Nickell, Meltzer, **Shugart latest Spingold casualties**

Big wood fell in yesterday's Spingold action. The #2 seed of Nick Nickell, Richard Freeman, Jeff Meckstroth, Eric Rodwell, Bob Hamman and Paul Soloway was upended by the #15 (originally #18) seed of Lou Ann O'Rourke, Billy Miller, Curtis Cheek, Mike Cappelletti, Peter Fredin and Magnus Lindkvist, 140-136. Nickell jumped out to 29-IMP lead after the first quarter, and was still leading at the half, 85-62. O'Rourke rallied in the third set to trail by only 10 IMPs, then outscored Nickell in the fourth quarter, 47–33, to advance to the quarterfinal round.

The #6 seed, and defending Bermuda Bowl champions, of Rose Meltzer, Kyle Larsen, Alan Sontag, Peter Weichsel, Lew Stansby and Chip Martel was ousted by the four-handed team of Mike Moss, Martin Shifko, Allan Graves and Brian Maksymetz, 148–135.

The international #5 seed — Rita Shugart, Andrew Robson, Tony Forrester and Boye Brogeland — lost by a single IMP to the Swedish squad of Claus Christiansen, Magnus Eriksson, Lars Munlsgaard and Ulf Nilsson. The final score: Christiansen, 137-Shugart, 136.

The top-seeded Jacobs team survived a scare by Continued on page 12

Two more vugraph shows are coming up. The second half of tomorrow's Spingold semifinals will be shown. On Sunday the final of the Spingold will be featured.

Virginians ahead in **National IMP Pairs**

Hailong Ao of Herndon VA and Yi Zhong of South Riding VA led by more than 14 points after the qualifying sessions of the National IMP Pairs. Their score of 106.20 put them well ahead of runners-up Randy and Kay Joyce of Raleigh NC, who had 91.98. In third place were Brian Glubok of New York City and Sheila Ekeblad of Providence RI with 89.08.

The field was huge -13 sections. A total of 182 pairs qualified for today's two-session final.

Note that the scores are much smaller than they were a year ago. Pairs still are IMPed against every other pair in their field, but the method of figuring scores has changed. The difference is that the IMP total now is divided by the total number of comparisons. The total score for each pair is stored in the computer so that there are no round-off errors.

Snider was presented the Tom Weeks Award, given annually to the tournament director who makes a professional appearance and shows the most improvement. The Fred Friendly Award, given annually to the TD who offers the best customer service with a smile, went to Whidden.

Snider got into the directing game back in 1974 when Betty Perkins asked her if she wanted to help. Snider said "no" but later changed her mind. She started working tournaments in the late Eighties and became a full-time member of the ACBL staff in 1994.

Her husband Bill was very surprised that she has stayed with bridge so long. He asked her why, and she told him it's because of the unique folks she meets in the bridge world – the players and her fellow TDs. She credits National Tournament Director Millard


The two top finishers will represent the United tes in the World Youth Team Championships next summer. The event probably will take place in Beijing, China, but final arrangements have not yet been made.

Local pairs top National 199ers

Calvin Cobb of Chevy Chase MD and Chip King of Bethesda MD posted a score of 342 matchpoints to win the National 199er Pairs. The event — open to players with fewer than 200 masterpoints — was the largest in the history of the contest, attracting 52 tables.

Cobb, an attorney with the local firm of Steptoe and Johnson, and King, a retired businessman with IBM, have played infrequently together, but King asked Cobb to play for a reason.


"He needed the gold points," said Cobb — a longtime duplicate player — of his partner, who has played for four years. The pair picked up 19.18 gold for the win.

Will anyone top Ralph Katz's record?

Will anyone top the record set last year by Ralph Katz for the most points won at the Summer NABC?

Ralph Katz entered only three events at the Summer NABC in Toronto last year, but he finished with a record 383.85 masterpoints and claimed the Fishbein Trophy, awarded to the ACBL player who wins the most masterpoints at the Summer NABC.

Katz won 1.35 points in the Grand National Teams Championship Flight, finished second in the Life Master Pairs (142.50 points) and was on the winning squad in the Spingold Knockout Teams (240 points).

