Newt Bowers is no doctor, so he doesn't know how much danger he was in Monday, but he does know one thing - "my condition wasn't good."

Thanks to quick action by ACBL staffers and a registered nurse who happened by, Bowers' medical emergency didn't become a tragedy.

Here's what happened. Bowers and wife Jean, of Clive IA near Des Moines, were on their way from the Regal Hotel to the Goodwill Day reception at the Hyatt Regency.

Bowers, a diabetic on insulin, had taken a drink in his room just before leaving. On the second floor of the hotel near the snack bar, Bowers went into insulin shock. As he leaned against the

wall in a cold sweat, tremors came on and eventually he slumped to the floor.

One of the first people to notice the emergency was Anne Hedden, an RN who told Jean she knew what was going on. "She said she had seen the situation many times," Jean said.

Internet world championship ready to take off

The second annual Internet World Bridge Championships will begin soon with matches in all sections of the world. The two teams that survive the North American and European competitions will be brought to Birmingham AL for the final on Wednesday, Nov. 16 – the day before the opening of the Fall NABC in that city.

This will be an open teams event, with teams representing specific countries. No more than onethird of a team may be from outside the the country represented. The teams will be divided into eight regions – three from the United States; three from Europe; one (World Region 7) that includes Canada, Mexico, Bermuda, Central America, South America and the Caribbean, and one (World Region 8) that includes Africa, Asia, the Middle East, the Far East and the South Pacific

The three American winners plus the victor in

Region 7 will battle in quarterfinals and semifinals to determine one finalist. The Region 8 winner will vie with the three European victors for the other final berth.

Teams may include up to six players plus a nonplaying captain. Teams from within the United States will represent states, and the team captain may designate the state the team is representing. There must be more members from the home state than any other state on American teams.

ACBL masterpoints will be given to the players on teams that reach the quarterfinals. The following masterpoint schedule will be in effect: first place, 50; second, 37.5; third, 27.5; fourth, 22.5; fifth through eighth, 11.25. Match awards of two points will be given to winners of matches beginning with the Round of 32. However, there will be no match

Truscotts out front in Mixed Pairs

Dorothy and Alan Truscott of New York City led 156 qualifiers into today's two-session final of the NABC Mixed Pairs. Two strong sessions earned them a 41-point lead after the two qualifying sessions. Top on a board yesterday was 64, so the Truscotts finished ahead by approximately twothirds of a board. In second place were Joan Jackson of Dallas and Roger Bates of Mesa AZ. The mother-son combination of Jill and Joel Wooldridge were third, another 55 points back. Their lead over Gene Simpson of Redlands CA and Betsey Schneider of San Carlos CA was only one and a half points. Those were the only four pairs who cracked the 2000-point barrier.

Shugart foursome bounced from Vanderbilt

The high-flying team captained by Rita Shugart made an early exit from the Vanderbilt Knockout Teams, losing by 48 to the Joe Quinn squad in the round of 32.

The new No. 3 seed is the team of Quinn, Ira Hessel, Sid Brownstein, William Wickham, Alan Le Bendig and Jon Brissman.

Shugart, Andy Robson, Geir Helgemo and Tony Forrester were among the favorites in the Vanderbilt after winning their second straight Reisinger Boarda-Match Teams last fall in Boston.


The foursome fell behind, 26-23, after one quarter and never recovered, losing every set on their way to a 145-97 defeat.

Form prevailed in the other matches, as the topseeded George Jacobs team won by 76. The No. 2 seed, the reigning Bermuda Bowl champs captained by Nick Nickell, also cruised, 174-86, and No. 4 (James Cayne) won handily, 150-97.

The No. 6 seed, captained by Grant Baze, trailed at the half, 56-54, against the William Doroshow squad. The Baze team crushed their opponents in the second half, outscoring the underdogs 155-30, for a 209-86 rout.

The No. 7 seed, led by John Mohan, survived a close match -- and an appeals committee -- to prevail, 156-154.

One match was to be completed today. The No. 13 seed (John Onstott) ended regulation tied at 98 with No. 20 (Steve Levinson). The match was still deadlocked (116-116) after an eight-board overtime set, and the teams were scheduled to play another eight boards starting at noon today.

