Junior Corps to gain 7 members today

ACBL's Junior players -- ages 26 and younger -- will be treated to a dinner/reception and an update on Junior activities today between sessions.

The meeting is scheduled for 5:30 p.m. in Pullman B at Union Station, located across the street from the Hyatt Regency.

Charlotte Blaiss, ACBL coordinator for Junior programs, said seven players will be inducted into the ACBL Junior Corps, the group established in 1990 to promote bridge among young people.

Blaiss said that preliminary figures, as of March 7, show that Junior Month -- February Junior fund games to promote Junior activities -- raised \$11,347 in the U.S. and \$1,334 in Canada. Final figures will not be available until the end of the month.

Blaiss said four North American Junior teams -- two from the U.S. and two from Canada -- are preparing for the World Junior Bridge Team Championship in Hamilton ON in August.

Among their preparations:

- U.S. I and a mixture of the two Canadian teams competed in the Fifth International Youth Bridge Festival in

World champion Aces took shape in Big D

Two years ago, the bridge world marked the 25th anniversary of the first world championship won by the Aces, the world's first full-time professional team.

The remarkable experiment which resulted in the creation of the legendary squad began right here in Dallas,

home of the 1997 Spring NABC.

It all started with Ira Corn, a Dallas businessman who was inspired by what he saw in the 1964 World Team Olympiad in New York.

Corn had become interested in bridge, and he traveled to the world championship in New York to have a closer look at the top players in the game. What he saw was the Italian Blue Team, a finely tuned bridge machine which dominated the field and defeated a strong American team in the final.

Corn left New York with dreams of creating an American juggernaut which would wrest world bridge domi-

Charity Foundation presents \$30,000 in major grants

The ACBL Charity Foundation will present grants totaling \$15,000 for flood relief in the Northwest and the Midwest plus another \$15,000 in grants to honor three longtime ACBL members.

"We are so glad to find ourselves in a position to earmark money for those who are longtime ACBL members," said Foundation President Carol Sanders, who announced the grants.

Three grants of \$5,000 each will be presented to the Age-Related Macular Degeneration Foundation, honoring Sue Emery; the Chemotherapy Foundation, honoring Edgar Kaplan; and the Myasthenis Gravis Foundation, honoring Lynn Deas.

The flood relief grants will go to states in the Northwest and Midwest, including Ohio, Kentucky and Tennessee.

Before the Charity Pairs and the Charity KO Teams on Thursday, the Foundation presented checks totaling \$105,000 to the National Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse and the local chapter of the Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation.

Robison, Perlmutter lead Open Pairs I

Jim Robison Jr. of Las Vegas and Mark Perlmutter of San Francisco took a two-board lead into today's final two sessions of Open Pairs I.

The two posted a 1741.83 total after yesterday's qualifying sessions. Robison-Perlmutter were the only pair to top 1700. Top was 51.

Second with 1634.13 matchpoints were Bermuda Bowl champions Nick Nickell, New York, and Dick Freeman, Atlanta, followed by former world champion Fred Hamilton, Fresno CA, and Kyle Larsen, San Francisco. Their total was 1600.

The winner will receive the Silodor Trophy -- presented in memory of Sidney Silodor, winner of the Bermuda Bowl, the McKenney Trophy and more than 30 North American championships.

Silodor, a member of the team that won the first Bermuda Bowl World Championship in 1950, won the Vanderbilt eight times, the Spingold, the Open Pairs and the Master Mixed Teams three times each and the Mixed Pairs five times -- a record.

At the time of his death in 1963, Silodor was third on the list of all-time masterpoint holders with a total of 6,450 -- a figure great enough to hold that place until a year later when his total was surpassed by Norman Kay, who had been his regular partner.

Silodor was an original member of the Bridge Hall of Fame, elected in the Sixties when the institution was the province of its creator, *The Bridge World* magazine.

The trophy was presented in 1963 in memory of Silodor and made retroactive to include winners of the event which began in 1958.

The four-session event consists of two qualifying sessions and two final sessions. □

It is ACBL policy to have players tap the Alert strip and say Alert out loud at the same time. When an announcement is made, once again the player should tap the Alert strip.

When using spoken bidding, players are required to announce and Alert aloud.

If there is some reluctance about complying, players should summon a tournament director rather than get into a hassle with an opponent.

The auction put West on lead with an easy ♥10.

