Three upsets in firstround Wagar action

The first round of the Wagar Women's Knockout saw the seventh-, eighth- and ninth-seeded take an early exit. The #7 seed (Marinesa Letizia, Carlyn Steiner, Libby Fernandez, Carol Sanders, Susan Wexler and Margie Gwozdzinsky) lost 158–92 to the squad of Nancy Sachs, Linda Wolber, Diane Travis and Judy Cohn. The #8 seed (Jacqui Mitchell, Amalya Kearse, Laurie Vogel, Lynne Tarnopol and Gail Greenberg) was shown the door by Jane Segal, Judy Kay, Gloria Rabinowitz and Donna Morgen, 138–111. The #9 seed (Peggy Sutherlin, Karen Allison, Barbara Sion, Suzy Burger, Rhoda Walsh and Gloria Silverman) was ousted 168–91 by the team of Linda Perlman, Mickie Kivel, Mickie Chambers and Wendy Sameroff.

Of the 27 teams that entered the Wagar, 16 remain for today's matches.

The 103-team field in the Spingold Knockout Teams was pared to 64 for today's action. The first round saw an enormous upset, however, as the star-studded squad captained by Reese Milner failed to advance from their four-way match.

"When it comes to dedication and responsibility, nobody could top Charley," said Retek. "There aren't many like him."



"I met Jeanne and asked her what a Life Master was. I told her I had just had two lessons about weak two-bids. She explained about red points and Life Masters, then she told that it's OK to open one-bids as well as two-bids."

Rust pointed out that Charley is one of a set of identical twins. "Can you imagine *two* Charleys?" she asked.

"I'm speechless," said a highly emotional Stenger. He told about his wife being in the hospital, but the emotion overpowered him and he left the podium as the assembled throng cheered for him.

Redesigned Bulletin **premiers in January**

Members can expect to find something new in their mail starting in January, 2003. *The Bridge Bulletin*, a digest-sized publication since the early Fifties, will become a full-size magazine beginning next year. The two-color, newsprint format will be replaced by a four-color publication on glossy paper, similar to magazines such as *Newsweek* or *Sports Illustrated*.

Brent Manley, executive editor of *The Bridge Bulletin*, led a team from the editorial and publishing departments of ACBL in a six-month-long redesign effort. A limited number of sample issues of the new magazine was presented at the Washington DC NABC, where the project was overwhelmingly approved by the Board of Directors.

The content of the new magazine will be very similar to the current one. One of the major changes will be the inclusion of Audrey Grant's *Play Bridge* magazine — a 12-page publication targeted to newer players — in every issue of *The Bridge Bulletin. Play Bridge* will take the place of the *Bridge Bulletin's* "New Player" section.

Members will also receive their masterpoint up-

Marsha Sternberg was a woman of many talents who was struck down by cancer suddenly last year. Her husband, Jim Sternberg of West Palm Beach FL, is honoring her memory by donating a trophy for the Women's Boarda-Match Teams, an event that takes place at the Fall NABC. The trophy will be known as the Marsha Sternberg Memorial Trophy. Each member of the winning team will receive a replica of the trophy. The Board of Directors has given its approval for the new award.

Marsha was outstanding in many fields – she was a sailing instructor and she was very successful in golf, tennis and of course bridge. She took up the game and joined ACBL in 1990 and became a Life Master in 1997. She won many regional championships. She also was an excellent pianist.

Parking information

When parking for commuters is available at the Marriott Wardman Park and the Omni Shoreham, the charge is \$19 per day. There is 24-hour access but no in-and-out privileges. There is a \$5 rebate on weekdays, but there are special conditions for the rebates. Please note that this rebate plan is for commuters only. It is a subsidy underwritten by the local unit for local

The rebates cannot be applied to your parking charges. Instead they are in the form of scrip that can be used to buy entries to events at this tournament. When you get your parking ticket, bring it to the Information Desk where someone will stamp the ticket and give you the scrip good for part of your bridge entry fees.