South had no idea what was in store for him when he made the reasonable lead of the $\blacklozenge Q$. Hirshman took this and proceeded to run all eight trumps. That forced South to come down to four cards. He had to keep three spades – otherwise dummy's spades could be run after the marked spade finesse. So he had to blank the $\clubsuit K$. Now Hirshman took the spade finesse and cashed the $\blacklozenge A$. Now North felt the crunch. He was forced to come down to two cards. He could see that dummy was down to the $\blacklozenge J$ and a club, so he had save the $\blacklozenge A$ and throw a club. So Hirshman led to the $\clubsuit A$, dropping the king and the jack, and cashed the good $\bigstar 3$ for his 13th trick.

Dick Budd, playing with Robert Ryder, found an opportunity for not one but two nice plays on the same deal in the first final session of the Silver Ribbon Pairs.

On the opening lead of the \bigstar A and a spade continuation, Budd carefully ruffed high, then drew two trumps, ending in dummy with the \bigstar 9 to ruff another spade. A heart to dummy with the \bigstar A to ruff and a diamond to the ace let him draw the last trump and cash the fourth trump, pitching a heart from his hand. The last trump squeezed East in the red suits – Budd did not have to guess whether to finesse in diamonds since East had to pitch one to keep a guard against the \bigstar 9. Plus 620 was a fair score for North-South.

A dummy reversal plus a squeeze might seem like an unusual theme. Not so. Look at Dick Fleischman and Marty Baff at work.

On a top heart lead, ruffed, and a trump to the jack, East had a chjoice of defenses (ducking makes declarer's life tougher, and of course there is a spade ruff to be had), but East won his A and returned a heart. Declarer ruffed, cashed the K and crossed to the A to draw the last trump. Now he cashed the Q, pitching a spade. He crossed to the J and cashed the A in this position:

If the king had failed to fall, Hardy still would have been OK as long as trumps broke 3-2. But playing the ace first gave her an extra chance.

Bid Box Alerts and Announcements

When using bid boxes, ACBL suggests that players tap the Alert strip and say "Alert" at the same time. When making an announcement, use the announcement word -- such as "transfer" -and tap the Alert strip at the same time. A player who Alerts or announces a bid should make sure his opponents are aware that an Alert or announcement has been made.

Run your long suit!

Quite often it pays for declarer to run his long suit – it often puts intolerable pressure on the defense. That's what Ralph Cohen, former CEO of the ACBL, did on this deal from the second final session of the Silver Ribbon Pairs



Cohen got off dummy with a heart, taken by North. He switched to a club, and South took his two club tricks. Whether or not he cashed his high heart, South still had to break the diamonds. Cohen guessed right – he played low from dummy, forcing the king. That made dummy's $\blacklozenge Q$ the game-going trick.

What happens if North ducks the heart and lets South win the jack with the king? Once again South will cash two clubs, forcing Cohen to make a discard in this position:



He can't pitch a diamond – a diamond return would force the ace. When he then led a heart, North would take the setting trick with the \mathbf{A} . So he must throw a heart, and this frustrates the defense. Either at the next trick or the one after, the defense has to

The bad breaks in the majors would seem to at least make life difficult for Shenkin, but he shrugged off the nasty splits to bring home the contract.

West led the \mathbf{A} to Shenkin's ace. He played the $\bigstar K$ at trick two to East's ace. The $\bigstar J$ was next, followed by a third round of the suit, ruffed by Shenkin. He got the bad news in trumps when he cashed the $\blacklozenge Q$. Undaunted, he continued with a heart to dummy's king (it would not have profited West to ruff) and a club to his jack.

Shenkin then cashed the \clubsuit A, and played a spade to dummy's 9. East was already starting to feel the pressure, and it became unbearable when Shenkin cashed the \bigstar J. This was the position:

Swedes are no turnips

They were delayed for a full day by the their flights from Sweden, but they are playing in the Vanderbilt with Mike Moss (now an honoary Scandinavian) and Bjorn Fallenius.

Lindkvist led the ♠7 (third and fifth best). When declarer played low from dummy, Fredin carefully followed low, too! Next came the ♣K-Q. Fredin could see that if he let this hold, declarer might turn his attention to hearts, and then dummy's ♥8 would eventually build up to be declarer's ninth trick. So Fredin took the second club and led the $\bigstar 10$, trying to disguise the blockage.

It worked! Declarer ducked. And now Fredin shifted to a low diamond. Declarer put in the 8 and Lindkvist won his queen to play a third spade. Now the defense could arrange to duck the first heart and win the next, cash their winners and get out with a diamond. That would enable them to collect a diamond trick in the ending.