With the heart suit lying as it does, it is necessary to consider your first move carefully. If the heart suit splits 4-3, it is irrelevant whether you win the first or second round of the suit. But as the cards lie, look at what happens if you take the first heart and drive out the ♠A (if you lead the ♣K West will duck). When East takes the ♠A and returned the ♥J, West overtakes and can clear the suit while retaining the ♣A as an entry.

If you duck the first heart and win the second in hand, East will have no hearts left when you drive out his ace. That makes the difference between an undertrick and an overtrick.

ACBL teams finish in top 10 at Bridge Festival in Holland

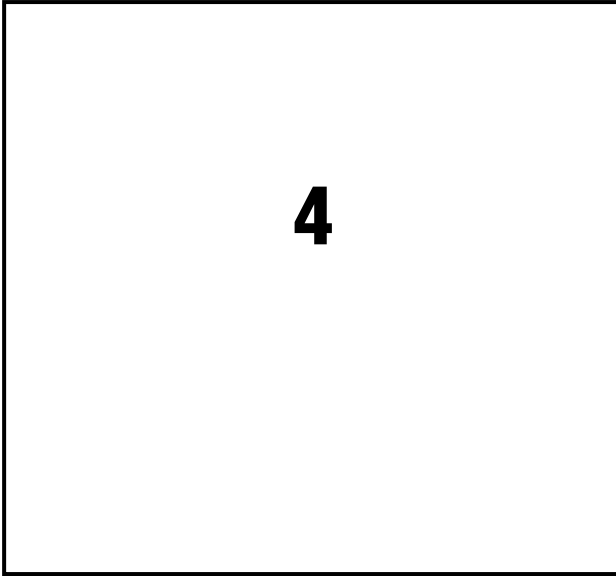
Junior teams from the U.S. and Canada, gearing up for the World Junior Bridge Championship this summer, finished in the top 10 at the fifth International Youth Bridge Festival in the Netherlands in January.

"I thought it was really important for us to do well," said Steve Altus, non-playing captain of the U.S. team. "When these European countries sit down to play against us in Hamilton (Ontario, site of the 1997 world championships), they'll know they can lose."

Italy won the four-day competition of round-robin matches. Canada finished seventh and the U.S. ninth.

Both North American teams defeated Italy in their matches. The U.S. defeated Norway, Russia and Denmark -- teams they'll meet again in the world championship. "I was very happy with the way all our guys played," said Altus, a former Junior player in his first outing as npc.

Canada's Fred Gitelman, another former Junior player making his debut as npc, was equally

After Moss opened the West hand and Paltowitz was able to show both spades and clubs, it was easy to reach the good spade slam. With clubs breaking, the U.S. gained 14 IMPs in a losing effort against Germany.

In the third round, Canada got off to a slow start against Sweden but gained 30 IMPs on the last two boards to win the match 44-32.

Mini-Bridge highlights Festival final day

After the Junior team competition ends, there was a special "Youth Day" on Saturday with three separate games:

- A Swiss teams tournament for Junior players where multi-national teams are encouraged. Thirty-eight teams participated this year.
- A Pupil Bridge game for teenage players. Thirteen tables were in play.
- A Mini-Bridge game for youngsters 10-12. Thirty tables were in play.

Mini-Bridge was developed in the Netherlands in 1987 by Ids Hemminga, who noted that "the first main difficulty is to keep 13 cards in those little hands."

That obstacle dealt with, he said, "the kids are taught at their own tempo, their own speed."

Els Creusen, a member of the Dutch Bridge Federation's Youth Bridge Committee, said Mini-Bridge is "bridge with no bidding -- just play. After one hour, they can play bridge."

Here's how it works: the cards are dealt and each player announces the total of his high-card points. The side with the most points wins the deal and the player with the most points becomes declarer.

His partner becomes dummy and faces his hand. Declarer now decides if he will play game or no-game and if he'll play in a suit or notrump.

All this takes about 30-45 seconds and the youngsters are playing. They're good and they're enthusiastic -- 300 youngsters from all over Holland competed in last year's school championship.

The next step, Creusen said, is for youngsters to learn bidding at Youth bridge clubs. These are separate from "regular" bridge clubs. "We have about 20 now and we hope there'll be 100 in a few years."

