## Italians romp in Open Pairs II

The reigning World Open Pairs champions, Claudio Nunes and Fulvio Fantoni, topped the 130-pair field in the final of the Wernher Open Pairs II. Nunes and Fantoni led for much of the final and finished in front by more than two boards. Their two-session total was 2272.31, with a 55.72% in the afternoon and a 65.45% in the evening combined with a large carryover for finishing first in the two-session qualifier. Top on a board was 64.

Nunes and Fantoni have previously won the Open Board-a-Match Teams in Philadelphia in 2003, and Fantoni was a member of the winning squad in the Mixed Board-a-Match Teams in Long Beach in 2003.

Both players are frequent members of the Italian national squad. They earned their World Pairs title in Montreal in 2002.

In second with 2147.47 were Fred Stewart and

Kit Woolsey, and one board back was the third-place pair of Irina Levitina and Ilya Levitin with 2089.90.

## Women's champs: Kearsse-Mitchell

In a feat they last performed 33 years ago in 1971, longtime partners Amalya Kearsse and Jacqui Mitchell have won the Women's Pairs. This is the second victory for Kearsse in the contest, but it's the fourth for Mitchell who has won previously with Gail Greenberg (twice) and with the late Judy Tucker. Mitchell also has several second-place finishes in the Women's Pairs, the first of which occurred in 1962 playing with Betty Kaplan.

Mitchell and Kearsse were World Women's Pairs champions in 1986.

Mitchell was inducted into the ACBL Hall of Fame in 2003. Kearsse has been elected to the Hall of Fame for 2004, and will be inducted at the Summer NABC in New York.

Kearsse and Mitchell scored 66.14% in the afternoon and 62.85% in the evening to post a final score (with carryover) of 1368.9.

In second with 1242.18 were Cynthia Balderson and Carole Miner of Minnesota.

## Midwest pair tops in Red Ribbon Pairs

A mutual friend who was trying to put a team together a few years ago contacted Marty Harris of Chicago and Jacob Morgan of Madison WI. That's how Harris and Morgan began their partnership, and it was culminated yesterday by victory in the Red Ribbon Pairs.

They had a powerful 70% game in the first final after a so-so performance in the qualifying. Their evening effort was good enough to give them a one-and-a-half board margin over second place.

The battle for second place was hard-fought. Mark Brighthouse of Towaco NJ and Harvinder Sidhu of Neshanic Station NJ edged John Rollin of Hayward CA and Alex Stagner of Menlo Park CA by two points – a tiny margin considering that top on a board was 77.

Morgan had high praise for Harris. "He didn't touch a wrong card during our big session. He played most of the hands, and he was strong."

They play a special system they call the Inverted Polish Club. An opening bid of 1♣ is

forcing, but it can be weak as well as strong. Their opening 2♣ openers are like Acol two-bids. Their opening 2♦ bids are much like the Standard American 2♣ bids.

Morgan's friends are always surprised when he attends a Spring NABC – he's a tax preparer. Harris, an attorney, is a partner in a law firm.

## Nickell stunned by Schwartz rally, loses in OT Schwartz to face Jacobs

The top-seeded Nick Nickell squad had built up a 53-IMP lead after three quarters of play against their opponents led by Richard Schwartz in their Vanderbilt semifinal match. Schwartz returned from the dead in the last quarter, picking up exactly 53 IMPs to tie the match. In the subsequent eight-board playoff, Schwartz outscored Nickell 18-16 to win the contest by 2 IMPs. Final score: Schwartz 159, Nickell 157.

In the other semifinal bracket, the #2 seed captained by George Jacobs kept Jim Mahaffey's squad at arm's length the entire match, winning it 121-105.

## Those darned trumps

The field, whether North-South or East-West, had reason to curse the opponents' trumps during the evening session of the second Open Pairs game.

4♥ looks playable enough, does it not? Well, North sat back as the defense went ♦A, diamond ruff, club ruff, diamond ruff, club ruff, diamond promoting the ♥J for down three. I suffered that torture. My opponents were Marshall Lewis and George Whitworth.

Another bad trump break turned into good news.

The defense led a diamond to the ace and a diamond back. You lead a heart to the king and ace and win the heart return in dummy as West suggests a doubleton heart.

