Russia-Poland team victorious in Open BAM

Andrew Gromov and Aleksander Petrunin of Russia came to Boston last year for the final of the Internet World Bridge Championship, but they went home disappointed after losing to the United States team in the final. This year there will be no "if only" syndrome. Two years ago Cezary Balicki and Adam Zmudzinski of Poland got to the final of the Spingold only to lose to the Nick Nickell team – by a single IMP. But they won't be saying "if only" either. Together the foursome conquered a strong field to win the Open Board-a-Match Teams.

It was a hard-fought battle – they were less than a board ahead of Eddie Wold, George Rosenkranz, Sam Lev, John Mohan, Piotr Gawrys (Poland) and Jacek Pszczola (Poland). Only fractionally behind in third place were George Jacobs, Ralph Katz, George

Texans cruise to win in Women's Board-a-Match

An all-Texas team built a two-board lead into a victory margin of 6.93 boards while coasting to a win in the Women's Board-a-Match Teams.

The team – Petra Hamman, Peggy Sutherland and Joan Jackson, all of Dallas; Robin Klar, Spring; Shawn Quinn, Katy, and Mildred Breed, Bryan – has already won two major women's events in 2000: the World Women's Bridge Olympiad and the Women's International Team Trials.

Hamman led from start to finish in the four-session event, finishing with a score of 39.78 to 32.85 for the runners-up: Hjordis Eythorsdottir, Huntsville AL; Carol Sanders, Nashville; Libby Fernandez, Northport AL; Judy Wadas, Chicago, and Valerie

Bridge a challenge for woman teacher in Saudi Arabia

Eleanor Sherwyn has made bridge a major part of her life in a country where this is difficult to do. Goodwill Committee Chairman Aileen Osofsky honored Sherwyn at yesterday's Goodwill Committee meeting by naming her a Goodwill Committee member.

"Ordinarily ACBL Board members name players from their district to this committee," said Osofsky. "But Saudi Arabia isn't in any district, so I'm making myself her district director and naming her."

Winning colored points is difficult when you spend most of your time in Saudi Arabia, but Eleanor is close – she needs three silver points. She was ready to play at a sectional trying to get those points, but when she heard about the Goodwill honor, she got on the first plane and flew to Birmingham. She's heading back to the sectional today.

Her bridge adventures started when her husband Raymond accepted a job with Aramco in Saudi Arabia. Ray had plenty to do and their son Chris was

Gayle wins points in every session

Gayle Cole of Birmingham played in her first duplicate ever last Thursday in the Charity Pairs. She now has played in six events, and she has scored masterpoints in every one. She already has about nine points, a remarkable achievement for a new duplicate player.

Note that we didn't say it was the first time she played bridge. She's been playing party bridge for many years. She gave up the game for about 25 years but came back when she started playing the Microsoft version of Internet bridge. She found a mentor – Maurice Joseph of Baton Rouge LA, and it was he who convinced her to try duplicate "I was going to come down and watch," she said, "but he came in from Baton Rouge and asked me to play with him." He was her partner in all six sessions.

"The first session was tough," said Cole. "I kept throwing cards into the middle of the table, and several times I bid out loud instead of using the bidding boxes. I got over that and I really like duplicate – but I still feel a little insecure. I guess I'll try the local club when this tournament is over. I hope I can find a partner."

To Uppercut or Not

An uppercut made the difference on this interesting deal from the final session of the Life Master Pairs.

World champion Jacek Pszczola of Poland found the only lead to give declarer a problem on this relatively straightforward deal. After the lead of the ♠K, declarer naturally worried about the diamond position. He decided his best chance was to duck and finesse the ♠J at trick two. This lost to Pinhas Romik's queen, and the ♠9 was returned. When declarer pitched a diamond, Pszczola ruffed with the 4. The ♦J was taken by dummy's ace, and declarer embarked on a crossruff. He played the ♣4 to his ace (eschewing the finesse) and ruffed a club. Romik ruffed with the 8 when declarer came off dummy with the ♦5, and this forced declarer's ♥9. Another club ruff was followed by the ♦6 from dummy. Romik's ♥6 did its dirty work when it forced declarer to overruff with the king. Pszczola's ♥10 now became the setting trick.