Note that street parking is available in the vicity of the hotel only on weekends. On weekdays, zone parking permits must be displayed on your vehicle. This is strictly enforced.

Extra parking spaces are available4 at the University of District of Columbia (UDC) garages for only \$8 a day, but there are no in-and-out privileges. A free shuttle bus operates between the garage area and the hotel from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m., from 4:30 to 7:30 p.m. and from 10:30 p.m. to midnight.

Offsite parking also is available under certain conditions. Anyone using offsite parking must stay at the tournament for a minimum of four days. Those who use the offsite plan are escorted to the North Virginia suburbs and will be driven back to the area when they are ready to leave. For further information contact David Rodney at the Marriott Wardman Park Hotel. A shuttle schedule is available at the Information Desk. If you have a return reservation and wish to make a change, it is necessary to let Mr. Rodney know at least 24 hours in advance.

Opening lead: ♠9. East wins the ♠A and returns a spade, West playing the 3. Plan the play.

Kantar's answer: The danger is that East will win the first heart and lead a third spade, allowing West to make the ♥J. There is no recourse if West has ♥J 3 2, but at least you can protect against J–x.

Cash the ♦A at trick three, enter dummy with a club and discard both remaining spades on the diamonds. Now lead a heart. If East rises and returns a spade, ruff high and cash the remaining high heart hoping to drop the jack. This play loses if East has ♥A J x and is smart enough to play the ace immediately. You can't have everything.

Insured by "Meckwell"

It must be nice to have Jeff Meckstroth and Eric Rodwell as teammates. Most of us can only imagine the sense of security that it imparts to the other members of the squad. Take, for example, the following deals from the Grand National Teams Championship Flight which was won by the District 9 (Florida) team of Russ and Sheila Ekeblad, Michael Seamon, Mark Molson and, of course, Meckstroth & Rodwell.

This deal is from the semifinal round against District 21 (northern California):

Consider this from declarer's point of view. East leads the ♣A and switches to a diamond. You play low from dummy and West inserts the jack. You win the ace and decide to go all out to make the contract by taking the spade finesse in order to use the ♠A for a diamond pitch.

Unfortunately West wins the ΔK , gives East a club ruff, wins the diamond return and plays another club.

So you're down three. Feel bad? Don't. You just won 11 IMPs. How? At the other table your "insurance" — the boys from Meckwell — defended the same contract in the same manner, but they decided to double declarer first, so they were plus 800.

This hand is from the final against District 17 (Southwest). You hold as West, vulnerable against not,

♠A J 10 7 5 4 ▼10 4 3 ♠6 3 ♣4 3, and the bidding goes 1♣ on your left, pass from partner, 1♠ on your right. You decide to exercise restraint at these colors and pass quietly. LHO rebids 1♥, partner passes again and RHO bids 1♠, Alerted as a (possibly) artificial force. Now, let's say you decide to yield to temptation and double — just to help partner out in case he's on lead, mind you, since he needs all the help he can get.

But things now take an unpleasant turn, as LHO redoubles and this is passed back to you. You sheepishly pass and the opponents proceed to make nine tricks without breaking a sweat. Here's the full layout:

So you're minus 920. Feel bad? Don't. You just won 2 IMPs. How? Meckstroth and Rodwell got to the laydown 6NT for plus 990.

Haste makes waste

It is usually fruitless to ask an expert how to bid a freak hand, but occasionally one occurs on which the right actions can actually be demonstrated. One thing about bidding freaks "scientifically" is that it usually pays to take things slowly so that the entire picture can come out.

Friday morning in the top bracket of the Educational Foundation KOs such a hand came up. Our team got this one right, but our opponents, Bill Parks - Ken Chatzinoff of the Philadelphia area and Balusu Rao-Dave Grubbs of greater Seattle, had to get up early Saturday morning while we could sleep in.

