Tim Barrett, 37, is a movie theater manager. Grue, 16, is a junior in high school. Lee, known to his teammates as "Scooter," is a math major at the University of Minnesota. Joe Barrett, Tim's cousin, works for First Bank in the wire transfer department. Monikowski, 25, works for Qualex, a subsidiary of Kodak, as coordinator of the packaging department.

I/N turnout a pleasant surprise

Going into the Summer NABC in Albuquerque, ACBL's Intermediate-Novice Coordinator Betty Bratcher wasn't quite sure what to expect -- and in her wildest dreams she didn't think so many players would turn out for the beginner games.

"They came, they tried us, they liked it and they came back," said Bratcher of the surprising turnout in the I/N games. "We've had a lot of repeaters."

Through Saturday evening, the

Trailing by 38 IMPs, the District 4 team from Delaware routed their District 3 opponents, 50-9, in the fourth quarter to win the Grand National Teams, Flight B, 131-128.

The winners are Harold Jordan and Sigridur "Sóley" Kristjansdottir, Wilmington DE; Andy Kaufman, Smyrna DE, and Greg Burch, Newark DE.

The runners-up are Steve Albin, Princeton NJ; Elaine Pittius, Bridgewater NJ; Julia Ehlers, West Orange NJ, and Michael McNamara, Morristown NJ.

Jordan, 26, and Burch, 25, are computer programmers for Blair Computing Services of Newark DE.

Kaufman, 38, and Kristjansdottir both work for DuPont. Kaufman is a chemical engineer/project engineer. Kristjansdottir is a research chemist. Originally from Iceland, she has been in the U.S. for 12 years.

Three members of the losing team are regular OKbridge players, and they asked that they be identified by their OKbridge "handles." McNamara is "Daddymac," Pittius is "PityUS" and Albin is SteveA.

The match was close after one quarter, 44-36 for District 3, but the winners were bombed, 67-23, in the second quarter and trailed by 52 at the break. In the second half, however, District 4 outscored their opponents, 72-17.

Great attendance

The crowds dwindled yesterday, the way they always do toward the end of an NABC. Nevertheless there were enough players to bring the table count up to 10,719. We need only about 300 tables a session today to surpass 11,300 tables -- a great showing.

Propelled by fate

Sometimes, it seems, you're destined to win, and just about anything you do turns out right. A case in point is this deal from the first final session of the IMP Pairs, won by Junior players Tom Carmichael and Joel Wooldridge. In that set, the two ended up plus 102 IMPs.

Carmichael and Wooldridge had a bidding misunderstand to reach a slam which, on the surface at least, had rather poor prospects. As it happened, however, the slam was cold -- if Wooldridge found the right line of play.

When Carmichael bid 6♦, Wooldridge began to realize that the wheels had come off in the auction. Rather than trying to improve the contract -- he had no idea to what, of course -- Wooldridge passed.

Thanks to some lucky breaks in the red suits, Wooldridge was able to redeem himself in the play.

West led the $\blacktriangle 10$ to Wooldridge's ace. Wooldridge cashed dummy's two diamonds and played a heart to his queen. East attempted a falsecard with the $\blacktriangledown J$.

In hand again, Wooldridge held his breath and played the ◆K. When both opponents followed, Wooldridge knew he was still alive. Rejecting the possible finesse in hearts, Wooldridge played to the ♥A and cashed the ♥K. When both opponents followed again, he discarded his losing spade on the 13th heart and ruffed a spade to hand.

Wooldridge then played a low club from his hand. West, with nothing but clubs left, could take his one trick in the suit immediately or later, but it was the only trick for the defense.

Plus 920 was good for a 10-IMP gain.

Fred Hamilton

Hamilton poised to top 25,000 masterpoints today

Fred Hamilton, two-time world champion, almost certainly will surpass 25,000 masterpoints today. He needs less than 1 masterpoint to go over and is playing on a strong team in the Senior Swiss Teams.