Correct play is to cross to the ♠A, ruff a diamond high since the ♠J has already put in an appearance, and overtake the ♠9 to draw trumps. Now you can inferentially count West for one spade, two hearts and six diamonds. Hence it is East, not West, who has the doubleton club honor. So lead a club to the 10 rather than advancing the jack from hand. When the ♣K falls under the ace you have 10 tricks.

The next deal saw many Easts producing their hoariest overcall of the event – and regretting it!

queen for the ace and another club ruff. That was plus 1100. East made the mistake of leading a diamond honor from hand prematurely and had run into a trump promotion for minus 1400!

## French fried

Marvin French had a choice of squeezes on this deal from the second session of Thursday's Stratified Open Pairs, but he chose one of the flashier lines of play.

French, South, won the opening diamond lead and took the heart finesse. East won the king and returned a diamond. This was ruffed in dummy and the ♥A was cashed, revealing the bad split.

French knew, however, that West would likely come under some discarding pressure if the red suits were continued, so he played a trump to the queen and another trump to East's 10. West had discarded three black cards at this stage.

East made the best try by returning a club. There are several strategies that will work for declarer, namely, win the ♣A and duck a spade, but French preferred the "delayed duck" form of the squeeze. He won the ♣A, cashed the ♠K A and then played the ♦K in this position:

French scored 10 out of a possible 12 matchpoints for plus 400.

Glass led his singleton ♣3 to partner's queen. Jim Steelquist cashed the ♣A on which Glass discarded the ♦3. Partner led a third club and Glass ruffed with the trump 3. Then he put the ♥3 face down on the table.

"May I see the previous tricks?" he asked as he turned over his three threes. Then he turned over the fourth 3. The opponents weren't amused – they called the director. When the TD heard the story and saw the four threes, all he could do was laugh. He ruled that Glass's action was strictly humor and caused no damage.

## A very good start but a bad finish

Don Rumelhart and Zeke Jabbour had two huge gains in the first three hands of one of their knockout matches, but they were one point behind at the halfway mark. "We didn't do so well on the slams later on," said Rumelhart. They were playing a very strong team captained by Marc Jacobus.

Board 1 was a double slam swing. You hold:

♠ 7  
♥ J 4  
♦ 6 5 3  
♣ A K Q 8 6 3 2

It looks too good for a white vs. red 3♣ call, but you bid it anyway. LHO jumps to 4♠, partner bids 5♣, RHO bids 5♦ and you pass. LHO passes and partner bids 5♥. RHO doubles, you pass and partner runs to 6♣. This was passed out even though you expected a double. The opening lead is ♠A and dummy hits with:

♠ J 10 6  
♥ A K 10 9 8 6 5  
♦ —  
♣ J 7 4

There was no problem to the play. However, both 6♦ and 6♠ are cold East-West because there is a stiff heart in one hand and a club void in the other. "Our partners bid 6♠, got doubled and made seven when the opening leader underled his ♥A K in hopes of getting a diamond return for a ruff. We won 21 IMPs on this board," said Rumelhart

Two deals later you hold this hand with nobody vulnerable.

## Minus 2800 via Active Ethics

Bill Glass and Jim Steelquist came up against a pair that was using a Forcing Diamond. They agreed to play that a double of 1♦ would show the majors and a 1NT overcall would show the minors.

On the second deal, the opponents opened 1♦ and Glass overcalled 1NT. "Alert," said Steelquist. "Partner is 5-5 in the majors." Then he bid 2♥. Glass knew he had unauthorized information, so he passed, but Steelquist redoubled. Once again Glass passed, and a few moments later he was writing down minus 2800 on his scorecard.

Later a tournament director came over to make sure the score was correct. When he discovered it was correct and how it happened, he congratulated Glass for his fine act of Active Ethics.

## Correction

In yesterday's article about Dixie Hsu, we stated that she started playing duplicate in 1997 – it was 1987. She is now a Diamond Life Master with more than 5000 masterpoints. She was the top masterpoint winner among women last year. Her teacher, Ken Gee, and Barry Harper told her she had a good chance, and she began racking up the points.

You're not playing support doubles, so you don't know whether partner has three or four-card support. Based on the auction, it appears that partner must have a singleton heart. Do you make a game try? You decide to bid 3♦ — those two aces look really good. Partner bids the spade game, and this is your dummy:

♥ 5 4  
♦ K 10 7  
♣ A Q 6 4 3

You are totally surprised to find *two* losing hearts in dummy. The opponents play three top hearts and you ruff, noting that your ♥J is now good. You play the ♠K and the ♠A, followed by your good heart. You note that LHO did not ruff — things are looking up. You play the ♦A and ♦K and ruff a ♦, noting that RHO discards a club. You put RHO in with his high trump and claim. If you had known that RHO was overcalling on a four-card suit, you might not have invited game. But it was his lack of a fifth heart that resulted in his being endplayed.