The hand in question is

Your side is not vulnerable, the opponents are, and the auction started (at both tables) pass by partner, pass. What would you open? Even though the hand undoubtedly qualifies both on honor strength and playing strength, 2Φ is probably wrong since you will have to rebid 3Φ and then 4Ψ , and you are awfully high by then. Indeed at both tables this hand opened 1Φ . The next hand overcalls 1Φ , partner tries 2Φ and RHO passes. At both tables this hand now bid 2Ψ , 2Φ on your left, pass, pass back to you.

This is actually quite revealing. Partner has shown 10 or more points, but did not bid 2NT, did not double 24, and did not rebid 34. So partner should have some length and some high card strength where you want it, namely in the red suits. Also, not surprisingly, partner doesn't have real diamond support but doesn't have four hearts either. Given all this, what would you bid?

At the other table they chose 4∇ , which ended the auction.

3♥, however, drew a raise to game which left this hand in a position to offer a choice of slams by bidding 6♦ next. Partner took the preference to 6♥ holding a suitable 10-count:

Notice the effect of going slower and giving yourself more time to find out relevant information. Also notice the gain from having it be your bid, not partner's, when the auction reached 4Ψ ,

Actually $6 \blacklozenge$ is a better contract, but when hearts were 3-2 and diamonds were not 4-0 offside, $6 \blacktriangledown$ also made.

stood out. She became the first female editor for the National Enquirer, and she climbed the ladder until she became senior editor. She became the highest paid female editor in the world. She wrote a much-read column entitled "Tales of Courage" which profiled people facing crises.

She left her post at the Enquirer in 1989 when she married Jim, a radiologist. It still brings tears to Jim's eyes when he remembers viewing Marsha's xrays and discovering that the cancer he saw had to have a fatal outcome.

Marsha was a countess – the Countess of Abruzzi. This title was given to her in recognition of the couple's philanthropic efforts in Italy.

One of Sternberg's favorite memories of his late wife occurred during the world championships in Albuquerque in 1994. "I had lost in the Rosenblum quarterfinals and had gone to sleep. When I woke up, there was a trophy on the table in our hotel room. I asked, 'Marsha, did I win something?' 'No,' she said, 'I won something – the novice Swiss."

dates inside each issue of the magazine. This will be performed using ink-jetting, as will the address label. The advantage is two-fold since members will receive their point totals every month (instead of every other month) and the ACBL will save postage costs since the point confirmation cards don't have to be produced or mailed.

Other ACBL publications, such as the product catalog, can also be telescoped into the new design, further reducing postage costs versus mailing the catalog separately.

The new *Bridge Bulletin* will be 64 (full-size) pages long, plus 12 pages of *Play Bridge* inserted.

There is always risk involved in changing the format of a publication that readers have become accustomed to, so the ACBL staff spent several months creating a new look that would please the majority of the membership. The change to four-color process (use by most national periodicals) and the upgrade to glossy paper will be a giant step up in appearance for the magazine, and reaction to the sample issue was strongly positive.

Ian Boyd had his chance in the GNT B event. He blew his opportunity, but in the spirit of true contrition here is his penance for the Daily Bulletin.

Boyd was South. On the auction shown, Boyd got the lead of the ♠9 which he won in hand.

Since West appeared to have five or more spades to the A–K–10–9 and one heart, the clubs might quite reasonably be expected to split. Boyd played for this and went down even though East produced the ♣J 10 on the first two rounds of the suit.

But if instead of cashing all the clubs you take the king and ace then run the diamonds to finish in dummy, West has to keep two clubs and thus either has to let go of his heart (in which case he gets endplayed with either black suit) or to pitch a spade winner. Then declarer simply plays a low heart: East can win and play a spade through, but since the defense has only three spades to cash, declarer takes the last two tricks.

New Life Masters



Triple squeeze without the count

Mark Molson took full advantage when his opponents failed to find the optimum defense on this deal from the Championship Flight of the Grand National Teams. Molson and his teammates won this event.