His masterpoint total puts him at #8 on the all-time list

Long one of the top professional players, Hamilton has a win in the 1976 Bermuda Bowl and the World Senior Pairs with Hamish Bennett in 1994. Hamilton has been second in the Bermuda Bowl and the World Team Olympiad.

In addition, Hamilton won the Cavendish Invitational Pairs with Jimmy Cayne in 1981. He was second in the Omar Sharif World Individual in 1990.

Hamilton has won nine North American championships, most recently the Senior Knockout Teams last fall in San Francisco. He has been second in 11 major ACBL championships.

He captured the Herman Trophy, for winning the most masterpoints at a Fall NABC, in 1974.

Going into the Summer NABC, the Fresno CA resident's masterpoint total stood at 24,936 and a fraction. Through Saturday afternoon, Hamilton had earned 62.99 masterpoints at the Summer NABC.

Gold Life Master

Joel Wooldridge, who won the IMP Pairs on Friday, had another victory yesterday when his team won a knockout teams event. The points he won yesterday were enough to put the 18-year-old in the Gold Life Master class (more than 2500 masterpoints).

Make your foes decide early

In situations where the opponents will have to decide how to play a hand, it is usually best to force them to decide early. This hand comes from the Round of 32 in the Spingold. It was defended by Alex Kolesnik and Varis Carey, both of Austin TX.

Kolesnik and Carey played on a team with Steve Altus, Joel Singer and Amy Lewis. Carey, Singer and Lewis are members of the United States I Junior team which will be playing in Canada next week in the World Junior Championships. Altus is their coach and non-playing captain.

Against 4♥, Carey led the ♦ J. Declarer ducked and Kolesnik won the king. At this point the distribution and honor card placement were entirely known. It looked as if a diamond continuation would be needed to kill the dummy entry to the spades. However, Kolesnik considered what would come next. Declarer would be forced to draw trumps and play on spades. When in with the ♠A, after holding up one round, Kolesnik would have been forced to play a club and declarer could not go wrong.

Instead Kolesnik decided to lead a club immediately, to see if declarer would go wrong. Declarer found the correct play of ducking, and Carey ducked also. Now declarer could have succeeded by drawing trumps and playing spades, since the suit broke 3-3. But he decided to play spades first, not realizing the club danger. Kolesnik won and got a club ruff to defeat the contract for a 10-IMP gain.

Even though their team lost the match, the Junior players all played extremely well to get that far in the Spingold. They defeated two higher-seeded teams.


By the way, the two good sports earned an 11-IMP swing on the next deal.

Rogers led her singleton heart, taken with the ace, and declarer led a diamond to the king and ace. Peggy then cashed the A and continued the suit. That set up a series of six consecutive ruffs, three in clubs and three in hearts. When the smoke cleared, 24 was down three for 10 of the 12 matchpoints.

With the ♥J dropping singleton and the ♣Q onside, Beth had no trouble wrapping up her contract -- five spades, four hearts, three clubs and a diamond.

Wolff led a low spade to dummy's jack, and declarer played a heart to the ace and ruffed a heart. Next he played the *Q from dummy, ducked all around. The ♣J was next. Hamman followed low and South started to think. He was fearful that Wolff was ducking the &K and planned to win the next round and give Hamman a ruff. With this in his mind, declarer finally went up with the A, which Wolff ruffed.

Now Wolff had to think. Wolff knew declarer still had two losing hearts in his hand, so the natural instinct was to return a trump to prevent any more ruffs. That would have been disastrous, however.

Had Wolff exited with a trump, declarer's only option would have been to run trumps hoping for something good to happen -- and it would have worked. Wolff's hand would have gone through the proverbial meatgrinder. If he discarded more than one diamond, the entire suit would run after the finesse of the jack, and if he threw both his heart honors, declarer could cash the ♥10 before taking the diamond finesse, not needing the low diamond spots.


