Kyle Larsen—The Quiet Man

One of the great bridge stories in recent years was the 2001 Bermuda Bowl win by the Rose Meltzer team -- you remember the squad: Meltzer and her trademark million-dollar smile; Peter Weichsel and Alan Sontag, still tough after all these years; Chip Martel and Lew Stansby, another of the world's great partnerships, and . . . the almost forgotten player, often seen standing off to the side nursing a Diet Coke or non-alcoholic beer.

Not that Kyle Larsen minds the lack of attention. He is secure in his role as Meltzer's partner. He knows he is a key player on a team that will always be among the favorites in any major competition.

Weichsel, who put the Larsen-Meltzer partnership together, is more sure than ever that the one-time teen prodigy was the best choice for the squad.

Larsen grew up in the bridge world. He remembers caddying with Gary Soules and Bob Crossley at the 1963 NABC in Los Angeles. "Bob and I were caddying and the directors needed a pair to fill in. We were probably the best of the caddy players so we got paid to play.

"Bridge has always been such a fun, high-interest thing for me."

Bob Hamman remembers the young Larsen. "In 1964 Harold Shaw owned a bridge club in San Francisco and he made arrangements with me to teach a class every Tuesday.

"The Sonny Liston-Cassius Clay fight was on a Tuesday night and I didn't really want to teach that class. I wanted to listen to the fight."

Hamman laughed as he reminisced: "I made up some problems -- tough problems -- and gave the class their assignments. Then I went into the next room to

Boris Schapiro, 93, dies in Britain

Boris Schapiro, 93, who made bridge headlines from 1929 to 1998, with special emphasis on 1965, died on Sunday.

He amazed the bridge world in 1998 when, at the age of 89, he won the World Senior Championship in partnership with Irving Gordon at the World Championships in Lille, France. No person before or since has ever won a world title in any sport at such an age.



Why the special mention of 1965? At the Bermuda Bowl World Championships in Buenos Aires, Argentina, he and his partner, Terence Reese, were accused of cheating by John Gerber, captain of the

American team. Subsequently the World Bridge Federation found the pair guilty of cheating by using illegal hand signals.

The case was referred to the British Bridge League to determine the ultimate penalty, but after an inquiry that lasted more than a year, the BBL concluded that there was insufficient evidence for the WBF's verdict of guilty.

Notwithstanding the British verdict, the WBF suspended both Schapiro and Reese. After three years the suspension was lifted with the proviso that the two never play as a pair in world competition again.

Eddie Wold reached the 40,000-masterpoint plateau when his team finished third in the Open Board-a-Match Teams on Monday night.

"I'm just so glad I was playing with George (Rosenkranz) when it happened," said Wold. "Edith and George have provided generosity, constancy, faith and affection -- the foundation upon which my career has been built."

Wold remains #5 on the list of all-time masterpoint winners -- behind Paul Soloway, Mike Passell, Jeff Meckstroth and Mark Lair. He has won a world championship -- the 2001 World Transnational Teams -- and

Cezary led a top heart and shifted to a club. Adam took the ace and found a diamond shift, won by declarer in hand for a heart ruff (yes, he could have cashed out for minus 500 but he thought he could do better).

Now came a club ruff, a heart ruff and a club ruff with the ♠6 – overruffed with the ♠7. Back came the ♦J, locking declarer in dummy. A club ruff with the ♠J saw declarer exit with the ♠Q to ♠A.

This was the ending with the defense having four tricks in and East on lead.

The ♠A was the coup de grace. If declarer ruffed low, West would overruff and play a heart, leaving East with the long trump. If declarer ruffed high, he could not prevent the defense from scoring the last two tricks.

If declarer discarded, East would be on lead at trick 12 for the trump promotion. Down 800.

At her final turn Irina knew that any tenace in a red suit would be protected if declared from her partner's hand and that there would be no ruffs relevant on the deal. As it was, 6NT is not only the par spot but it was reached by only a very few of the field.

An easy game, I suppose

A few days ago I showed an excellent defense by Dave Treadwell, where he passed throughout, followed suit to every trick and claimed the last four tricks when he was thrown in.

Here is my variation on the same theme. I sat West and was faced with a vicious problem on the second round of the auction. My partner was Sharon Osberg.

I guessed to pass and Sharon led a trump. Declarer won in hand and led a diamond, allowing Sharon to win the ♦A and play a second round of trumps. Declarer advanced the ♠Q, covered all around, then cashed the ♦K, ruffed a diamond and led the ♥A.

Had this held, he would have been in great shape. As it was, Sharon ruffed, cashed the ♣A and the ♦Q and led a spade to my jack. I could take my heart winners for down three and plus 800.