West led a club to East's ace, and East switched to his singleton spade, won in dummy with the king. Molson found out about the diamond situation when he cashed the •K. He switched to a heart, and East was surprised to win the trick with the 6. Another club would have been best for the defense at this point, but East actually returned a trump. Molson took his ace and gave up another heart to East. He fired back another trump to dummy's 10, and Molson ruffed a heart. Molson ruffed a club, leaving this position:



Molson led the ♠Q, and what could West do? He couldn't throw a spade – both spades would be good. He couldn't throw a heart – North's 10 would be good. His only hope was to ditch the ♣K. But Molson was ready for that – he led dummy's heart to West's queen, and West had to lead away from his ♠Q-10 to give Molson plus 670 on the board. West had been caught in a triple squeeze without the count.

This was worth 13 IMPs when Eric Rodwell and Jeff Meckstroth made 3♠ at the other table. They were happy with the plus but a little unhappy they didn't get to 5♠.

Junior Team Trials



Momentum is great

Prospects weren't bright for Rick Atwater and Chris Pesce, winners of Red Ribbon, on this deal from the first final session. But this was the session where everything went right – they wound up with a 74.78% game, scoring 75 or more on a 90 top on half the boards in the set.



Apparently Pesce's $2 \triangleq$ bid steered South away from the killing spade lead. Instead South led the $\blacklozenge 5$ – queen, king, ace. Pesce found this interesting – he decided South must have led away from the 10. He cashed the $\blacktriangledown A$, dropping the jack, and continued the suit, South winning his king.

South led another trump, apparently to make sure declarer couldn't score a spade ruff. Pesce won the ♥10, cashed the ♣Q and crossed to the ♣K. He then led the ♣A, pitching a spade as South ruffed.

South now realized what was happening and led a spade, but it was too late. Pesce won, took a finesse to the ◆9 and ruffed a club. He got back to dummy with the ◆J and got rid of his other losing spade on dummy's fifth club. 86.5 matchpoints out of 90.

After Pesce and Atwater were crowned champions, Pesce said that he was happy that their opponents were so set on self destruction.

Georgia Heth and Bob Sievers, the runners-up, enjoyed this deal from the second final session.

When Sievers was able to make a two-level response to her opening bid, Heth knew they were in slam territory. She didn't waste any time – she went right to Blackwood. Discovering that her side was off only one key card, and also at the same learning the club situation from the double, she jumped to the heart slam.

Actually the double of 5♣ backfired. North might well have cashed the ♠A without the double, but he followed his partner's instructions and led a club. Heth and Sievers would have earned 72 matchpoints just for getting to the slam, but they got another 16 when they made the overtrick.

Women begin battle for Wagar Trophy

The Wagar Women's Knockout Teams, which enters its second day today – is a battle for the Wagar Trophy, which honors one of the all-time great players

Wagar of Atlanta (1902-1990), inducted into the ACBL Bridge Hall of Fame in 1999, became Life Master #37 in 1943, the fifth woman to earn the ranking. She and Kay Rhodes share one of the most remarkable achievements in ACBL history -- they won the Women's Pairs four consecutive years: 1955, 1956, 1957 and 1958.

Wagar and Rhodes share another record -- one of frustration. They were second in the Women's Teams for seven consecutive years, 1952-1958.

Wagar's impressive record spans three decades and includes wins in women's and open competition. Her open wins include the Reisinger in 1941, the Open Pairs (the forerunner of the Blue Ribbon Pairs) in 1947 and 1948 and the Spingold in 1946 and 1948.

Wagar served on the ACBL Board of Directors from 1960 to 1972 and was named *ACBL Honorary Member* in 1979. She was non-playing captain of the U.S. World Women's Teams in 1968 and 1972.

