### Canadians win NAOP-A

Two British Columbia residents, representing District 19, led throughout the North American Open Pairs-A and won their first NABC championship by more than a board.

Gordon McOrmond, Delta BC computer consultant, and Aidan Ballantyne, an environmental consultant from Vancouver BC, scored 432.18 to 417.50 for runners-up JoAnna and Lew Stansby, District 21 representatives.

McOrmond and Ballantyne -- who formed a partnership "just for this event," said McOrmond -- led all the way from the club, unit and district level to the national final.

"Our defense was really steady," said Ballantyne, "but we got a bit lucky in the bidding."

Play in the NAOP-A -- a grassroots event that began last summer at the local club level -- began Wednesday.

Qualifiers at the club level advanced to unit competition and those qualifiers advanced to district finals. At least two pairs from each district qualified for the North American final.

## 8 bridge greats inducted into ACBL Hall of Fame

Eight all-time bridge greats entered the ACBL Hall of Fame at the annual Hall of Fame banquet last night. Four previously elected Hall of Fame members were present -- Edgar Kaplan, Norman Kay, Bobby Wolff and Al Roth.

Lee Hazen was entered as the winner of the Blackwood Award for services to bridge other than at the bridge table -- although Hazen actually was a fine player as well.

David Bruce, Life Master #1, was entered as the winner of the von Zedtwitz Award for his extensive contributions to the game of bridge.

The three present-day players now in the Hall are Edith Freilich, George Rapee and Bill Root.

The three players honored posthumously were Lew Mathe, Jim Jacoby and Richard Frey.

For the third straight year, David Ezekiel of Bermuda did a magnificent job as master of ceremonies. He kept the festivities going at a reasonable rate so that the attendees could easily make the various Charity games.

Alan Truscott, the presenter for Frey, told of Frey's outstanding work in bridge as a writer, an editor, a public

Winners in flights A and B will have their names inscribed on the Baldwin Memorial Trophy and will also receive certificates of recognition.

The trophy is presented in memory of Col. Russell J. Baldwin (1889-1969), U.S. Army officer and expert on tournament procedure who was ACBL *Honorary Member of the Year* in 1943.

One of the leading American bridge personalities, he was active as an organizer from the earliest days of contract bridge and became a director and treasurer of the American Bridge League shortly after its foundation in 1927.

A member of the ACBL Laws Commission (originally Committee) from its foundation in 1933, Baldwin was primarily responsible for the first Duplicate Code issued in 1935. He played a considerable part in formulating subsequent codes.

He was the author of the McKenney-Baldwin schedules for Howell movements and constructed other movements.

His contributions to tournament procedure include the official ACBL method of dealing with fouled boards.

Baldwin was active as a tournament director from 1927 until 1941. After service in World War II, he was ACBL business manager from 1946 until 1951.

He was recalled to military service at the outbreak of the Korean War and retired from the U. S. Army in 1957. He rejoined ACBL in 1958 and was in charge of tournament scheduling until his retirement in 1963.

relations expert, a commentator and a player. He also told how he first met Frey and what happened as a result.

"In 1960 I was working hard at my writing duties at the World Team Olympiad, and apparently Frey was impressed because he invited me to dinner. Later he asked me to ghostwrite some of his columns. Then 18 months later he asked me to come to work on the ACBL Bulletin. I accepted his offer and my major task while I worked for the ACBL was to edit the first edition of the *Encyclopedia of Bridge*."

Frey, Life Master #8, was editor of the ACBL *Bulletin* for 12 years, and after he retired he served for 11 years as president of the International Bridge Press Association.

His daughter Penny and her husband Peter were among the attendees.

Jim Jacoby was presented by two of his former teammates on the Aces -- Bobby Wolff and Bob Hamman.

Wolff told how he met Jacoby back in the Fifties and how well they worked as a partnership. Lots of folks think the Jacoby Shuffle has something to do with getting cards ready to deal, but Wolff knows better. "That's the dance that Jim did after he won an event," said Wolff.

"Jim was a gracious loser, but he didn't have to be gracious often because he seldom lost. Above all else he was a winner."

Hamman called Jacoby "a very tough partner -- I'm glad he was on my side." Hamman told of the day Jacoby dropped in on him after Bob had had a tough day. "He suggested that we play some backgammon, and he won enough that night to help finance his new grandson's education."

Included among the family members present was four-month-old Jake Jacoby, Jim's grandson. Also present were his wife Judy, his son Jim and Jim's wife Vicki, his brother Jon and Jon's wife Caroline.

Judy took the microphone to say how happy she was that her late husband was being inducted in his home town of Dallas. "And Jim's grandson will be so happy in later years when he learns that he was there when his grandfa-

ther was inducted into the Hall of Fame."

Hamman also was the presenter for Mathe, one of the fiercest competitors of all time. "Two players dominated bridge in the West when I started playing in the Sixties -- Lew Mathe and Meyer Schleifer. I learned a lot from Lew.

"Lew was the Ty Cobb of bridge -- mean, tough, a relentless competitor. He's the toughest player I've ever seen."

"Can a semipro pitcher make it to the Hall of Fame?" queried Virgil Anderson, presenter for Hazen. "Yes he can -- as long as it's the Bridge Hall of Fame." Anderson pointed out that Hazen actually first broached the idea of a Hall of Fame way back in the Sixties.