Note that if Fredin plays the $\bigstar 10$ at trick one, the defense is much tougher. Fredin cannot attack spades again from his side, and the chances that declarer will build a ninth trick one way or another are dramatically increased.

"He needs sugar," Hedden told them.

"She just kind of took charge," said Jean.

Hedden helped the semi-conscious Newt get down some orange juice. "He couldn't swallow right away," Jean said.

Said Hedden, of Watkinsville GA, "He had all the classic signs of low blood sugar."

Tournament Director Mike Flader came by with a device that measures blood sugar, and they tested Newt.

Two other NABC staffers, Jeff Johnston and Brian Russell, were also very helpful, Jean said.

Newt eventually came around and was able to return to his room.

Hedden, who works at the Athens Regional Medical Center, said the situation could have been much more serious. "If he had passed out," she said, "he would have had to go to the hospital." Tom Marsh, another NABC staffer, told the Bowers, who were supposed to play in the second final session of the Silver Ribbon Pairs, that he would get word to the directors that they weren't going to make it for the evening session. Indeed, Newt slept for 12 hours after the incident.

Maastricht to feature University team event

The World University Teams Bridge Cup will be a featured new event at the World Team Olympiad championship tournament in Maastricht, the Netherlands, this summer. It will be played under the auspices of the FISU (Fédération Internatioanle des Sports Universitaires). There will be no entry fee.

The event will be played from Sunday, Aug. 27, to Saturday, Sept. 2, during the first week of the Olympiad. The minimum age is 17, the maximum 28.

The World Bridge Federation would like all entries to be submitted to the WBF office no later than May 1.



What was East to do on the play of the $\bigstar J$? A heart discard was out of the question, so he had to let go of a club. Shenkin then played the $\clubsuit Q$, leaving East on play in the two-card ending with the \mathbf{V} Q 10, while Shenkin had the \mathbf{V} J 5 in dummy and the $\mathbf{\Psi}$ A 7 in his hand.

Deadly combination

Bernie Chazen and Allan Cokin were completing their losing Vanderbilt match against the Brian Platnick team when Cokin complimented his opponents, Rich Rothwarf and Steve Goldstein.

"You guys played well," Cokin said, "and you deserve to win."

"Well," said Rothwarf, "you were a bit unlucky."

Chazen chimed in: "We were unlucky, but we also played like (bleep), and that combination is devastating."

After the worst of it was past, Johnston kidded Newt: "We need all the tables we can get, so we've got to get you well."

Newt, who was feeling fine on Tuesday, said he had never had such a seizure before. "I was beyond dizzy."

Newt retired four years ago from his job teaching actuarial science at Drake University. Now he and Jean travel the country playing bridge.

They were back at the table on Tuesday, looking forward to playing more and thankful to all the people who helped out in the mini-crisis.

"It was a great example of goodwill," said Jean. Said Hedden, "I'm glad I was able to help out."

The Facts: $2\bigstar$ went down one, plus 100 for N/S. The opening lead was the \bigstar A. The Director was called at the end of the auction. East agreed that there had been a 10-15 second pause. West did not dispute this at the time, but later said that she had not noticed the pause. The Director ruled that the tempo indicated that West would be better placed by bidding than by passing and that pass was a logical alternative. The contract was changed to $2\bigstar$ made three, plus 110 for N/S.

The Appeal: E/W appealed the Director's ruling. South did not attend the hearing. West stated that she did not notice the hesitation and that it was losing matchpoint tactics to pass 2. The vulnerability did not seem relevant to her.

East said that he thought about bidding over 1♥ but decided not to based on holding only 6 HCP. North told the Committee that West asked the Director when he arrived if it was too late to call him at the end of the auction. When the Director told her that it was not, she remarked that "someone should have warned her." West disputed this statement and told the Committee that she was a certified director (club level) and that she knew her obligations after a break in tempo.

The table Director was consulted. He told the Committee that when he was at the table the 10-15 second pause was not disputed by East and that West had said that she had not noticed any pause. She also inquired of him whether N/S had lost their rights to summon the Director since they had waited until the end of the auction.

The table Director pointed out to her that while it was acceptable to call the Director when a pause occurred, waiting until the end of the auction was also perfectly acceptable. She then asked him "should I not have been warned about this before making my second bid?" 2 bid was not allowed and the contract was changed to 2 made three, plus 110 for N/S.

