

## Atlanta NABC –Parking Options and MARTA

There are numerous surface parking lots near the Marriott Marquis with rates generally at \$12, as well as an early bird rate of \$8 if you're in by 8:30 am. Some of the lots closest to the Marquis are listed below.

- 207 Peachtree Center Avenue, NE
- 36 John Portman Blvd., NE
- 226 Courtland Street, NE
- 127 Andrew Young International Blvd., NW

### **MARTA (Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority)**

Taking MARTA is a more leisurely way to get to and from the Marriott, and is the preferred method of transportation to the NABC by many local bridge players.

**Free daily parking** is available at most of the MARTA stations.

There is also long-term parking for \$5 or \$8 at nine MARTA stations. The stations with long-term parking include: North Springs, Sandy Springs, Dunwoody, Doraville, Brookhaven, Lenox, Lindbergh Center, Kensington and College Park.

A one-way fare on MARTA is \$2.50 plus a one-time fee for a Breeze card. The fare can be purchased at the train station. The trains run every 12 minutes during the week (10 minutes during rush hour) and every 20 minutes on the weekends, until 1:00 am.

Peachtree Center is the closest MARTA station to the Marriott and is on the red and gold lines. When you exit the train, you can walk to the hotel via the street level or through the Peachtree Center food court through an aerial walkway to the hotel. Each is about a 6-7 minute walk.