"Hazen played bridge through six decades," said Anderson. "One time he won a cruise to South America -- but he and his wife Sylvia didn't go -- Hazen didn't have enough money to buy Sylvia a cruise outfit."

Mathe was a major stabilizing influence for bridge in the Forties, when many problems assailed the infant organization. He served as League counsel for 44 years and was a member of the ACBL Laws Commission for 31 years. No family members were present, but Ezekiel read a letter from his son and grandson.

Mike Passell, presenter for David Bruce, actually never met Bruce. Bruce was one of the early stars of the game, and he actually became Life Master #1. "He appointed himself and no one challenged," said Passell. Bruce was a member of the Four Aces team and he also was a successful bridge author. In his early years of play, David was known as David Bernstein.

Edgar Kaplan heaped lavish praise on Freilich as he presented her for induction. "Putting her in the Hall of Fame is an honor for the Hall," he said. "Edith is a lady in all respects except bridge -- in bridge she's like a mensch. She's an adventurous bidder -- you never know what's going to happen next. Edith graces the game and the Hall."

Freilich told how completely thrilled she is to be in the Hall. "I really appreciate it," she said.

Al Roth took a somewhat different approach in presenting George Rapee -- he talked at length about two other inductees -- Freilich and Root. "Edith and Bill are part of my family. Bill always was a wonderful partner."

Roth said everybody always forgot about Rapee. "He didn't like to discuss theory -- he was a practical player who was a winner from the word GO." Rapee was a member of the team that won the first Bermuda Bowl in 1950 -- altogether he has three Bermuda Bowls to his credit. And George is still playing winning bridge 47 years later.

Roth was thoroughly enjoying talking about his friends, but Ezekiel's job was to keep the show moving. He went to the stage and laid his hand on Roth's arm. "Am I talking too long?" asked Roth, and he immediately left the rostrum with a smile.

Rapee told of his long-time addiction to bridge. "You meet your best friends through bridge," he said.

Wolff returned to the microphone to present Root. "How do you classify Bill Root?" asked Wolff. "Superior player? Compassionate partner? Secure individual? actively ethical player? One thing's for sure -- he is the most successful teacher, and perhaps the best."

When Root took the stage, he recalled, "When I started playing 45 years ago, George was already a world champion and the bridge world was debating whether Edith or Helen Sobel was the best woman player in the world. And now I'm here with them as we join the Hall of Fame -- it's a major honor and quite a thrill."

He told about his association with Al Morehead. "He started me on my career as a writer."

His favorite partner is Richard Pavlicek. "We've been playing together for 22 years, and he's my favorite partner of all time."

### The Alert strip

It is ACBL policy to have players tap the Alert strip and say Alert out loud at the same time. When an announcement is made, once again the player should tap the Alert strip.

When using spoken bidding, players are required to announce and Alert aloud.

If there is some reluctance about complying, players should summon a tournament director rather than get into a hassle with an opponent.

## Dallas parking

**Valet parking:** Valet parking is available at the hotel entrance. The 24-hour rate, usually \$12, has been reduced to \$7 for bridge players. In and out permitted for hotel guests.



**Annex parking:** Located at the intersection of Hotel Street and Reunion Boulevard. \$6 per day maximum. No in and out.

**Union Station:** Union Station parking is connected to the Hyatt Regency Dallas by underground tunnel. \$5 per day maximum. No in and out.

**Reunion arena:** Entrance is at the intersection of Sports Street and Reunion Boulevard. \$2 per day, but may be adjusted for special Reunion Arena activities. No in and out.

## DART information

Step outside the Hyatt Regency and you can catch a Dallas Light Rail train, part of the Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART) system.

Reduced rates are available for rides that begin and end downtown: 50 cents for a single trip, \$1 for a round trip.

Cash is not accepted but tickets or passes may be purchased at vending machines in the stations.

The Light Rail runs from 5:30 a.m. until 12:30 a.m. seven days a week. From 6 a.m. to 9 a.m., the Light Rail trains arrive every 5 to 10 minutes; from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., every 10 to 20 minutes; from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m., every 5 to 10 minutes, and from 6 p.m. to 12:30 a.m., every 10 to 20 minutes.

## Adolphus Hotel Shuttle

Guests staying at the Adolphus are being offered complimentary shuttle service from 8:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and from 10:30 p.m. to 1:00 a.m. The shuttle will leave approximately on the hour and half hour from the Adolphus at 15 and 45 minutes past the hour. Departure point from the Adolphus is at the corner of Commerce and Field and from the Hyatt is at the base of Reunion Tower (side entrance of the hotel). Guests who would like to return to the Adolphus between sessions may check with the bellstand to arrange a ride in the hotel's car. Arrangements should be made in advance and are based on availability.

## Check cashing

Check cashing is available to ACBL members daily for an hour before afternoon game time (noon to 1 pm). The check cashing desk is located next to the ACBL Products Store on the lobby level. Checks up to \$250 will be cashed, but picture identification is a must.



## Checking the defense

When playing in an event governed by the MidChart or SuperChart, players may consult their own defenses as well as the defenses in the pamphlet and those offered by opponents during the auction and play.
