

Radin, Moss victors in Women's Pairs

Judi Radin and Sylvia Moss, both of New York City, took top honors in the NABC Women's Pairs by almost two boards. "We played for 75 minutes and sat two hours on the couch," said Judi, indicating how fast they play as a pair. They finished more than 42 points (25 top) ahead of Tobi Sokolow of Austin TX and Janice Seamon-Molson of Miami. Kerri Sanborn of Stony Point NY and Karen McCallum of Exeter NH were only six points further back.

Judi and Sylvia had four good sessions. They were third after the first qualifying session, and they went into the final in second place. They took over the top spot in the first final session, and they stayed on top.

Judi has been a frequent winner over the years. Does it still feel good to win? "It's always thrilling – it always feels just like it did the first time I won

Gromov-Rosenkranz in Vanderbilt final

The Russian-Polish team captained by Andrew Gromov outscored the Nick Nickell team 66-19 in the fourth quarter to gain a berth against the George Rosenkranz team in today's Vanderbilt final.

Rosenkranz used a 38-5 third quarter to gain the lead against the Rita Shugart squad and held on for a 123-113 victory.

Gromov's four-man squad (Aleksander Petrunin, Cezary Balicki-Adam Zmudzinski) won the Open Board-a-Match Teams at the Fall NABC in Birmingham last year. Here in Kansas City, they've continued their winning ways. They came from far behind (down 56 after 16 boards) to oust Billy Eisenberg & Co. 186-165 in Thursday's quarterfinal. In Wednesday's Round of 16, they defeated the team captained by

People everywhere are watching us

Bridge enthusiasts all over the world are following the Vanderbilt, thanks to e-bridge and ACBL Online. They can watch the bidding and play almost as soon as it happens, have a little time to check for analysis, and then hear expert analysis from experts around the world.

Here's how it works. Jesus Arias of New York City, e-bridge systems manager, and Rich Laufer of New York City, e-bridge marketing director, select the match they think will be the best of the day. A runner brings the results from the match that's being displayed on the Internet to the e-bridge room at the Hyatt. Arias, who is known to his co-workers as Zeus, prepares about five hands at a time and puts them on the Internet. The hand presentation usually is less than 45 minutes behind the actual playing time.

The material also is sent to the commentators – people like Eric Kokish of Canada, Sally Brock of England, P.O. Sundelin of Sweden, Drew Cannell of Canada, Danny Kleinman of the U.S., Marc Smith of England, John Gowdy of Canada and Anders Wirgren of Sweden. Since this NABC is running at the same time as the European Pair Championships in Sorrento,

Willenken, Smith win Open Pairs II

Chris Willenken and Ron Smith overcame horrible results on their first three boards in the first final session of Open Pairs II and went on to win the event.

On the first board of the afternoon, Willenken-Smith went minus 800. On the second board, they played 3NT making three when 4♠ was cold. On the third board, they went minus 800 again.

At this point, their kibitzer left.

Despite that start, "we were able to stay focused and not do silly stuff trying to get it back," said Willenken.

In fact, they posted a 56% game in the afternoon and added on a 60% game in the second final session for a total of 2102.01 matchpoints.

Joe Kivel and Chris Larsen were second with 2045.10, followed by Russell Samuel and Eric Balkam with 2020.59 and Michael Huston and Robert Schwartz with 2002.36. These four pairs were the only ones to top 2000 matchpoints.

West led the ♠6. East won his ace and shifted to the ♦K. Machotka won his ace and led the ♥9: 4, 6, king. East returned the ♠J and Machotka won his king. Now he cashed the ♥Q and played a heart to the ace. He played a club to his king and a club back, inserting dummy’s ♣9.

East won the ♣J and returned a spade. Machotka pitched a diamond and ruffed in dummy. This was the four-card ending:

Machotka cashed the ♥J and pitched a diamond from his hand. He turned to his left-hand opponent and said, “It’s over. You’re through.”

The situation is a classic criss-cross squeeze. If West discards a diamond, Machotka cashes the ♦Q and goes back to dummy with the ♣A to cash the now-good ♦9.

If West discards a club, Machotka cashes dummy’s ♣A and crosses to his hand with the ♦Q to cash the now-good ♣10.

Disappearing ace

This deal helped Steve Catlett and me to win the Silver Ribbon Pairs.

