

Award Subsidies*

Travel subsidies are awarded to players who place in the top 2 places in each flight of the District Final. Travel subsidies will be paid to players who actually attend the NABC Final. If a partnership chooses not to attend the NABC Final, the awarded subsidy will be passed down to a lower-placing qualifier.

Additionally, there will be no entry fee for the national level of the nap event in all flights. That is, all entry fees for the NABC Final are paid for by the ACBL.

Championship flight (no masterpoint limitations) with Open+ convention charts – if a pair is playing methods requiring written defense, these need to be submitted at registration.

- 1st place – \$700 US per player subsidy from ACBL for travel to spring NABC in Dallas, TX
- 2nd place – \$300 US per player subsidy from ACBL for travel plus a \$CAD top up from District 2
- 3rd place – qualification to national finals at spring NABC in Dallas, TX, no travel subsidy

Flight A (under 6000 MP) with Open convention charts

- 1st place – \$700 US per player subsidy from ACBL for travel to spring NABC in Dallas, TX
- 2nd place – \$300 US per player subsidy from ACBL for travel plus a \$CAD top up from District 2
- 3rd place – qualification to national finals at spring NABC in Dallas, TX, no travel subsidy

Flight B (under 3000 MP) with Basic+ convention charts

- 1st place – \$700 US per player subsidy from ACBL for travel to spring NABC in Dallas, TX
- 2nd place – \$300 US per player subsidy from ACBL for travel plus a \$CAD top up from District 2
- 3rd place – qualification to national finals at spring NABC in Dallas, TX, no travel subsidy
- 4th place – qualification to national finals at spring NABC in Dallas, TX, no travel subsidy

Flight C (NLM under 750) with Basic+ convention charts

- 1st place – \$700 US per player subsidy from ACBL for travel to spring NABC in Dallas, TX
- 2nd place – \$300 US per player subsidy from ACBL for travel plus a \$CAD top up from District 2
- 3rd place – qualification to national finals at spring NABC in Dallas, TX, no travel subsidy
- 4th place – qualification to national finals at spring NABC in Dallas, TX, no travel subsidy

Tie-Break: If there is a tie between two or more pairs in a district final, the score of these pairs will be recalculated to determine the pair that finishes before the other. For comparable boards, the calculations will be as follows: +1 for a win, +½ for a tie, 0 for a loss.