Until 1976 the Women's Teams was a four-session event scored by board-a-match. It was contested as a three-session championship until 1972 and again in 1975.

The Women's Teams was held at the Fall NABC until 1963. In 1976 the event became a Women's KO with Swiss qualifying.

The Stengers weren't the only ones honored. Tournament Director Millard Nachtwey told how novice programs became an integral part of Washington area clubs, then sectionals, then Mid-Atlantic tournaments, then North American Championships. "Years ago a very innovative lady came up with a plan to get more people into the bridge world," said Nachtwey. "Edith McMullin finally convinced our bridge club to try a novice program. Of course everybody knew it wouldn't work. Imagine everyone's surprise when we had 20 tables the very first time. Eventually it worked up to 25 or 30 tables.

"Next she went after the people who were in charge of our sectionals. Again nobody thought she would succeed, but she certainly did. And then she got intermediate and novice games to be a regular part of our regionals.

"When she suggested a novice-intermediate program for the 1984 NABC here, she was told she was out of her mind. But you know Edith – she just kept battling until she got the OK. Reasonable turnouts on Saturday and Sunday didn't impress anyone – those were weekend days. But when 40 tables showed up on Monday, Edith had proved her point. Games for intermediates and novices became a must for all future NABCs."

Charity Sack, McMullin's daughter, said there was never a dull moment in her mother's house. "We had to do all the usual household tasks, but we also had to make boards and caddy. We were very much a project-based household."

Sack was inducted into the Goodwill Committee by Nadine Wood, district director for District 6, later in the meeting.

McMullin, visibly emotional, thanked everyone for their backing and good wishes.

Osofsky told of Jim Wood, a long-time Washington enthusiast and worker who was unable to appear because of ill health. "He served three terms as president and was the conscience of the Washington Bridge League." said Osofsky. "He was a maverick but you could always count on him to be helpful. People near and far turned to him because he was a true friend of bridge."

Osofsky also honored Margot Hennings, chairperson of this tournament. When Hennings took the podium, she said, "I've learned the meaning of goodwill -- it means keeping a smile on your face no matter what happens during the tournament."

She told of a couple of strange things she's heard this week. At the Partnership Desk -- "I've lost my wife." "I've read the Club and Diamond books. Can I play?" "I have fewer than 50 points. Exactly how many, you ask. Well, about one and a half.".

Among those attending were Goodwill Members of the Year Tom Gardner (1996) and Kay Afdahl (2002). Also present was Richard Freeman who has been a member of the Goodwill Committee for 43 years. Osofsky also introduced Richard Bowling, president of the American Bridge Association. He is the first ABA president to become a member of the Goodwill Committee.

Osofsky thanked the many people who sent in contributions to the Norman Kay Memorial Fund of the Goodwill Committee. "The \$3000 received from all over the country will enable us to fulfill Norman's wish that the person selected as GW Member of the Year will receive appropriate transportation – most likely airline –plus one day's onsite housing, food and bridge entries. The money collected to date will hopefully fund our next three recipients."

Knockout mathematics

How do you match up 103 teams in knockout competition to wind up with the manageable number of 64 for the second day?

Here's all you have to do. Give the #1 seed a bye. Next have seeds 2-13 play in four-way matches with two teams from the middle of the seeds and one from the lower end. In each four-way match have two teams face each other for 32 boards. The two winners are through for the day – they've qualified for the next day's play. The two losers battle each other for 32 boards, and the winner advances. That's 48 teams with 36 qualifying.

The remaining 54 play head-to-head matches, setting up 27 more qualifiers.

Add them up – the #1 seed plus 36 from fourway matches plus 27 from head-to-head matches. The total is 64, right?

What about the women where there were 27 teams? How do you reduce the field to 16?

Easy. Give the #1 seed a bye. Seeds #2 and #3 play in four-ways, so six of the eight advance. The remaining 18 teams play head-to-head, for nine qualifiers. That's one plus six plus nine – that's 16, right?