As you can see North made a winning decision not to compete. 3♠ would go down unless East took a trump finesse after winning the opening heart lead with the ace. It appears that 3♦ also is headed for a one-trick set – won’t I lose a spade, a heart, a diamond and a couple of clubs?

After ruffing the second spade, I led the ace-king of diamonds and then the ♥Q. West ducked both the queen and the jack of hearts, trying to keep me from using dummy’s fourth heart. I played a club to the 7 and 10. East returned a high spade, ruffed. Now the ♣A and a club to the queen and king left East with only spades to lead. I chucked my ♥10 and West could ruff or not. The ♥A had gone bye-bye!

3rd annual Internet tourney ready

The third annual Internet World BridgeTeam Championship, sponsored primarily by OKbridge, will take place for the rest of this year. Teams already are signing up with OKbridge. The contest features knockout matches throughout, with matches occurring approximately once a month. The final will be held December 8-9. Entries close April 15, and play will start immediately afterward. Signups are available at

Each team represents a specific country. The country can be the nation in which (1) any player was born, (2) any member is a citizen, or (3) any player is a resident.

Last year 186 teams from 50 countries competed, with Rumania winning the championship by defeating the United States in the final.

Players may form teams with whomever they wish and may choose their playing zone. Masterpoints will be awarded by the ACBL, with 50 points going to the victors.

The fee is \$75 per team, with non-mabers paying a \$25 surcharge. Non-members receive OKbridge memberships from the time the team registers until the team is knocked out or until June 15, whichever is later.

East led the ♦7: 3, 10, queen. Mark led the ♣8, ducked around to West’s queen. He exited with a low heart to the king and ace. The ♦6 came back and Mark won dummy’s ace. He cashed the ♥Q, pitching his losing diamond.

Next came the ♣J, covered by the king and ace. Mark ruffed a club, ruffed a heart and led another club. East, with no good discard, ruffed with the ♠9 and Mark overruffed with dummy’s ♠Q. He led another heart and West ruffed with the ♠K. Mark overruffed with the ♠A, gave up a spade and claimed 10 tricks. Plus 170 was worth most of the matchpoints.

“They didn’t give me the greatest defense,” he said, “but it’s a hard hand to defend.”

Timing was the key on this deal from the first final session.

North led the ♣Q and Mark won dummy’s ace. He played a low diamond to his jack and North’s ace. Another club came back, again won in dummy.

Mark led the ♠J, covered by the king and ace. Next he led a low diamond and put in dummy’s ♦7, won by South with his king. South cashed the ♥A K and exited with a third heart. Mark won in dummy and led a high diamond, ruffed and overruffed. Mark cashed the ♠Q, ruffed a spade and played diamonds from the top. Plus 140 was worth almost all the matchpoints.

Attendance report

The news is not good today. Even though it would seem that attendance might be up because it’s the beginning of a weekend, attendance actually was down substantially. Only 944.5 tables were in play yesterday, a drop of 72 from the day before. The total to date for Kansas City 2001 is 7968 tables. That is well below the 8496.5 table total at the same point in Kansas City 1993.

Richard Schwartz 144-139.

Rosenkranz, at 85 the oldest man ever to reach the final of a major North American team event, is playing with John Mohan, Sam Lev and Poland's Piotr Gawrys and Jacek Pszczola. They were one of the four teams (Nickell, Rose Meltzer and George Jacobs) that were forced to play an extra 16 boards Thursday night when the boards were distributed to the wrong tables for the third quarter.

About 3:30 a.m. Friday, Rosenkranz came from behind to defeat Jacobs 120-118. Both teams thought they had lost and congratulated each other. The Kansas City recount, however, showed Rosenkranz on top.

That was also the case 25 years ago when Rosenkranz and Mohan won the 1976 Vanderbilt with Roger Bates, Larry Cohen and Richard Katz.

Rosenkranz oldest ever in KO final

The Bull's day of light grazing on the range with the little calves was brutally upset by the defeat of the reigning Bermuda Bowl champions and defending Vanderbilt champion Nickell. A replayed five quarter quarterfinal left a tired six-handed #1 Nickell to play four-handed original #12 Gromov. Nickell stayed with Gromov through the first half and then blasted away with a 51-IMP 3rd quarter to lead by 40 going into the last 16. However, the Eastern European Russians and Poles, Gromov-Petrudin and Balicki-Zmudzinski, playing in memory of the Space Station Mir, pounded arguably the world's best front four, MeckWell and HamWay, by 47 in the fourth quarter to be the last team standing at the end of an incredibly exciting match. How much gas came out of the Nickell tank during the organizer-inflicted fifth quarter of the quarterfinal?

