## Bertheau squad wins Open Swiss Teams

A multinational team captained by Sweden's Peter Bertheau scored a near-blitz on the final round to move from third place to first by 1.5 Victory Points in the Jacoby Open Swiss Teams.

The winners are Bertheau and Fredrik Nystrom of Sweden, Italian stars Fulvio Fantoni and Claudio Nunes, American Christal Henner-Welland and transplanted Canadian Fred Gitelman.

They surged into first while the first- and second-place teams – captained by John Kranyak and Eddie Wold – fought it out. Wold beat Kranyak by 12 IMPs, not enough to win the event because the Bertheau squad defeated their final-round opponents by 27 IMPs for 19 VPs out of 20.

Their final total was 135.25 Victory Points to 133.75 for Wold, who was playing with George Rosenkranz, Mike Passell, Eric Greco and Geoff Hampson. The high finish earned Hampson the Mott-Smith Trophy for winning the most masterpoints at the Spring NABC.

Third place went to John and Ken Kranyak, Gavin Wolpert and Vincent Demuy of Thornhill ON.

Westheimer claimed her second Women's Swiss – she also won in Cincinnati in the Spring of 2000. She and Radin won the national Women's Pairs in 1998. Westheimer's teammates all have multiple North American and world championships. Last year, Breed and Quinn won an unprecedented fourth straight Life Master Women's Pairs at the 2002 Fall NABC in Phoenix.

Quinn is No. 1 in World Bridge Federation rankings for women players. Breed is No. 4.

Their sessions were 64%, 50%, 60% and 57%, leaving them with a final score of 430.36 (13 top) to 418.56 for the runners-up: Lester Gottlieb of White Plains NY and Richard Avazian of Suffern NY.