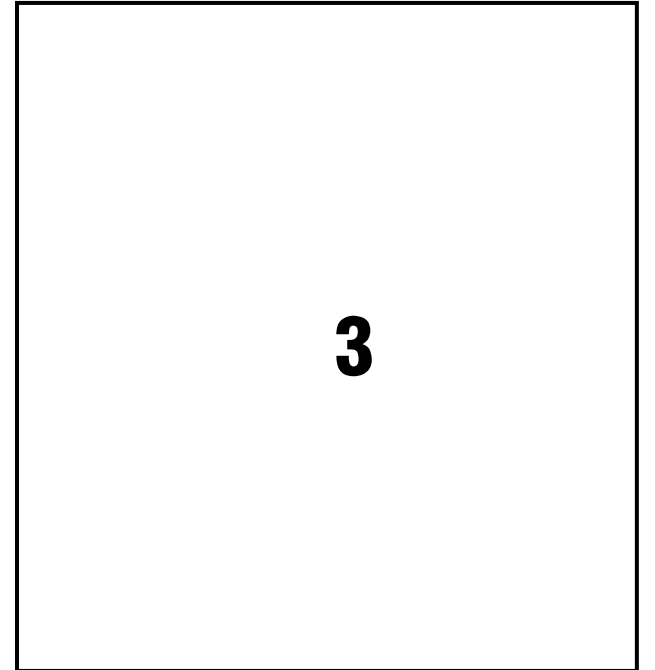

Lee led the ♣3 to the 2, queen and 7. Zeidenberg shifted to a low heart and declarer played the queen. Lee won his ♥K and returned the ♣J -- low, low, ruff.

Now declarer led the ♠J, ducked all around. He cashed the ♥A and led a low heart. Lee pitched

a low diamond and declarer ruffed with dummy's ♠9.

Declarer led a low diamond to his king and continued with the ♥J, ruffed low by Lee and overruffed with dummy's ♠A.

Now declarer cashed the ♦A and continued with a low diamond. He ruffed with the ♠10 and Lee overruffed with his queen to return the ♠8.

Declarer won his king and led the ♥9 but Lee ruffed with the ♠6 and cashed his good ♠7. Down two and plus 1000 to East-West.

At the other table, clubs were never bid (or doubled) and Roberts, declarer for Canada at 4♠, received a low diamond lead. This was ducked around to his 9 and he cashed the ♦K at trick two.

A spade to dummy's ace revealed the 5-0 trump

pleased. Canada defeated Russia but lost to Norway and Denmark. "This tournament has been good for our team," he said, "and I think the good will extend to Hamilton."

Canada's squad was a mixture of the two teams that will compete in the world championship: Eric Sutherland, Mike Roberts, Ben Zeidenberg, Colin Lee, Mike Nadler and Darren Wolpert.

The U.S. representative was U.S. I -- Varis Carey, Joel Singer, Michael Shuster, Andrew Lewis, Andrew Moss and Mark Paltowitz.

Twenty-two teams, representing 21 countries (the Netherlands, as the host country, was allotted two teams), played 12-board matches against every other team. The competitors played 21 matches in four days.

Both North American teams served notice early on that they would be contenders.

Nadler, West for Canada, led the ♠A and continued with the ♠K. Declarer correctly ruffed with dummy's ♠A -- if he ruffs with the ♦6 and cashes the ace, he can't get back to his hand to draw the last trump -- and led a low diamond.

When Wolpert followed with a low diamond, declarer -- playing for diamonds to be 4-1 -- played his ♦9. Nadler won his 10 and Canada scored a win.

Andy Lewis, West, found an unusual endplay to make his 4♥ contract against Finland in round 14, reported npc Altus.

North led a high spade and shifted to the ♥7 -- 8, 9 and queen. Lewis returned a heart to the king, ace and 9.

Now he played three rounds of clubs ending in dummy. He ruffed the last club and played a diamond to the king. When this held, he exited the ♦J and North won the queen.

Sutherland first Junior elected to CBF board

Eric Sutherland of Toronto has become the first Junior player elected to the board of directors of the Canadian Bridge Federation.

Sutherland, 24, represents Zone III --- Units 166, 246 and 249, covering Toronto and vicinity.

Sutherland is a Silver Life Master, a member of the ACBL Junior Corps and the president and founder of CYBORG, the Canadian Youth Bridge Organization.

He has represented Canada twice at the World Junior Bridge Championships and, as a member of Canada Red (the team that won the Junior Team Trials at the Miami NABC last summer), will represent his country in the World Junior Team Championship in Ontario this summer.