In the other semifinal: upset quarterfinal winner #10 Rosenkranz played solidly against Lady Shugart and her bandaged band of Robin Hoods. It was Shugart by 24 at the half, but Gawrys and Pszczola with Lev-Mohan had a super second half to win by 9. As to Air Shugart, kudos for yet another fine showing in a major team event. Helgy-Forrester, Rita and Wild Bruce lost a tight match to Rosenkranz, but demonstrated that the adversity of losing teammate and npc Robson to tragic injury could be alchemized to positive motivation. The Bull roots for Robson to heal quickly and show up at the gate for the Toronto Spingold.

At an all-time record oldest age of 85, Hall of Famer Dr. Jorge Rosenkranz, co-inventor of the birth control pill and chairman of the first drug company to market cortisone, is once again in a Vanderbilt final. Although Dr. Jorge claims the process of aging forces prioritization of mental faculties to conserve energy focus for large swing hands, his beloved Romex bidding system allows him and his red-hot partner, John Mohan, great comfort in the bidding. In a remarkable *deja vu*, the Bull recalls the 1975 Honolulu Vanderbilt and the 1976 K.C. Vanderbilt being won by a team with John Mohan and Dr. Jorge. He was elected to the Hall of Fame last year in Anaheim, so the Bull asks all the livestock to take a moment and recognize the talents of Dr. Jorge, a man who has truly left his mark, not only a mark on bridge, and not merely a mark on the 20th century, but actually an eternal contribution to profit all mankind.

In the final of the Vanderbilt, it's Cinderella original #12, now #1 Gromov, against original #10, now #2 Rosenkranz.

Congratulations to the Russian Gromov-Petrudin and Polish Balicki-Zmudzinski who have a record of 1st, 4th, and 3/4th in the last three NABC open team events. Pay close attention to the halftime score. The Bull sees a tight match early, with a small chance the tired five-handed Rosenkranz gets blown out early. However, one can not root against Gentleman George. Rosenkranz by 1 in an upset.

As a consolation prize, Nickell heads to Memphis for the U.S. Team Trials and emerges triumphant as the U.S. representative to the Bali, Indonesia, Bermuda Bowl. Meckwell, HamWay and Nicky'n Dickie are merely the most successful team in the history of the ACBL. It's just Dr. Jorge's turn to win one more time -- the oldest competitor becomes the oldest champion.

The Bull is packing up, but he wants to take a moment to thank all his Kansas City area friends for a fabulous job of hosting the Spring 2001 NABC.

Not-so-blue Jay

I breakfasted with Jay Stiefel, fresh from his narrow loss to Meltzer, and he pushed the obligatory pieces of paper across the table.

Put on your thinking cap – you are going to be given two challenging contracts to play.

(1) Denies a top heart honor.

In 3NT on a top heart lead, it seems to me you have a choice. You could go for the psychological line of crossing to the ♠K to try to sneak a low club past East. Or you could duck a club, win the third heart and then play on spades. The upside here is that if West has exactly a 2-5-4-2 shape without the ♠Q, three rounds of spades squeeze him.

Jay decided to go for this line but he took the infinitesimal improvement that made this hand a serious candidate for an award. At trick two he cashed the ♦A – and the ♦J dropped.

Now he crossed to the ♦10 and finessed the ♠J and though it lost, the 3-3 spade split made life easy. This was the full deal:

As you can see, this is the only line that works here. Jay said that he was playing a young team and at this point in the match, they led by 20 IMPs. After this deal, Stiefel's team outscored them 120-9.

From the win against Marty Fleisher's tough quartet comes a deal where Walter Shafer took a bid (or two) too many and left it to Jay to pick up the pieces.

On the merciful heart lead, Stiefel pitched his diamond loser at once. Now how do you cope with the potential bad splits?

The question is whether to cash the ♣A K or just one of them, or whether to ruff diamonds at once, or to delay the process. Give it a moment's thought before you decide.

Jay actually cashed the ♣A and ruffed a club, dropping East's queen. Now he ruffed a diamond, ruffed a club high (as East threw a heart), ruffed a diamond (as

Italy, half the commentators are working on each tournament.