Wolff finally arrived at the solution -- he got out with the ♥K, forcing declarer to use dummy's last trump and making it impossible for declarer to get to his hand without playing on diamonds and thereby breaking the communication necessary for a squeeze to work.

Don't mess with Larry

When Larry Cohen bids a slam, it's best not to be too hasty about doubling, as his opponents on this deal from the quarterfinals of the Spingold Knockout Teams learned to their chagrin. Unfortunately for Cohen and partner David Berkowitz, the huge gain on the board wasn't enough to salvage the match.



- (1) Four-of-a-minor preempt.
- (2) Settling for game if partner's suit is diamonds -willing to play slam if partner's suit is clubs.
- (3) Trying to have the slam played from Cohen's side. East could have defeated the slam with the lead of either red suit, but he was guessing about his opening lead -- and he guessed wrong. Cohen ruffed the opening spade lead in dummy and played a club, going up

with the ace. Cohen then cashed the A and K, pitching diamonds from dummy, and ruffed a fourth round, setting up the two long spades in his hand. He then gave East his club trick and claimed -- dummy's two losing hearts would go on the established spades.

Plus 1380 was good for a 16-IMP gain. At the other table, the slam was played from the South side. With the ♥K lead, the slam was doomed. It was not enough, however, as their opponents -- the Jimmy Cayne squad -- won handily, 138-104.

Be prepared

When one line of play fails, you have to be ready with another. Brian Gunnell was prepared on this deal from the second final session of the IMP Pairs.

Gunnell won the opening spade lead, pitching a club, and ruffed a spade. He took a finesse to the trump 8 in an attempt to get an extra entry to dummy. It worked, so he ruffed another spade. After crossing to the trump jack, he ruffed another spade, but the suit didn't drop. Time to look for something else.

He crossed to the A and took a heart finesse, also a success. Then he led a second club, and East was forced to win. He had to lead a heart to give declarer a third heart trick and his contract.

Of course East could have made it more difficult by dropping the king under the A, but then West would have risen with the queen on the next club lead to swallow East's jack, a so-called crocodile coup.



Limbrick, a technical writer who does a lot of contract work in Colorado Springs.

Miller works as an editor and translater for Berlitz Translations, working in Latin, Italian, French and German

She recalls playing in a tournament in Baltimore when she was in school. "There were a lot of angry players," Miller said, "and it turned me off. I played only party bridge after that."

That was, until Limbrick called and invited her to play in the NABC.

Her experience this time has been positive. "We're having a blast," Miller said, "and Bob is great." She was referring to Bob Bratcher, a tournament director who is working the I/N games at the NABC.

Robert Fogarty of Andover MA and Susan Kraght of Seattle, who formed a partnership in the hallway earlier in the tournament, were thrilled to have won the 299er game Saturday afternoon. Earlier in the week, they had braved the IMP Pairs game.

Betty Bratcher gives much of the credit for the success of the I/N program to Marilyn Anderson, local I/N chairman for the NABC.

Said Bratcher of Anderson: "She got out and beat the bushes."

After taking bridge classes in 1994, Anderson decided she wanted to teach the game, too. The World Bridge Championships played in Albuquerque that year included a Teacher Accreditation Program taught by Audrey Grant. Anderson signed up and loved it.

For a year and a half after that, she taught bridge at the Duke City Duplicate Bridge Club in Albuquerque. At one point, she realized that there was no novice program at the club, so she and another player started one.

Now she has a thriving novice game each Monday morning at Duke City, and she's teaching bridge through the continuing education program at the University of New Mexico.

Anderson is committed because she believes the I/N program is vital to the long-term viability of the ACBL. "Our future is in our students and getting them interested in duplicate bridge," she said.

Anderson still plays when she gets a chance, but it's not easy fitting that in with teaching and traveling with her husband David, who is retired.

Teaching and helping promote bridge are passions with Anderson. "I love it," she said. "I've done a lot of volunteer work for other people. This is something I'm doing for myself."

No place to stay