Sutherland is also an accredited teacher who has earned a one-star rating, awarded for teaching 100 students the *Club, Diamond, Heart or Spade Series*.

On May 3 he will join the ranks of the married -- he will wed Charlene Knowlton.

College championship changes venue

The College Bridge Team Championship, won by a Texas university for the first time last year, has been re-scheduled from Memphis to OKbridge on the Internet.

Texas A&M University, making its first appearance in the championship, defeated York University (Toronto) -- the first win for a Southwest Conference school since the college team championship became an annual event in 1987.

A&M's squad was Marc Whinery of Dallas and Patricia Lozano, Hank Eng and Eric Wolff, all of San Antonio.

Wolff, by the way, is not related to Bermuda bowl champion and fellow Texan Bobby Wolff, but "every tournament I go to, I make sure to mention Uncle Bobby."

Prize for Juniors

The International Bridge Press Association, which gives annual awards for Best Play, Best Defense and Best Auction, has added a new prize for 1997 --- the Levendaal Award. This will be given to the Junior player who is selected as having made the best play or best defense of the year.

The winning Junior and the IBPA member who writes up the hand each will receive \$200.

Levendaal is a software company in the Netherlands.

The Youth Festival

The International Youth Bridge Festival began 11 years ago as a "cafe bridge tournament" --- the brainchild of Fons van Bokhoven and Jan Rijnaarts --- where team games were played in the cafes of 's-Hertogenbosch.

Teams play four-board matches at a cafe and move to another cafe to play their next match.

The idea proved so successful --- nearly 2000 pairs participated last spring --- that van Bokhoven and Rijnaarts set up the *Bridgestad 's-Hertogenbosch* Foundation to sponsor Junior bridge activities.

The first International Youth Bridge Festival was played in 1993 with seven countries participating.

The 1997 festival drew 22 teams --- including first-time participants Canada and the U.S.

"These are very friendly games," said van Bokhoven. "The bridge, we think, is perfect. When they enjoy it, we enjoy it."

The Junior players stay with "guestparents," local residents who open their homes to one or two young players. A note in the tournament bulletin had a guestparent talking about her Juniors:

"You have two loaves of bread, brown and white, some croissants, some sausage-sandwiches, cheese, ham, eggs, orange juice, milk and fruit. The youngsters sit down and after some 20 minutes, everything has vanished. That is what I like: good eaters."

Eric Sutherland and Mike Roberts stayed with guestparents in town and "it was just a whole bunch of fun," said Sutherland. "It's a wonderful way to get to know a country and its people."

His guestparents will visit North America later this year "and they're coming by Toronto just to say hello."

Dallas parking

Valet parking: Valet parking is available at the hotel entrance. The 24-hour rate, usually \$12, has been specially discounted to only \$9 for bridge players. In and out permitted for hotel guests.



Annex parking: Located at the intersection of Hotel Street and Reunion Boulevard. \$6 per day maximum. No in and out.

Union Station: Union Station parking is connected to the Hyatt Regency Dallas by underground tunnel. \$5 per day maximum. No in and out.

Reunion arena: Entrance is at the intersection of Sports Street and Reunion Boulevard. \$2 per day, but may be adjusted for special Reunion Arena activities. No in and out.

DART information

Step outside the Hyatt Regency and you can catch a Dallas Light Rail train, part of the Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART) system.

Reduced rates are available for rides that begin and end downtown: 50 cents for a single trip, \$1 for a round trip.

Cash is not accepted but tickets or passes may be purchased at vending machines in the stations.

The Light Rail runs from 5:30 a.m. until 12:30 a.m. seven days a week. From 6 a.m. to 9 a.m., the Light Rail trains arrive every 5 to 10 minutes; from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., every 10 to 20 minutes; from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m., every 5 to 10 minutes, and from 6 p.m. to 12:30 a.m., every 10 to 20 minutes.

nance from the Italians. A couple of years later, he began work on the project.

His first recruit was Bobby Wolff, who was living in San Antonio at the time and running a bridge club with Joe Musumeci, who eventually became coach of the Aces.

In 1967, Wolff and Corn prepared a short list of players they thought worthy of the soon-to-be-created Aces, and the two went to work trying to sign them.