Note the layout of the heart spots – just enough to uppercut declarer's heart holding. The combination of Romik's non-overcall of 1♠ and Pszczola's fine lead of the ♠K gave declarer just enough rope to hang himself.

En route to the title

Clearly Shawn Quinn and Mildred Breed had many fine boards en route to their runaway victory in the Life Master Women's Pairs – their second title in a row in this event. Here are a couple of deals that stood out in their minds as they celebrated their triumph. The first is from the second qualifying session.

After Breed opened a 15-17 notrump, Quinn liked her hand – good honor cards plus a spade suit that had a good chance of running. She thought it was worth checking out slam prospects, even though some would feel she was a trifle light for this action. If Breed had been looking at a minimum, she would have signed off in 4NT, but she had a maximum with most of her points in top honors. That was enough for Quinn – she jumped to 6♣, suggesting this as the final contract if partner fit spades. Breed did not fit spades, so she corrected to 6NT.

Chances of taking 12 tricks were reasonable no matter what the opening lead was, but the actual lead of the ♣J took off a lot of the pressure. Two clubs were a sure thing, and when the jack-10 fell tripleton, there were three club tricks to go with five spades, two hearts and two diamonds.

Quinn found the killing lead on this deal from the second final session.

Most Wests led a spade or a diamond, which resulted in 10 quick tricks for declarer. Quinn felt she needed to find something in her partner's hand that she could help. She decided hearts provided the best chance, even though she had only three. As a result, she and Breed took the first four tricks, holding declarer to plus 600, an excellent matchpoint result.

That Zia hand

Remember the hand published in the Sunday Daily Bulletin (page 3) about the fine play made by Zia in a 6♥ contract? Remember that Zia got a tie for top on the board? A friend of Charles Durrin of Huntsville AL came by the Daily Bulletin office to tell us that Durrin earned the tie for top with Zia by playing 6♥ card for card the way Zia did.

Ruffs aren't always rough

This was the key hand from the Iron Bowl Bracket 2 Knockout Teams final. On the winning team were Riva and Elliot Sternlicht, Melanie Tucker and Kent Mignocchi, all of New York City.

Dummy won the ♦Q opening lead, and the declarer, Riva, cashed the ♦K, pitching a club as West ruffed. West exited with the ♥Q, won in dummy, and Riva led a diamond, ruffed with the 9. West scored his second ruffing trick by overtrumping with the 10. West got out with his last trump, and this was the six-card ending:

When declarer led her singleton club, West was endplayed. If he ducks, declarer's club loser goes away and declarer loses just one spade trick. West therefore won the ace and returned a club. Taking her only chance, Riva finessed the ♣J. When this held, she pitched her two spade losers on dummy's clubs.

It's a hard play to find, but west could have avoided the endplay by cashing the ♣A after overruffing at trick seven.

Bidding ZT

You can actually bid "Zero Tolerance" at the Scottsdale Bridge Club in Arizona.

Yellow Zero Tolerance cards are in the bid boxes and they have had a positive influence on behavior, according to club owner Jan Bricklin.

Players are asked to flash a ZT card to an offending player (or players) when they feel intimidated or abused. If the bad manners continue, the offended player can call the director and get a ZT ruling.

"There are too many new players who are simply afraid to call the director when unruly behavior occurs," said Bricklin. "These cards can be very useful. I think they are a very good reminder."

Diamond Life Masters

Naida Lamb of Oak Ridge TN became a Diamond Life Master playing with her favorite partner, Jane McCoin.

Her victory in the first round of the NABC Senior Knockout Teams earned Ann Clay of Little Rock AR sufficient points to make her a Diamond Life Master.

