

Junior Month proceeds double 1996 mark

Proceeds from ACBL's second Junior Month -- February 1996 -- appear likely to be much larger than the amount raised last year.

Figures released by ACBL on Friday show more than \$15,000 was raised in the U.S. and more than \$2,000 (Canadian) in Canada. Final amounts will not be available until the end of this month.

The proceeds will be used for ACBL Junior projects such as the Junior Bridge Camp, scheduled this summer in Italy, and for the Canadian Bridge Federation's Junior Development Fund.

Last year's Junior Month total was \$10,706 (in U.S. funds) which included \$8649 in the U.S. and \$2057 (in U.S. funds -- \$2798 in Canadian funds).


3 knockout wins


Kratenstein team leads Women's Swiss

Dallas -- home of world champions

Dallas is home to six living present and former world champions: Malcolm Brachman, Bobby Goldman, Bob Hamman, Mike Passell, Nancy Passell and Bobby Wolff.

Brachman, Goldman and Mike Passell won the Bermuda Bowl in 1979 "after the most harrowing finish in the 30-year history of Bowl competition," according to the account in the World Championship book.

Goldman also won the Bermuda Bowl in 1970 and 1971, as a member of the Aces, and the World Mixed Teams in 1972.

Hamman and Wolff have won these world championships together: the Bermuda Bowl in 1970, 1971, 1977, 1983, 1985, 1987 and 1995; the World Team Olympiad in 1988 and the World Open Pairs in 1974.

Wolff also won the World Mixed Teams in 1972, the only player to have won world championships in four different categories.

Nancy Passell won the Venice Cup in 1991. She and husband Mike are the only married couple who have both won world titles.



Remember the article in Friday's *Daily Bulletin* about the caddies issuing tickets to rude players?

The caddies have added another cause for citation: calling "caddy" in a team game and not holding up the boards -- and they've decided to include kibitzers among rude players who may be cited for:

- \checkmark smoking in a non-smoking area,
- ✓ rudeness or vulgar language,
- ✓ row obstruction -- chair,
 ✓ row obstruction -- purse,
- ✓ row obstruction -- leg,
- ✓ obstruction of game by putting slips or boards in inconsistent or
- inconvenient places, ✓ false caddy call.
- The opposite side of the coin is that the caddies will recognize considerate players with "Caddy Commendations."

and back came a club. I saw my chance to be a hero again, recovering from my previous error. Win the \clubsuit K unblocking the jack, and play a spade to the jack. East will win and probably return a club. Now I can win and cash the last club. This was the ending:

East still has to make a discard. If he throws a spade, you cash the \bigstar A and exit with the \forall 7. East would win and be endplayed at trick 12 again.


If East throws a heart, you set up the hearts for one loser. Either route leads to a valuable overtrick.

But it didn't work out that way. What actually happened when I played a spade to the jack, it was allowed to hold the trick!! Now I had the same squeeze for a second overtrick, enough to recover all the matchpoints I had dropped on the first hand.


Out for the count

Squeezes without the count are one of the more esoteric available to the sophisticated declarer. I had two such opportunities in the Thursday evening Open Pairs, but strange things happened on both deals.

East-West avoided an accident in spades, but since plenty of pairs escaped for minus 50, there were some possibilities of a reasonable score if I could make my contract. I won the \blacklozenge Q opening lead and finessed a club, then played a second spade, ruffed. West got out with a heart, and I foolishly (well, unluckily maybe) tried to run this to the 10. East took his queen and played a third spade. I ruffed and played the \clubsuit K, allowing West to win and make the mistake of cashing his last trump before exiting with a heart. This was the ending:



When I led the last trump, West couldn't pitch a diamond or I would play two rounds of the suit. If he throws a heart away, I can take my top hearts and play a diamond to the 9, endplaying him for the last two tricks.

Alas, I missed my chance and went one down. But I had my chance to recover a few boards

later.

