday December 11, 2024, via email to the District NAP Coordinator: [LeeWebb1@sc.rr.com](mailto:LeeWebb1@sc.rr.com)

You are expected to notify the District NAP Coordinator on or before Monday, January 14, 2025, if you are unable to attend the National Final. Pairs who fail to comply may be subject to District Disciplinary action and/or denied future District subsidies.