Moving to bridge from backgammon

Laila Leonhardt of Copenhagen, Denmark, is in the process of making a couple of major changes in her life. She is a backgammon expert, but she is switching her attention solely to bridge. She is a citizen of Denmark, but she now spends most of her time in the United States. She is here in Birmingham where she is working as a recorder for Richard Schwartz and Drew Casen

Her backgammon background is strong – her standing in the game was sufficient for her to get a special talented athlete visa. She is on the panel of experts for Kit Woolsey's backgammon magazine. She was the first woman ever to win a master tournament in backgammon. She is a regular contributor to backgammon magazines in both Europe and the United States. She was in charge of keeping the world ranking list up to date.

She discovered bridge two years ago, and the game fascinates her. "I play online all the time," she says. She even has set up an online bridge club called Swangames.com. She had an interesting situation at a Raleigh regional – she as team captain had fewer masterpoints than one member of the team (George Jacobs) had seeding points.

"Recording for Richard and Drew is wonderful," she said. "It's a great way learn the game. I'm involved in every discussion, and you can learn so much when you can ask questions of experts and get insightful answers."

Wake-up call

Barnet Shenkin has joined the ranks of bridge authors. After all, if Michael Rosenberg, Martin Hoffman, Zia Mahmood and all those other transported British residents like me can do it, why not he?

His first-round encounter in the Life Master Open Pairs came against Jill Meyers and Steve Garner. After collecting plus 300 on a partscore deal for almost all the matchpoints, Shenkin (West) had a chance to make it two in a row.

Garner led the ♠5 to the 3, jack and queen, and Shenkin returned the ♠10. Garner won his ace and shifted to the ♦J – and Shenkin ducked in both hands. Garner pressed on with the ♦A, as Meyers pitched a discouraging ♥5, and Garner exited with a third spade.

That let Shenkin cash the thirteenth spade and this exerted a little pressure on both defenders. This was the position as the last spade was led:

On the 13th spade, Meyers pitched the ♥2, Shenkin pitched a diamond and Garner let go the ♥6. Now Shenkin led a heart to the 9 and 10. He won the club return with dummy's ace, cashed the ♣K and played a heart to his ace, dropping the king. Now he cashed the ♥Q for plus 120 and another nice board.

Meyers was not upset; in fact, she thanked Shenkin for giving her a wake-up call and said she always did well after starting with a couple of zeros. (Since Meyers and Garner won the event, I guess she knew best.)

Wiegman no longer can do the things she used to do for bridge. She is bed-ridden, and she says she looks forward to hearing the phone ring because she can't go out any more. She was especially pleased when the phone rang yesterday. After Osofsky told her about the honor being conferred upon her, Wiegman asked Osofsky to "tell them I'm crying."

Wiegman has been a hard worker for the ACBL for 35 years. Joan Jacobson, author of the nominating letter, noted the following accomplishments: initiated progressive sectionals and simultaneous unit games, was instrumental in setting up a unit newsletter and served for a year as editor, helped change scoring at games from manual to computer, served as secretary of the District 17 board, served as a member of the Board of Governors for 22 years, worked with the committee whose aim it was to expand computer applications, and served as chairman of the Mesa Senior Regional three times.

Keech is an accomplished bridge player who has been involved in the organization of approximately 25 sectionals over the past 16 years, working in virtually every capacity, including chair. Keech volunteers his talents to district regionals and was Victoria's representative to District 19 for six years.

He is the editor and publisher of *The Bridge Buzz*, his area's newsletter. He donates the supplies, the printing costs, the paper and his time.

Linda Patton, who wrote the letter nominating Keech, added this: "John was chosen not only for these reasons, but more importantly for the intelligence, expertise, composure and dedication he brings to the unit meetings; for the diligence and effort given to the running of many tournaments (all accomplished with a smile); and specifically for the manner in which he conducts himself at the bridge table. All tasks performed by John are done with modesty and no thought of remuneration and recognition."