The issue of an Appeal Without Merit Penalty Point and procedural penalty were also considered. The Committee ultimately decided that since West's hand was relatively close to an action without the break in tempo that neither would be assigned. West's faulty memory as to the facts coupled with the fact that as a director she could be expected to know her responsibilities as a player meant that she had brought herself exceedingly close to both.

The Facts: $4 \blacklozenge$ doubled went down one, plus 100 for E/W. The opening lead was the \clubsuit K. The Director was called when dummy was put down. East had repeated his double after the second explanation (which was the partnership agreement). North said that she had mis-sorted her hand and thought the \P K was the \clubsuit K. She did not realize this until she saw the dummy. The Director ruled that North was not in possession of any unauthorized information and allowed the table result to stand (Law 16).

The Appeal: E/W appealed the Director's ruling. They believed they had been misinformed about the N/S agreement because the $\diamond K$ was in the dummy and did not think that North should bid once her partner passed East's double. The Director had not been called when the explanation was corrected and East repeated his double. North said she had thought her $\forall K$ was the $\diamond K$ and that the pass by South had shown soft values. She bid because she believed the opponents' double.

The Committee Decision: The Committee believed that North had mis-sorted her hand and that E/W had an accurate explanation of the N/S agreement before doubling again. North had no unauthorized information. The information from the double was authorized information. E/W had no plus score of their own available above 4♦. The Committee allowed the table result to stand. A brief discussion of whether or not this was an appeal without merit took place, but because of the confusion in the auction and the mis-sorting the Committee did not believe a penalty was indicated.

awards for the teams that reach the final eight.

Monitors will be required beginning with the quarterfinals. Players on participating teams will be given OKbridge playing privileges from the date the team entry is paid until the team is no longer in the competition. The entry fee will be \$50 per team, plus \$5 per player who is an OKbridge tournament subscriber and \$10 per player from those who are not basic subscribers to OKbridge.

Conventions and carding rules are being set up in such a way as to allow what is common practice in worldwide competition. These rules will be published and will become part of the IWBC Conditions of Contest. Any participants wishing to use conventions or carding techniques not on the IWBC list must complete a convention card and post it on OKbridge for opponents to review at least 72 hours prior to the match.

Matches will be 24 boards long until the Round of 4 in each World Region. From that point on, 32board matches will be played. The final will be a 48-board match. Matches within world regions will random draw. The World round of eight will be seeded into two divisions – American and European. The tournament committee and the appeals committee will be composed of a minimum of one individual from each of the world regions.

Roy Green, former CEO of the ACBL who is now executive vice president of OKbridge, is tournament chairman. Other tournament officials: Gary Blaiss, chief tournament director; appeals and systems chairman, Richard Colker; publicity chairman, Henry Francis; deputy chief tournament director, Tony Reus.

The United States won the first IWBC, defeating a strong Russian team in the final in Boston last November.

Mott-Smith Trophy honors best performer at Spring NABC

The Mott-Smith Trophy is awarded each year to the player with the best overall individual performance at the Spring NABC.

John Sutherlin holds the record -- 300 masterpoints won at the 1990 Spring NABC in Fort Worth. Last year's winner was Petra Hamman who won 265 other "par" bridge events.

He worked with Ely Culbertson in the organization of the United States Bridge Association and with William E. McKenney in the early days of the ACBL.

The trophy was donated by friends in memory of Geoffrey Mott-Smith in 1961 and made retroactive to 1958 to include all the winners.

Mott-Smith (1902-1960) was co-chairman of the ACBL Laws Commission, editor of the ACBL Bridge Bulletin 1935-36, a contributor to The Bridge World, a writer and cryptographer.

Mott-Smith was one of the first to operate a bridge club and to direct bridge tournaments. He was the director of the annual intercollegiate tournaments and

During World War II, Mott-Smith served as chief instructor for the OSS in the training of cryptographers and cryptanalysts.

He authored or co-authored more than 29 books on games and served as games consultant for the Association of American Playing Card Manufacturers.

Mott-Smith was regarded as a great player, brilliant theorist and one of the soundest and most lucid of the early writers on contract bridge.

The Mott-Smith Trophy winners since 1968 are listed along with their point totals. An asterisk indicates the record was broken that year.