Two of the initial invitees -- Californians Bob Hamman and Eddie Kantar -- turned Corn down. Hamman and Kantar were enjoying some success in their developing partnership and didn't want to change -- and Kantar was not about to leave his beloved Southern California. Furthermore, Hamman had misgivings about the whole idea.

The other players may have wondered whether Corn could make the project work, but their doubts were not strong enough to keep them from signing on. The original Aces were:

- Wolff, who remains one of the top players in the world today. In late May and early June, Wolff and his teammates will be attempting to earn a berth in the 1997 Bermuda Bowl in Tunisia in order to defend the championship they won in Beijing in 1995.

- Bobby Goldman, who still resides in the Dallas area. A professional player, he was a member of one of the U.S. teams which competed in Beijing two years ago.

- Billy Eisenberg, also a professional player. Ironically, the Boca Raton FL resident has formed a partnership with former Italian Blue Team star Benito Garozzo (now an American citizen).

- Jim Jacoby, a Dallas resident and son of the legendary Oswald Jacoby. Jacoby played professionally until his death in 1991.

- Mike Lawrence, an up-and-coming player from the San Francisco area. Lawrence still plays professionally but is equally well known as an author. Several of his books are considered classics of the bridge genre.

Wolff played with Jacoby. Eisenberg, Goldman and Lawrence played as a threesome.

Progress for the Aces was slow at first. Practice sessions were often disorganized and the partnerships lacked structure, particularly Wolff and Jacoby, with their "go as you please" bidding style.

Then came Musumeci, the retired Air Force officer hired by Corn to shape up the troops. He ran disciplined, structured practice sessions and enforced Corn's dictum that the partnerships have firm bidding agreements. Jacoby and Wolff began playing a strong 1♣ system called the Orange Club.

Pretty soon the Aces were the terrors of the bridge world. At the 1968 Summer NABC in Minneapolis, Eisenberg and Goldman won the Life Master Pairs. Wolff and Jacoby were second.

Hamman took notice, and it wasn't very long before he signed on with the Aces. He joined the team in January of 1969. The partnerships were Goldman-Eisenberg, Wolff-Jacoby and Hamman-Lawrence.

By the following summer, the Aces had become a virtual steamroller in the bridge world. In the Spingold Knockout Teams at the 1969 Summer NABC in Coronado CA, the Aces won every match but the final by more than 100 IMPs. In the championship match, the Aces pounded a strong team led by Ira Rubin, 211-116.

The Aces stormed through the team trials later that year to earn a berth in the 1970 Bermuda Bowl

in Stockholm, Sweden.

It appeared that the Aces' reputation preceded them to Stockholm. Shortly before the Bermuda Bowl began, the organizers of the tournament -- in a thinly disguised attempt to give the other teams in the field a better chance -- changed the conditions of contest.

In previous Bermuda Bowls, the scoring was by IMPs. For the 1970 contest, scoring in the final was by quarters with IMPs converted to Victory Points for each quarter. The maximum VP score possible per quarter was 20, although the losing side could go minus up to 5 VPs.

Ironically, the change made the final quarter of the 1970 Bermuda Bowl irrelevant -- the Aces were 45 VPs ahead of their Taiwanese opponents, who could have won the final quarter by 1000 IMPs and still gained only 25 VPs (plus 20 for themselves against minus 5 for the opponents).

At the victory banquet, the Aces shrugged off comments about the weakness of the field -- Italy (a poor substitute for the "retired" Blue Team), Norway, Brazil and Taiwan. Going into the championship, the Aces knew they were unlikely to be tested. Said Lawrence: "Any of the teams we played in the late stages of the (1969) Spingold would have been favored in Stockholm.

The team was vindicated the following year with a convincing victory over a strong French team in the Bermuda Bowl final in Taiwan.

Shortly after that tournament, the Aces were no longer Corn's full-time employees, although he paid some expenses for the team.

For a long time, any team with Hamman and Wolff was known -- unofficially at least -- as the Aces.

Corn died in 1982, and the team -- Hamman, Wolff, Peter Weichsel, Alan Sontag, Mike Becker and Ron Rubin -- dedicated their 1983 Bermuda Bowl victory to their former patron.