Well, I had passed throughout and followed suit (except to discard two low hearts on the clubs) and taken my winners for plus 800. Bridge is an easy game, I suppose.

Brilliancy missed

Did anyone find this possibility on this deal from the first final session of the Open Board-a-match final?

South's double of the opening preempt would not necessarily be the majority choice, but when North jumps to 6♥, it is clear for South to protect his ♦K. Say West leads the ♣J. Declarer wins and runs the hearts. East has to keep ♠ K-8-7 and the ♣K. So declarer takes a spade finesse and then throws East in with a club, forcing him to lead away from his ♠K.

Beautiful!! The only problem is that South did NOT correct to 6NT, and the contract went down when East led a diamond through the king.

You may wonder about Shawn's 1♠ overcall – probably you would have made a preemptive jump to 2♠ – if you bid at all. Shawn was feeling a bit aggressive, so she chose the stronger bid. Mildred's double of 2♥ showed cards, and Shawn went back to spades. But when West doubled, she changed her mind and went to clubs.

East cashed two top hearts and switched to her singleton spade to partner's jack. West continued with the ♠A which Mildred ruffed with the 9 but East overruffed. East led another heart which Mildred carefully ruffed with the jack. Now she knew where the queen was, and it fell when she cashed her top trumps.

Mildred wasn't home yet – she still had to handle the diamonds. She finessed the 10 successfully and cashed the king. Then she pitched a diamond on the ♠K, came back to her hand by ruffing a spade and claimed.

He got his first trump trick on the opening lead – he ruffed the heart. He led a club and West rose with the king to lead a second heart – trump trick #2. Ross cashed the ♣A and led a third club, and West slipped by ruffing. Back came another heart – trump trick #3. Now Ross led his last club, and West didn't want to "waste" his ♠J -- he pitched a diamond -- so Ross scored trump trick #4 with dummy's singleton 5. He successfully finessed in diamonds, but West ruffed the second diamond. Once again he led a heart – trump trick #5! West was able to ruff the ♦A with the king and then he cashed the ♠A. But Ross still had a spade left for trump trick #6 and his unlikely make.

Off to a fast start

No question about it – Charles Gray and Dave Treadwell got off to the fastest start in the Blue Ribbon Pairs. They scored 76 matchpoints out of a possible 76 in the first round. No, they didn't keep going like that. They finished the session with a 57% game.

listen to the fight.

"About midway through the second round, Kyle came out. He had finished the problems and said, 'Relax. I want to hear the fight too'."

A few years later, Hamman was playing money bridge at a club. "Some guy always wanted to organize a team game and I was being somewhat critical, so the guy says he and (Paul) Soloway will take on me and the kid (Kyle).

"Kyle comes over to me and says, 'How much of the action can I have?'"

Larsen, says Hamman, "was probably the best-ever young bridge player."

At the 1965 NABC in Chicago, Larsen and Bonnie Brier won the Teenyear Pairs. Larsen was playing bridge, poker and backgammon -- "a little action," he says. "It's always good for the soul, especially when you win."

He became a Life Master at age 15, at that time the youngest player ever to earn a gold card. In 1968 his team -- Larsen, Erik Paulsen, Peter Pender, Hugh Ross and Howard Schenken -- won the Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams. Larsen was 18, the youngest player to win a North American team title.

Other titles would follow but there were problems. "I've had some addiction problems through the years. I had a big problem with drugs and alcohol," Larsen said frankly. "I fought it a lot."

He spent time at the Betty Ford Clinic in 1988 and 1991 "and I've been clean and sober since the end of '96."

There was a time, Larsen added, when "clean and sober" was not an option but "at least it seems possible now. My team has been very supportive."

The Meltzer team debuted in the Spingold Knockout Teams at the 1999 Summer NABC in San Antonio, where they lost in the round of 64 to a Junior team: Samuel Ehrlichman, David Gurvich, Ari Greenberg and Joe Grue.

Weichsel wasn't discouraged. "I hand-picked Kyle to be Rose's partner," he said. "I thought of other people, but Kyle seemed like a good fit and I'm sure now he was the best choice.

"Kyle has been a friend of mine for many, many years. He's a very easy-going partner. Kyle is a tower of strength. He's a very good partner for Rose. He's a very good listener and a very good card player.

"They're very supportive of one another. They don't get upset at the table."

Meltzer agrees. "Kyle is such a special partner, I just can't tell you. He is just literally a perfect partner. You get from Kyle 100% support every minute of the time. He is always at the table, always on his partner's side."

Meltzer plays with Larsen in team games and with Weichsel in some pair games. Her favorite? Larsen. "Kyle, by nature, brings out my best game. We feel very fortunate to have found each other and feel we are a very strong mixed pair."