His winning total bested the 1999 performance of Eric Rodwell, who won 348 points in San Antonio.

The trophy was donated by ACBL in memory of Sally Fishbein and in recognition of the untiring efforts of Harry Fishbein, who served as ACBL treasurer and refused to accept the customary compensation.



An enterprising double

Beating 3NT usually gets you above average. Beating it doubled means lots of matchpoints. Lenny Holtz was fully aware of this when his opponents in the Life Master Pairs got to a marginal notrump game.

Holtz knew the opponents couldn't take many tricks in the black suits. Probably diamonds would be their only real source of tricks. He also knew that his foes had stretched a bit − North's 2♠ bid showed a weak hand. So he doubled.

He led a spade, and declarer didn't have a chance. He went after diamonds, but Tobi Sokolow held up the ace to the third round. Declarer saw that he was never going to get back to dummy, so when he got there with a diamond he also cashed the ΔK . When the smoke cleared he had only seven tricks – two diamonds, two spades, two clubs and one heart. Plus 300 earned most of the matchpoints for Holtz and Sokolow, who went on to win the Life Master Pairs championship.

The only suit not bid by North-South was the one in which they could have taken a lot of tricks – diamonds. Ten tricks are a sure thing in diamonds, and a diamond game is possible if the defenders fail to lead a trump on opening lead.

Well Bid

Allen Kahn and David Rosenberg got off to a fast start en route to a third-round Spingold win. On their very first board of the set, they got to an excellent slam on these hands

Kahn opened 1♠ in third seat and jumped to 3♥ over Rosenberg's 1NT response. Rosenberg raised to 4♥. Now Kahn bid 4♠ showing slam interest. Rosenberg cooperated with 4NT, which was a forward-going murmur of encouragement. Kahn cuebid 5♠ and Rosenberg bid 6♥. Well bid.

The opening lead was the $\clubsuit 2$, won by the ace. Two high hearts followed, and the $\P Q$ cooperated by dropping. Even if it had not, the slam would make as long as the hearts were 3-1 and the person with the $\P Q$ had at least two spades. This gained their team 11 IMPs.

Double-dip your MPs at Montreal fiesta

The World Championships in Montreal next month will be a masterpoint treasure trove. Those who compete in the world and the regional events will get both World Bridge Federation and ACBL masterpoints.

In the regional events, the top 10% of the field will get WBF points. In games limited to players with 50-300 points, those who finish first overall also will receive WBF points.

Players will be able to pick up their colorful certificates the day after they win them. The certificates are laminated and suitable for framing.

The regional, which will last 18 days, figures to be one of the largest of the year. Competitors

will receive a bridge book or a bridge calendar in their registration bag.


Those who compete in world events will receive a carry-on bag similar to the ones distributed at the Bermuda World Championships two years ago. These bags are very useful when traveling.

Section top prizes in world events will be World Championship books from either 1995 or 1996. In regional events, the overall winners will receive World Championship T-shirts and caps. More than 1000 T-shirts are ready.

Montreal of course is a gastronomic paradise. All competitors will be given an excellent restaurant guide.

The queen of crossruffing

Lynn Deas and Curtis Cheek were runners-up in the Life Master Pairs. On this deal, Deas discovered the correct plan to bring home her slam was through a crossruff:



West led the ♦5. Deas won the ace, took the heart finesse (noting the fall of the ♥J) and then made the key play of the ♣K, club to the ace and a club ruff. Since West had preempted in diamonds and had followed to three rounds of clubs, Deas knew she could safely play hearts through her left-hand opponent.

The ♥A was next. Whether West ruffed or not was immaterial, since Deas could overruff in dummy and return to her hand with diamond ruffs. Deas soon claimed on a crossruff for a great score.










Count, count, count

Curtis Cheek found a neat way to pick up an extra trick on this deal from the Life Master Pairs. Accurate counting was the key. Cheek was playing with partner Lynn Deas.



(Deal rotated.) West led the ♣2 (third- and fifth-best) which ran to the jack and ace. Both opponents followed to two rounds of trumps. Cheek reasoned that spades were probably 4–4 since neither opponent bid them. Since West led a fifth-best club, East probably had four. East's inferential count, therefore, was 4–2–3–4.