Mittelman, Peter Nagy, Lorenzo Lauria (Italy) and Alfredo Versace (Italy). In other words, foreign players were members of the top three finishers.

It was the first North American victory for the Russians, but the Poles won the Spingold championship in 1997. The Poles, both Grand Masters in the World Bridge Federation, have an impressive record in international competition. They were first in the Transnational Teams in Bermuda this year and second in the World Team Olympiad in the Netherlands, also this year. They have a second and a third in the Bermuda Bowl and a second in the Rosenblum Teams. They also have a third in the World Open Pairs. Add to that a first and a third in the Sunday Times Pairs, and a second and a third in the European Teams.

Balicki used to be a professional chess player – he twice won the Polish Junior championship – but now he's strictly into bridge. Zmudzinski works in a money exchange.

The Russians are quite young – Gromov is 30 and Petrunin is only 28. They were members of the Russian team that surprised by finishing tied for fifth in the World Team Olympiad in Greece in 1996. Gromov, who works in the family radio business in Moscow, also was third this year in the World Individual and third in the European Mixed Teams.

Petrunin, a sales manager in St. Petersburg, finished third in the World Junior Championships in Hamilton ON and also had a second place in the European Junior Championships.

Westheimer, New York.

The Texans have had a super tournament so far; Quinn and Mildred won their second straight Life Master Women's Pairs title while Jackson and Klar finished second.

Goodwill highlights

Reba Jernigan opened the meeting with a tribute to the late Jane Johnson, who was in charge of the club membership department at the ACBL. Goodwill Chairman Aileen Osofsky then asked for a moment of prayer for Johnson and Jan Weyant, who also died recently.

ACBL President Glenn Smith told what it's like to be the president – "You spend your life in a hotel room. My wife and I have spent about 150 nights in hotel rooms during the past year. But let me say that we've met some of the nicest people everywhere we've gone."

Smith pointed out that the biggest concentration of people in the ACBL is in the clubs. "The people in the clubs are what makes the ACBL work. It's up to all of us to encourage bridge at the local level. Let everybody know just how much fun bridge is. After all, if bridge isn't fun, why would we play it?"

ACBL CEO David Silber had some good news – "For the last two months our membership is inching upwards. We're not out of the woods, but we're moving in the right direction."

"I've done so little for bridge and bridge has done so much for me," said Norman Kay, the 2001 Player of the Year. "I've very much enjoyed my 55 years in bridge."

Ann West, Alan LeBendig and Jade Barrett offered suggestions on ways to make bridge more fun and more interesting.

Other speakers included District 10 Director Chuck Wilkinson and Tournament Co-Chairman Clay Hall. Osofsky congratulated the American and Canadian teams that won medals at the World Championships in the Netherlands this year. She also introduced the members of the U.S. Women's Olympiad team, victors in the World Women's Team Olympiad.



Ann West proved that it is possible to win and also be a tournament chairman. She and Richard Powell were the winners in Sunday's IMP Pairs.

New Life Masters

busy with school. However, Eleanor soon discovered that she had nothing to occupy her time. She learned that someone was giving bridge lessons, so she took up bridge and soon found that she had a natural aptitude for the game. But a problem arose – the teacher was going back to the United States so there would no more bridge in Dharhan.

Eleanor decided to do something about this, so on a trip back to the States she took the ACBL Teacher Accreditation Program course. Once she got back to Saudi Arabia she was ready to become the teacher the area so badly needed. Her classes consisted of from four to eight tables of novices.

Most of her students were American, but at one series a Saudi man came to learn the game. Of course he could not listen to a mere woman, so Ray sat at the back of the room with the Saudi student. The student faced him and had his back to Eleanor. Every time Eleanor said something to the class, the Saudi asked Ray, "What did she say?" Ray dutifully repeated what Eleanor said word for word. Although the Saudi was completely conversant with English, he was unable to accept anything out of the mouth of a woman.