A 2NT opening led to a routine auction to 3NT after a Stayman ask. The \blacklozenge 8 lead allowed me to cash a few rounds of the suit on which West threw two revealing hearts and East the \clubsuit 3.

The $\mathbf{\nabla}8$ was covered by the 10, queen and ace,

Lamprey (East) won the opening diamond lead with his ace. He cashed the \clubsuit A and gave up a heart. He ruffed the diamond return and ruffed a heart.

Now Lamprey played a spade to the ace and ruffed another heart. He ruffed a diamond, as West pitched a heart, and played a club to his king. He ruffed his last diamond, West pitching a spade this time, and ruffed a heart with his last club. (If West ever ruffs with his $\clubsuit Q$, dummy's spade loser disappears.)

West was left with these cards: \bigstar Q-10 and \bigstar Q. He could overruff and lead a spade or he could pitch a spade and Lamprey could cash a spade.

Either way, Lamprey had 11 tricks for plus 400.

"I love that preempt," said Franklin. "He really put it to them."


Against $6 \clubsuit$ doubled, Corker led the $\bigstar Q$, won by dummy's king. East crossed to the $\forall K$ to lead a club to the queen and Franklin's king.

Franklin returned the $\bigstar 9 - 10$, jack, ace. Declarer pulled two more rounds of clubs, ending in his hand, and led the $\forall J$. When South showed out, he ducked the trick to North's queen. Franklin then cashed the $\bigstar 8$ for down two. Plus 300 was worth 13 out of 13 matchpoints.



When Eddie Wold jumped to 4♠ SteveSion brought out Roman Blackwood and bid the slam.

Wold won the heart lead with the king and took four rounds of trumps, East holding back his king until the last round. Wold then made the key play -he led his $\clubsuit 2$ which West took with his queen. He returned a club, and Wold cashed his other high club, pitching a heart from his hand. Then he cashed the $\checkmark A$, and West was finished. His partner was out of clubs, so he had to hold a club. That forced him to come down to three diamonds. So Wold was able to cash his top diamond, then overtake the jack with the queen and cash two more diamonds for his slam.



The defense still had a diamond coming as well as two trump tricks, so declarer soon found himself down three vulnerable tricks.

Mind Sports Olympiad will feature bridge

The First Annual Mind Sports Olympiad, a festival of "thinking" games that will include bridge, is scheduled for Aug. 18-24 at the Royal Festival Hall in London, England.

Goldman, declarer for SCHWARTZ in a comfortable 6NT, received a low spade lead. He won dummy's ace and cashed the \forall A-J, the \blacklozenge A-K and the \clubsuit A. Then he claimed seven on a double squeeze.

Plus 50 and plus 1020 was a 14-IMP gain for SCHWARTZ, who won the quarter 59-20 and the match 156-128.

It happened when Rick Roeder and Harvey Brady were playing against Terry Michaels and Jo Morse. Terry trains seeing-eye dogs for the blind, and Rick sometimes runs a dog for her.

Terry opened $1 \bigstar$ and Harvey overcalled $2 \blacktriangledown$. Rick carried on to $4 \blacktriangledown$, which Harvey duly made. But something strange had happened -- Harvey had five spades as well as five hearts. Rick laughingly suggested that Harvey should have used Michaels since he had both majors.

Just then the dog being trained leaped up into Terry's lap. Said Rick: "Or maybe it should have been Leaping Michaels!"



Other contests on the schedule include such classic, strategic contests as chess, draughts (checkers), backgammon and go.

The event is open to everyone, and the contestants will compete for gold, silver and bronze medals. There will also be a "Pentamind" competition for those adept at five games, as well as a "Decamentathlon" for those wishing to demonstrate their mental prowess at 10 different games.

For those who wish to play bridge only, the event offers plenty. A four-session duplicate pairs game is scheduled, as well as an individual contest, a teams-of-four game and a rubber bridge pairs game, all of which are two-session events.