They go over the bidding and play and check out the alerts as they prepare their commentary. When they're satisfied, they send it to e-bridge where it is checked over by Quality Control, which is handled by people like Beverly Kraft. Once the commentary gets an OK, it goes onto the Internet. New material usually is sent out at least twice a day.

An interesting point – all this material is archived. If anyone wants to find out what happened on a hand that took place in last year's Olympiad, they can find it in the archive. The full records of the following tournaments are in the archives: all recent NABCs, the Olympiad, the International Olympic Committee special game in Switzerland, the NEC Cup in Japan, the China Cup, Cap Gemini and Forbo. e-bridge is going to do the World Junior Championship in Brazil and the WBF World Championships in Bali this fall.

e-bridge has sent out a match every day throughout this tournament. They featured Open Pairs I the first two days, and since then they have chosen a Vanderbilt match to feature each day.

Remember the runner we mentioned earlier? He is 11-year-old Adam Massey of Kansas City, who plays bridge and has interested his friends in playing the game. His ambition is to work for e-bridge when he grows up. It's a bridge family – both his mother, Trice Massey, and his grandmother, Barbara Hicks, are competing at this tournament.

"Get out of Kansas City and hang a left."

Jean Joseph calls bridge a great brain exercise

Most of you are doing some physical exercise to keep your body in shape. What are you doing to keep your mind strong and vigorous? Actually most of you are doing one of the best things possible for your brain – you're exercising your brain by playing bridge.

Jean Joseph, acclaimed as the #1 teacher in the Kansas City area, uses this point to convince students that bridge is a healthful thing for them to do. "Bridge is the aerobics of the mind," she said. "Not only that, some studies have shown that it helps the immune system. And other studies have indicated that people who play bridge regularly have a lower incidence of Alzheimer's."

It's clear that lots of people listen to Jean. She has been running a Tuesday night novice-intermediate game for 30 years, and attendance is 18 to 24 tables every week. She uses an interesting gimmick to keep the people coming. She gives a 45-minute free lecture before each game, but a condition of the free lecture is that the player must stay and play in the duplicate game.

Jean has another regular program that new players find especially fascinating – bridge workshops. A workshop concentrates on just one facet of bridge for three straight hours. The subject might be opening leads – or some convention – or defense. First she gives a lecture, then some patterned hands for the group to play, and finally a question-and-answer period. She usually draws close to 100 students to these workshops. Lee Goodman and Brad Furnish help Jean with the workshop program.

Audrey Grant was scheduled to come to town shortly before the NABC, and Jean told her people what a fabulous teacher Audrey is. They believed her – 135 signed up to attend, so Audrey gave two lectures instead of one.

Jean's students have been showing up in droves at the I/N games here at the tournament. "Some are doing quite well," she said. "One thing's for sure – they're having a wonderful time."

The Facts: 2♥ made three, +140 for E/W. The opening lead was the ♦Q. The Director was called before North's final pass. West repeated his explanation of their agreements. After the hand was played, North told the Director that E/W had a private agreement that had not been disclosed because East had 2½ quick tricks. The Director ruled that West gave the proper explanation of the partnership agreement (which East may have violated) and that the table result would stand.

N/S appealed the Director's ruling but did not request redress for themselves. They wanted E/W's methods reviewed as to actual agreements and proper disclosure. They believed that E/W did not deserve +140 if 2½ quick tricks was not their actual agreement. N/S admitted that despite misinformation on quick tricks, South should have figured out the proper defense. E/W said that 1♣ showed 10-14 HCP in a minimum hand. At least 2½ quick tricks were required for a non-1♣ opener, but that alone may not be enough. A balanced hand with three aces was still considered a minimum and thus a 1♣ opener. E/W understood why they should possibly lose one trick and did not disagree with that possibility.

The Panel Decision: The Panel decided that there was misinformation because the 1♣ opening bid did not completely deny 2½ quick tricks, although other openings must include at least 2½ quick tricks. One player with 1500 masterpoints said he would have led a club, since partner, with the ♦J and ♣K, might think he was under pressure if the hearts were run. The other player consulted said that he would have led a spade since East would have had only 8 HCP without the ♣K. The Panel decided that South would not have misdefended with the proper information. For E/W the contract was changed to 2♥ made two, +110 for E/W, and for N/S the table result was allowed to stand.