Declarer can take advantage of this information in an attempt to hold his diamond losers to one. If East holds $\oint K-10-x$ or $\oint K-J-x$ (meaning that West has the doubleton jack or 10), then an intrafinesse in the suit would secure the extra trick.

After drawing trump, Cheek led a low diamond to dummy's 9. East won the 10, cashed a high club and shifted to the ♠K. Cheek won dummy's ace and called for the ♠Q. East covered with the king, but declarer played the ace smothering West's 10. Declarer could now run diamonds from the top to pitch dummy's spade losers.

Making five for a great score.

Honor your partner

Consider your partner to be a friend. Treat your partner well, even (especially) if you are playing together for the first time. Always offer your partner a drink -- tea or coffee is a good starting point. This will lead to a relaxed atmosphere, enabling you both to play your best. By the way, always be a pleasant and courteous opponent.

Tolerate errors. Never go on about partner's mistakes -- just forget about them and move on to the next deal. You may be able to make a constructive comment at the end of the session. Your partner will surely show you the same consideration.

Be encouraging. Always be prepared to support your partner -- "well played" always goes down well and a "thank you" for the dummy does not go amiss. In one of my partnerships, if dummy was exactly what was needed, "mille grazie" would let partner in on the good news!

Keep a straight face. Never make the mistake of pulling a face or raising an eyebrow. Apart from hurting your partner's feelings, being deadpan does not let your opponents know that something may have gone wrong.

Win or lose, always stay calm at the end of the session and thank partner for the game. This is espe-

cially important if things have not gone so well. In my most successful international partnership, the first time we played together was absolutely hopeless but we stuck with it.

Coping with disaster: The best way to cope with the inevitable disasters is to laugh them off. This tends to disconcert even the best opponents who are used to seeing their opponents argue.

Conventions: Stick to the ones you both feel comfortable with. A player trying to remember some convention he is not familiar with will make errors in other departments.

Who's the boss? In most partnerships, one player tends to be regarded as the boss. If you are the stronger player, go out of your way to make life easy for your partner: make easy-to-understand bids, leads and signals. Don't land your partner in a tough contract - well, not on purpose.

Have fun! You are both out to enjoy yourselves. If your partner leaves the table feeling happy, you have done your job. Of course you want to win, but that objective should not mean spoiling the game for your partner or the opponents.

Clough team hard to top

The winners of the National Senior Swiss Teams — Roger and Rebecca Clough, Louise and Gene Freed, Nels Erickson and Derrell Childs — were in top form throughout the event. In the following deal from the first final session, the team showed why it won — good declarer play and good defense.

In the open room, the Cloughs bid the hands this way:

North South Roger Rebecca $1 \clubsuit$ $1 \checkmark$ $4 \checkmark$

West led a low spade to East's ace and returned the ♦6. Rebecca refused the finesse by rising with the ace before continuing with the ♣J. West covered with the queen, ruffed in dummy. Declarer took the trump finesse, carefully overtaking with the ♥10, cashed the ♥A dropping the king, drew the last trump and claimed. Making four, plus 420.

The contract and the opening lead were the same in the other room, but East, Childs, switched to a low trump at trick two. Declarer can still succeed if he adopts the same line as Rebecca in the open room (♥Q, ruffing finesse in spades, cross to the ♦A and draw trump), but he decided instead to take the heart finesse and play a low club. West, Erickson, discarded. East won the ♣A and returned the singleton diamond. Declarer was forced to take the diamond finesse at this point, but it failed and Erickson returned a diamond for East to ruff. Down one, and a 10-IMP pickup for the Clough team.

Bid and play 'em right

Jan Wittes and Ross Grabel used their system to get to the right spot, then took advantage of their chance to bring in a huge swing.

(1) Ace and king in different suits or three kings. On a trump lead Wittes drew two rounds and cashed the ♦A-K. Eureka! A defender showed out of diamonds but had no trumps with which to ruff. So Wittes ruffed his diamond loser and claimed 13 tricks. This was a gain of 16 IMPs against 7♦ down one in the other room.