Only one pass card

The most significant thing about Susan Wexler and Margie Gwozdzinsky, winners of the NABC Women's Pairs, is their unceasing activity as a partnership.

Susan's bidding box contains only one pass card and, as a result, it is rare to find an auction in which she does not participate. It worked to her advantage on Board 21 from the second final session.



(1) Transfer to spades.

Susan (West) doubled 4Ψ , a move that persuaded Margie to lead that suit rather than a club. Susan won the ace and returned a club to the jack, queen and king.

Now declarer played two rounds of spades and, unable to reach dummy to draw the last trump, led the \clubsuit A. Susan ruffed and returned a heart. Declarer had to lose a diamond in the end to score plus 620 -- good for 19.5 out of 25 matchpoints for Wexler-Gwozdzinsky, since many pairs scored plus 650 on a club lead.


Declarer could have recovered by running the first club to the king and leading a second club. It does Susan no good to ruff, and now declarer can win the \clubsuit A, cash the top trumps and ruff a club high to dummy. After drawing the last trump, she can play diamonds for only one loser.

Aggressive bidding, accurate defense

Susan Wexler and Margie Gwozdzinsky, second in the same event a year ago, combined aggressive bidding with accurate defense to win the NABC Women's Pairs by almost three boards.

Wexler and Gwozdzinsky are longtime friends and Gwozdzinsky is "Aunt Margie" to Sara, 13, and Adam, 16.

This was the first NABC victory for Wexler, a legal administrator in New York who took an 18-year vacation from bridge before coming back to the game about 2 1/2 years ago. Since that time, she's been second (with Gwozdzinsky) in the Women's Pairs and in the Women's Knockout Teams.

Gwozdzinsky, a bridge teacher and professional player, won her fourth NABC title. She was a member of the winning Venice Cup team in Perth, Australia, in 1989.

The two had a 66.69% game in the second final session. "The key is that we've been working on our game," said Gwozdzinsky.

The work paid off on this deal from the second final session.

NA Open Swiss Teams features Jacoby Trophy

The North American Open Swiss Teams -- formerly the North American Men's Swiss Teams -- will finish today, with the Jacoby Trophy going to the winners.

The trophy is named for Oswald and Jim Jacoby -- one of the premier father-son pairs in ACBL history -- the first father-son combination to win a national championship and the first father-son combination to be elected to the ACBL Bridge Hall of Fame.

The senior Jacoby (1902-1984) won his first major title -- the National Team Championship of the American Whist League -- in 1929 and his last major title -- the Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams -- in 1983.

In between, he won the *McKenney Trophy* (now the *Barry Crane Top 500*) four times. He was the first player to win 1000 points in a single year and the first player to earn 10,000 points.

Ozzie won seven Spingolds, seven Vanderbilts, two Reisingers and more than a dozen other major titles. He was named to the ACBL Bridge Hall of Fame in 1965.

He and son Jim are co-authors of Jacoby Transfer Bids, Jacoby 2NT and other bidding ideas. They won the Reisinger in 1955 -- when Jim was 22 -- and the Vanderbilt in 1965.

Jim Jacoby (1933-1991), elected to the Hall of Fame this year, won the Bermuda Bowl in 1970 and 1971, the World Mixed Teams in 1972 and the World Team Olympiad in 1988. He won more than 14 NABC titles and captured the *Barry Crane Top 500* in 1988 -- the same year he won the Olympiad title.

He is one of only three players to win the masterpoint title and a world championship in the same year -- Charles Goren won the Bermuda Bowl and the McKenney in 1950 while Barry Crane won the World Mixed Pairs and the McKenney in 1978.

Both tables reached 3NT. Peter Boyd led a top heart and shifted to spades. That beat the contract trivially.