It's not easy for a woman in Saudi Arabia, which is a male-dominated society. When Eleanor travels within the country, she must carry a letter from her husband giving her permission to travel without him.

Another problem: who could direct the games there? On another of her trips home, Eleanor took the director's course at an NABC and became certified. Now she's the official director of the Dharhan club as well.

She also realized it was difficult to get new players to compete in the open games – many of the regulars are very experienced players. So her next move was to institute a novice game, and that worked well also.

In addition to playing at the local club, Eleanor also gets in some extra bridge by logging into OKbridge.

It's true -- Eleanor has made bridge a major part of her life in a country where this is difficult to do.

Meyers and Mohan to defend Blue Ribbon Pairs title

Jill Meyers and John Mohan, the first mixed pair to win the Blue Ribbon Pairs since Dorothy Truscott and B. Jay Becker won the inaugural event in 1963, will seek a second title as play gets under way today.

Meyers and Mohan won the 1999 contest, finishing more than a board ahead of their nearest competitors, John Sutherlin and Russ Ekeblad.

It was the first Blue Ribbon win for both - Meyers' first North American victory in an open event and a key to Mohan claiming the 1999 *Player of the Year* title (awarded to the player who wins the most masterpoints in nationally rated events).

The months since Boston have been busy for both players. Meyers was a member of the team that finished second (by half an IMP) to the Dutch in the 2000 Venice Cup, played in Bermuda in January. She was second in the Generali World Masters tournament, played in Athens in April.

Then came the first of two trips to the Netherlands: Meyers and her Venice Cup team (partner Randi Montin and teammates Janice Seamon-Molson, Tobi Sokolow, Renee Mancuso and Pam Wittes, Wittes replacing Shawn Quinn, and non-playing captain Jo Morse) traveled to The Hague in July for a rematch with the Dutch world champions. The U.S. won the 108-board match by a score of 424-405.

Meanwhile, Mohan and his team (partner John Sutherlin and teammates Bobby Wolff, Dan Morse, Kit Woolsey and Steve Robinson) won the Senior Team Trials. They added Betty Ann Kennedy as their non-playing captain and set out for the Netherlands.

They won the Senior World Cup and claimed gold for the U.S.

Meyers, making her second trip to the Netherlands, teamed with Mohan for the World Transnational Mixed Teams, played at the same world championship. The e-bridge team (Meyers--Mohan, Irina Levitina--Sam Lev, Migry Tzur-Campanile--Piotr Gawrys with Pinhas Romik as npc) won gold.

After the forcing 1NT, North got to describe his black two-suiter. Mohan, East, led the ♦Q: 4, 8, 3.

Since the queen held the trick, Mohan knew that Meyers had started with ♦A 10 8, and declarer with a singleton.

Mohan switched to the ♣9, a suit-preference signal in their methods, indicating a high spade. Declarer ducked in dummy and Meyers won the king.

She dutifully returned a spade to the jack and Mohan's singleton king. Mohan exited with a low heart, taken in dummy with the king so declarer could take another spade finesse. Declarer apparently changed his mind about finessing and played his ♠A. Mohan ruffed and the rest was brutal.

A heart return was ruffed by Meyers, who played a club, removing dummy's last trump. Declarer ruffed a diamond to his hand and faced a miserable situation. He drew Meyers' last trump but was forced to lead a spade into the jaws of Meyers' spade holding.

She won and played the ♦A which declarer ruffed. Declarer was again forced to lead another spade to Meyers, finishing down four for minus 400.

The event

The Blue Ribbon Pairs ranks with the Life Master Pairs as the most prestigious -- and toughest -- pair event on the ACBL calendar. Like the LM Pairs, the Blue Ribbon is played over three days and includes two qualifying, two semifinal and two final sessions.

The Blue Ribbon Pairs was renamed the Edgar Kaplan Blue Ribbon Pairs in 1999 to honor one of bridge's all-time great players, writers, administrators and the authority on the laws of the game.