First-time grand slam for new players



Mori decided that it was likely to be based on a trump trick. So he cashed the ♠A and led a spade to the 9. Success! East discarded on the second trump: contract made.

The Facts: 3NT made five, +660 for N/S. The opening lead was the ♠5, won by the 10. The ♥8 was led to the queen, ace and 2. The ♥J was then ducked and followed by the ♥10, won by the king. When West then led the ♣3 declarer played the 2, and when East played the jack declarer said "nine, king, queen." Declarer said he assumed West wouldn't underlead and the king was going to be played, but he would

never duck the jack.

The director ruled that the 9 was played according to Law 45C4a. In order to be ruled inadvertent, a designation of a card from dummy must be corrected without thought. The Laws Commission has instructed that the burden of proof is on declarer and the standard is "overwhelming." It was believed that declarer expected the king to be played and may not have seen the jack.

The Appeal: N/S appealed the director's ruling. North said it took less than one-tenth of a second for him to correct the ♣9 to the ♣K, and another half-second to correct the ♣K to the ♣Q. East thought North might have taken a fraction of a second longer, but the correction was very quick. East thought North might have changed his mind.

The Panel Decision: North said he assumed West would not underlead his ♣K at trick five, so the panel believed he was expecting the ♣K to be played. Thus, he may have been intending to duck and changed his mind after he started to call the card from dummy. Therefore, the table result was allowed to stand. An Appeal Without Merit Warning was not issued because the decision was a close call.

The Facts: 4♦ made seven, +190 for N/S. The Director was called at the end of the hand. Both E/W convention cards had Rosenkranz redoubles and support doubles. N/S were playing Precision and 1♦ could be opened with a bad 16-count. The director ruled that the misinformation was not germane and allowed the table result to stand.

The Appeal: N/S appealed the director's ruling. South said that since his partner did not have a spade stopper, he was greatly afraid of a low spade lead and a spade back, maybe later losing a ruff or a third trick elsewhere. He said his partner could have opened with an 11- count vulnerable, which was why South did not bid game. Had he been given the correct information, he would clearly have bid the game.

North said he could have had another queen given the devaluation of his $\bigstar K$ which was why he didn't redouble at his second call. North said he thought his pass and subsequent bid showed a better hand. South said he thought just the opposite.

When South was asked what he would have bid had he known North was showing better than a minimum South said he would have bid 5. East said he thought they had discussed this auction and agreed that Rosenkranz applied, but West said they had not. Neither one believed the misinformation should have affected South's bidding.

The Panel Decision: This was a 32-board match and the last to finish, which made finding players for consultation difficult. As the matter had to be decided quickly, only two players were consulted. The first player said he would have bid 5♦ no matter what information he was given. He had no second choice. When told that South had passed and why, he said it

might be right but it was taking far too extreme a position for him. The second player said he would have bid 5♦. When asked if he had a second choice, he said 6♦. When told that E/W did not have the agreement that West showed the ♠A or ♠K with his double he said, "They never do."

Given the forcefulness of both players' opinions and given the fact that N/S would have reached their game had they been on the same wavelength, the panel allowed the table result to stand. Since there had been misinformation and the hearing was convened and conducted under great time pressure, it was decided that the appeal had merit.

THURSDAY EVENING BOARD-A-MATCH TEAMS

It takes two

Each player is required to have a convention card filled out legibly and on the table throughout a session. Both cards of a partnership must be identical and include the first and last names of each member of the partnership.

If a director determines that neither player has a substantially completed card, the partnership may play only Class A conventions and may use only standard carding. This restriction may be lifted only at the beginning of a subsequent round after convention cards have been properly prepared and approved by the director. Further, the partnership will receive a 1/6 board matchpoint penalty for each board played, commencing with the next round and continuing until the restriction is lifted.

In IMP team games, penalties shall be at the discretion of the director.

If the director determines the partnership has at least one substantially completed convention card but has not fully complied with ACBL regulations, the director may give warnings or assign such penalties as he deems to be appropriate under the circumstances. The objective of these warnings and penalties is the encouragement of full compliance with ACBL regulations.