## Thanks for the help

Sometimes you need all the help you can get. On this deal from the first final session of Open Pairs 1 a pair of defensive slips allowed newly elected Hall of Fame member Peter Weichsel to bring home a seemingly hopeless slam.

Weichsel, South, blasted to 6♥ after the preempt and raise. West led the ♠10, and Weichsel — who had hoped to find dummy with (maybe) ♦Q J x x x — knew his prospects were poor to say the least. The ♠10, likely a singleton, was won by declarer's ace. After two high trumps, on which East discarded a club, Weichsel continued with three rounds of diamonds ending in hand. Looking for inspiration, Weichsel cashed another high

trump. West shed a low club, but so did East. This isn't entirely silly since East could reasonably form the view that declarer is void in clubs based on partner's putative seven-card club holding for the preempt.

Declarer then played the ♣10. This was the position:

East's discards set the stage for this layout. For the defense to succeed, West must duck. Ducking an ace when declarer plays a known singleton towards a king in dummy seems counterintuitive when defending a suit slam, but it's necessary here.

West, however, won the ace and found himself endplayed. A diamond would allow declarer to ruff in dummy while sluffing a spade from the closed hand. Another spade would go on the ♣K. A club exit, on the other hand, would allow declarer to finesse the 9.

Making six, plus 980, for a huge matchpoint score.

## Triple squeeze

Lee Ohliger showed me the following deal from a knockout match.

Say you reach 6♥ and get the ♠J as the opening lead. You win and run the ♥10, losing to West. He returns a spade (no defense works any better at this point). You simply cash the ♦A and run the hearts to reach this point:

Note that East has more cards than anyone else. If he has pitched a club, your hand is high. If he has thrown his spade or diamond winner, you cash the top card in that suit and the squeeze repeats. As Ohliger ruefully commented, "With the cards cooperating, it was doubly unfortunate that he misplayed the hand and went down anyway."

## New Life Masters: Partners go over the top together

They did it Thursday in the bracketed knockouts. Vona needed about three and a half points and Miller was about five short. They were ready to play in the semifinal of their bracket when they reported their success – getting to the semifinal was worth about six points. “We came here for the gold,” said Vona, “and we weren’t leaving without it.”

Another husband-wife combo made the grade together. **Thayer** and **Alice Johnson** of Antioch CA went over the top in the Friday Compact Knockouts. Their teammates were Sandy Baker of Alamo CA and George Keifer of Yountville CA.

The team from Conroe TX is happy – **Jennifer Lindner** is now a Life Master. She needed only .89, but it had to be gold. She earned more than enough in the Bracketed Knockouts. Her Conroe teammates were William Lindner and Kris and Cathy Digre.

**Alayne McFetridge** of Vanderhoof BC became a Life Master playing in a bracketed knockout match against Bernel and Don Scott, who became Life Masters on Thursday in the same event. **George Kieffer** of Walnut Creek CA got the last points he needed in the 299er Pairs. His goal was to make LM before his 80th birthday, and he made it! He started playing bridge when he was 70.

He’s back in the game again, and he earned his gold card when he qualified for the final of the Red Ribbon Pairs. He made it almost exactly – he had 300.02 points after qualifying. 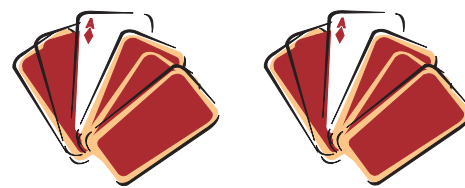

**Deja vu, sort of**

Back in 1979 the American team was battling Italy for the Bermuda Bowl in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. Malcolm Brachman was the sponsor of the American team, and Ed Theus, the non-playing captain, considered not using Brachman in the final. Brachman's teammates wouldn't hear of it. He had got his team this far, and he was going to have a chance to go all the way.

He played the first two sessions, and his team walloped the Italians, 72-3, over those 32 boards.

Brachman didn't play the rest of the way, and the Italians cut heavily into the lead. They staged a monumental charge in the final session, but the Americans held on to win by 5.