Dallas remains home to world champion bridge players. Hamman and Wolff are reigning Bermuda Bowl titlists (with nearly 20 world championships between them). Goldman earned his two Bermuda Bowl wins as a member of the Aces. Malcolm Brachman and Mike Passell were members of the winning Bermuda Bowl team in 1979, and Mike's wife Nancy was a member of the winning Venice Cup team in 1991. The Passells are the only U.S. couple to win the Bermuda Bowl and Venice Cup. □

Also taking part were Foundation Vice President Jim Zimmerman and trustees Joan DeWitt McKean and Don Moeller.

Dr. Wood noted that "one of the most difficult things for parents is to talk to youngsters about sensitive subjects, such as alcoholism and drug abuse. The film we've made -- with your money -- is doing just that."

This was the second \$100,000 grant presented to the Council. □

Looking back ... Dallas, 1964

Dallas' last NABC was the Fall of 1964 where the total attendance of 8686 tables set a record, 1557 more than the record set the previous year in Miami.

"Welcome-wise," noted the *Bridge Bulletin*, "the Texans easily scaled the heights of previous Nationals. And bridge-wise the fare was superb with most of the top players in North America contesting the main events."

If West leads either of his aces, the slam can be made. The ♥A, for example, is ruffed by South who later sheds a club on the ♥K and loses just one club trick.

If West opens the ♣A he has to shift, since South would allow a second club to ride around to his jack. When West shifts, South wins and pulls trumps. South cashes all his diamonds and spades, keeping just the jack and another club in his hand.

When South plays his last winner, West has to unguard the ♣Q in order to keep the ♥A. Dummy now throws the ♥K and South makes the slam-going tricks with the king and jack of clubs.

Leventitt did not lead an ace -- he opened the ♦J. Later he ducked when declarer led a low club and South had no way to win.

Emma Jean Hawes wasted no time bemoaning an atrocious trump break on this deal from the Mixed Pairs. Aided by a defensive slip, she brought home an impossible-looking 4♠ contract.

Holding three likely trump tricks, West tried to ensure a set by leading the ♣A. He then shifted to the ♠Q.

Hawes played dummy's king, came to the ♥Q, cashed out the diamonds and continued with the ♥A K, pitching two clubs. She then ruffed a heart as West followed.

With just four tricks left, South needed two for her contract. West had only trumps while South had three trumps and the top club.

She led the club, knowing that West would have to ruff. Having ruffed, West returned the ♠J but Hawes ducked and left West to lead away from the 10-8 of trumps into her ace-9.

If you question most experts about their bad hands, reported the *Bridge Bulletin* (February 1965), the best you will get is a reputation for

asking questions.

But Bob Hamman, who turned in two fine performances with a Trials fourth (before the NABC) and a Blue Ribbon first, actually *thrust* this hand upon us:

After a club to his 10, Russell continued with the ♣Q. Hamman (East) won the ace but erred when he returned a heart instead of flinging a club right back.

Allowed to hold Hamman's heart return with the jack, West won the next trick with the ♥K. On winning the third round of hearts with dummy's ace, Russell ran the diamonds and squeezed East in this ending:

West led the ♦9 and Truscott covered with dummy's 10 and topped East's jack with her king. The obvious --- some would say the only --- line of play is to cross to the ♠K and lead a trump, hoping to lose only one trump trick.

Truscott, however, was not sanguine about the prospects of such a play. Her reasoning was that if East held the trump ace, he would have won the opening diamond lead and fired back the suit, knowing that he could win the first trump lead and play another diamond.

In other words, the fact that he had apparently ducked the diamond lead to retain communication suggested that he had no other quick entry.

At the second trick South returned a diamond, knocking out East's ace. East failed to find the proper defense -- cash the ♣K before playing a

third diamond.

On the diamond return, Truscott sluffed her club loser while West had to ruff.

When Truscott regained the lead, she played a low trump to bring West's ace clattering down and the contract cantering home.

Victor Mitchell (South) was faced with a rough decision after his partner, Sidney Lazard, opened 2NT. Mitchell pondered the possibilities: unless clubs could be run, even 3NT might not make. On the other hand, a pass was unthinkable and 5♣ was a "nothing" bid.

Mitchell finally decided to take the optimistic view that clubs would run. This decision having been made, he now had to decide between 3NT, 6♣ or 6NT. He chose 6♣.

West, with little to go on, led a low spade and after several brief sighs of relief, Mitchell won the king. With the opponents having failed to cash their top diamonds, Mitchell was not inclined to relinquish the advantage.

He guessed the club position, leading the king from dummy. When West showed out, the marked club finesse was taken and the slam was home.