But Soloway got a low heart lead and won it in hand. Since the auction $1 \clubsuit$ - double - $3 \clubsuit$ - pass; 3NT had indicated hearts were 4-4, the right play looks to be to win the heart and lead the $\blacklozenge Q$. If West wins this and does not play the $\bigstar K$, you have nine easy tricks. If West wins and actually does lead the $\bigstar K$, you take the club finesse for your ninth winner.

But the defense ducks and you play your A followed by the jack. Again if the defense wins this and returns a spade, you have your nine tricks.

So East has to duck the $\bigstar J$. Then you simply play the $\bigstar A$ and clear the spades. You wind up with five minor suit winners, one heart and three spades -- again nine tricks.

(1) "I had run out of pass cards," said Wexler.
 (2) Still out of pass cards.

"Once we got to game, our opponents were not going to get a good result," said Gwozdzinsky. When they sacrificed, the opponents got a worse result.

Wexler led the $\blacklozenge 9$ and Gwozdzinsky won her ace and returned the $\blacklozenge 3$, suit preference for hearts. Declarer won her queen and led the $\clubsuit Q$.

Wexler ducked and Gwozdzinsky won her ace. She shifted to the $\bigstar K$ and declarer won the ace. Now declarer led the $\bigstar J$, and Wexler took her king and led a low heart.

Gwozdzinsky cashed the $\forall Q$ -A and the $\blacklozenge Q$. When she next led the $\blacklozenge J$, Wexler scored her $\clubsuit 9$ *en passant*. Plus 1100 was worth all 25 matchpoints.

The Facts: 3NT made four, plus 430 for N/S. The Director was called after the opening lead of the $\bigstar6$, but waved away. The Director was again called at the end of the hand. The 2NT bid had not been Alerted and was intended to show the minors. South did not advise the opponents before the opening lead that he had intended his bid to show the minors. North did not believe they had an agree-



ment. The Director ruled there had been no damage and allowed the result to stand because West had led fourth best from the suit he had opened and his partner had supported.

The Appeal: E/W appealed the Director's ruling. West stated that if he had been properly informed about the N/S agreement the defense might have been different. N/S had only one completed convention card and their

agreement was not on it.

The Committee Decision: The Committee decided N/S had the agreement that 2NT showed the minors since South had stated he thought 2NT showed the minors. Therefore, South had the responsibility to inform his opponents that there had been a failure to Alert before the opening lead. The Committee decided that, in compliance with Law12C2, the most unfavorable result that was at all probable for N/S was to take nine tricks on the lead of the $\bigstar K$ and East ducking the first round of hearts. The most favorable result that was likely for E/W had the irregularity not occurred was that N/S would take ten tricks. The Committee changed the contract to 3NT made three, plus 400 for N/S and 3NT made four, minus 430 for E/W. In addition, N/S was assessed a one-quarter board procedural penalty.

The Facts: 4NT made five, plus 460 for E/W. The Director was called because there was a break in tempo before East bid 4NT. The Director ruled that there had been no use

of unauthorized information and allowed the result to stand.

The Appeal: N/S appealed the Director's ruling. There was an agreed break



in tempo before the 4NT bid. E/W have been playing together for about 20 years. This sequence had not occurred previously in their partnership. They play no special agreement for the forcing 1NT bid. Rarely does a 1NT bid have game-forcing values. 2NT over one of a major would be forcing and balanced and 3NT would be 15 to 16 balanced. 2NT after the reverse was forcing.

N/S contended that the break in tempo suggested bidding over 4NT was a logical alternative for West. N/S suggested the contract should be 5♥ down one, plus 50 for N/S.

The Committee Decision: The Committee decided that the break in tempo did not suggest one action over another. Even if bidding was a logical alternative, the Committee agreed that pass was clear. The Committee allowed the table result, 4NT made five, plus 460 for E/W to stand.

The Committee found the appeal lacked substantial merit and thought the appeal was egregious. The Committee retained the \$50 deposit and assessed a 5.5 matchpoint procedural penalty against N/S for abuse of the appeals process.