Jo Morse, a frequent Larsen partner, is also a fan. "Kyle is one of the best partners," she said. "He's so supportive of his partner that you really want to play your best. He's low-key. He's quiet. He's just a really nice guy."

The really nice guy and his teammates played in the Reisinger at the 1999 Fall NABC but didn't make the first cut.

The following year was different: the team finished second in the Open Swiss Teams at the 2000 Spring NABC in Cincinnati, advanced to the semifinal round of the United States Bridge Championships and were runners-up in the Flight A Grand National Teams at the 2000 Summer NABC in Anaheim -- where they also won the Spingold Knockout Teams.

"That (the Spingold win) seemed awfully good," said Larsen.

The win was just the prelude: the team won the repechage final in the USBC and designation as USA II in the 2001 Bermuda Bowl.

The competition was originally scheduled for Bali, Indonesia and moved to Paris. "We went over there a few days early," Larsen recalled. "Once we got there, it was like it had been the plan all the time -- it went so smoothly."

The team qualified easily and defeated France in the quarterfinal match and Poland in the semifinal. Next up: the Norwegian team in the final.

The match wasn't pretty early on. "We were just

getting crushed," said Larsen. "We had lost every set. The dirt was just about covering us up, you know?"

Meltzer remembers set five: "We were down about 80-something IMPs and Kyle said, 'Come on, babe, let's get some of this back.'"

Larsen took up the story: "Norway went down in a grand slam. Chip and Lew stopped in six, which was enough on that hand. They kind of took the low road."

That was the turning point as the Meltzer team went on to claim the Bermuda Bowl.

According to Martel, Larsen is "a terrific partner and teammate in terms of an upbeat attitude. You couldn't ask for anyone better. He's always supportive when things are going well or not."

As for the future, "we're hoping to keep this team together for a long time," said Larsen.

West led the ♠J and East won his ace to return a spade. Winning with the ♠K, declarer's only problem lay in trumps.

The percentage play for no losers was to cross to dummy and play a heart to his queen, but our declarer crossed to dummy in clubs and led the ♦10, a seemingly irrelevant play.

East rose with the ♦K. Declarer ruffed, then laid down the ♥A, hoping for the singleton ♥K to appear.

What had happened to cause him to play against the odds? Do you think this was a good play?

The key to declarer's play on this thin 6♥ slam was a negative inference he had picked up from the bidding. East, who had passed as dealer, had turned up with the ♠A and ♠Q -- assuming East's lead of the jack denied the queen.

Declarer's clever discovery play in diamonds revealed that East also held the ♦K. If East had started with the ♥K in addition to the ♠A Q and the ♦K, he would have had 12 good-looking points and would

surely have opened the bidding.

That meant West had to have the ♥K, so declarer's only chance was that West's ♥K was singleton. His detective work was rewarded when the ace duly felled the king. He drew trumps and claimed. What an easy game!

The scandal led to two major books on the subject. In his book, Alan Truscott listed all the details that convinced many around the world of the guilt of Schapiro and Reese. In reply, Reese authored a book that attempted to explain away a lot of the charges made in the Truscott book.

Reese never again played in world championship events, but Schapiro continued to play, reaching the apex of his career with that victory in 1998.

Schapiro was born in Riga, Latvia on August 22, 1909. His family emigrated to England at the time of the Russian Revolution. He was playing cards for money by the time he was 10 years old.

His first major tournament was the 1929 World Auction Bridge Pairs, where his partner was Oswald Jacoby. He won his first world title, the World Pairs, in 1932, again with Jacoby.

Schapiro's mental powers seemed to increase with age -- at 90 he claimed he had never played better bridge in his life.

In 1955 he led Great Britain to victory in the Bermuda Bowl. He won the World Mixed Teams in 1962. He played a major role as Great Britain won European championships in 1948, 1949, 1954 and 1963. He placed second in the first World Team Olympiad in 1960 and in the Mixed Pairs in 1962. He was victorious in the Sunday Times Invitational Pairs in 1964, and three years later he became the newspaper's bridge columnist.

He won Great Britain's Gold Cup 11 times -- the first time in 1945 and the last in 1998.

So I just quit table tennis cold and took up bridge."

He and Kantar have been practicing and "I think this is going to be a fun match. We're pretty evenly matched."

Wold expressed thanks to all his partners and teammates with "special gratitude to long-time friends and partners Paul Soloway, Mike Passell, Mark Lair and Geoff Hampson."

He also thanked Malcolm Brachman -- "many triumphs and great times" -- and his life partner, Bob Morris, "for all his love and support."
