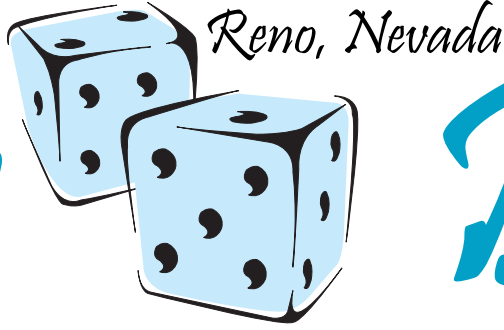

Godefrin-Schulte lead Silver Ribbon

Joseph Godefrin and Ed Schulte parlayed a huge first qualifying session into a field-topping performance in the first day of play in the Silver Ribbon Pairs.

Godefrin and Schulte scored 71.31% in the afternoon session and 58.69% in the evening to post a total of 1285.16 matchpoints.

In second, more than two boards behind the leaders, are Ronald Spath and Shou-Ling Wang with 1205.50. Close behind in third are Steve Cohen and Gene Freed with 1205.36.

The field of 306 pairs was cut to 156 for today's two-session final.

The Silver Ribbon Pairs is open to players 55 and older who have earned a Silver Ribbon qualification by finishing first or clear second in a regionally rated Senior event.

The squad of Jimmy Cayne, Robert Levin, Steve Weinstein, Michael Seamon, Geir Helgemo and Dano DeFalco was seeded sixth in the Vanderbilt Knockouts, but they're on the sidelines today after they failed to win either of their 32-board matches in yesterday's opening-round action.

Top seed Nick Nickell had a bye in the opening round, but will face the team captained by Barry Rigal today.

One hundred five teams entered the event. Only 64 remain. Action will resume in the Crystal Ballroom at 1 p.m. today.

Turn ‘em off

Cell phones, audible pagers or any similar communication equipment may not be operated or operable in the playing area during a session of play at NABCs except for health-related equipment or by permission of the director-in-charge of the tournament or event.

This is the resolution passed by the ACBL Board of Directors, meeting before the start of the 2000 Summer NABC in Anaheim. While the resolution applies only to NABCs, the board urged that “sponsoring organizations of other ACBL-sanctioned events are strongly encouraged to adopt this policy.”



Bid Box Alerts and Announcements

When using bid boxes, ACBL suggests that players tap the Alert strip and say “Alert” at the same time.

When making an announcement, use the announcement word — such as “transfer” — and tap the Alert strip at the same time.

A player who Alerts or announces a bid should make sure his opponents are aware that an Alert or announcement has been made.

Apology to Tom Lum

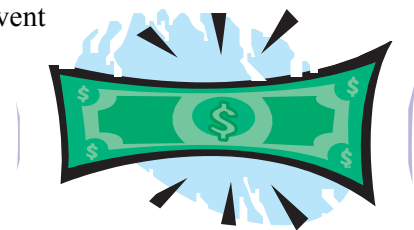

Junior coupons

With student coupons, the cost of entries is \$6 per session for any event at the North American Bridge Championships.

Student coupons will be available to players who have not had their 22nd birthday or who offer proof that they are full-time students and have not reached their 26th birthday.

The coupons are available to all Junior players whose ACBL dues are current. The coupons must have the Junior player’s name, event and ACBL number on it.



Honolulu unit honors Tom Lum today



Honolulu Unit 470 is honoring Tom Lum for his tireless contributions to bridge by designating today's Senior Knockout Teams as the Tom Lum Senior Knockout Teams.

Lum was the hospitality chairman for both the 1975 and the 1983 Spring North American Championships in Honolulu. Both events made the Top Ten in attendance at the time they were held.

He is president of the Hawaiian Contract Bridge Units Association that sponsors the annual Hawaii Regional. He has given 37 years of service to this organization. He also serves on the ACBL Board of Governors and the ACBL Goodwill Committee.

Lum retired as president of a professional consulting engineering firm he established in 1967. He designed structures for high rise building and freeways in Hawaii and Guam. He was the chief architect for the Pearl Harbor Arizona Memorial design structure.

He is a Diamond Life Master with more than 8000 masterpoints and dozens of regional wins.

Honolulu will be hosting the Fall North American Championships in 2006.

Convention card reminder

Each player is required to have a convention card filled out legibly and on the table throughout a session. Both cards of a partnership must be identical and include the first and last names of each member of the partnership.

If a director determines that neither player has a substantially completed card, the partnership may play only the Standard American Yellow Card and may use only standard carding. This restriction may be lifted only at the beginning of a subsequent round after convention cards have been properly prepared and approved by the director. Further, the partnership will receive a 1/6 board matchpoint penalty for each board played, commencing with the next round and continuing until the restriction is lifted. In IMP team games, penalties shall be at the discretion of the director.

If the director determines the partnership has at least one substantially completed convention card but has not fully complied with ACBL regulations, the director may give warnings or assign such penalties as he deems to be appropriate under the circumstances.

The objective of these warnings and penalties is the encouragement of full compliance with ACBL regulations.

How to score 2230

I've had a bad history with the meaning of redoubled contracts (see "Losing at Lille" at <http://www.larryco.com>). It was nice to be on the right side of one on this deal from the first qualifying session of Open Pairs I :

South might have thought her partner's pass was for penalty, or maybe she was just hoping to avoid a big number. After all, 1♣ redoubled isn't game.

A diamond was led to the queen and declarer's ace. There is no way to make all 13 tricks, but 12 tricks were easy. The score we entered was 2230 (the five redoubled overtricks are 2000, then 20x4, plus 100 for the insult and 50 for the partial). And now you know how to score plus 2230 – look at the back of a bidding box.

The online game

The annual Junior Collegiate Team Championship will be played April 3-4 on OKbridge.

What's your worst action at the table?

The worst thing you can do at the bridge table is to squeeze your partner . . . or is to endplay him? What if you have the choice?

Dave Berkowitz, who won Open Pairs I in partnership with Larry Cohen, saw that he had his work cut out for him when he viewed the dummy. South started with the ♥J, ducked, and the ♥10 ducked. Berkowitz ruffed the third heart as the ace fell from North. He led a club and South climbed with the ace. He could have scored a club ruff at this point by continuing the suit, but apparently he thought he had a trump trick anyway. Instead he led a diamond to partner's king. Berkowitz won the diamond continuation in dummy with the ace.

At this point Berkowitz knew South didn't have the ♥A, the ♦K or the ♣K, so it was more than likely that South had the trump queen for his opening bid. He led a spade to the king, passed the ♠J and crossed to dummy's trump ace. Berkowitz was happy to find the trumps 3-3. Now he faced this ending:

Berkowitz led the ♣Q . . . and what is North to do?

If North wins with the king, Berkowitz will unblock the 10 and win the forced club return in dummy, squeezing South. If North ducks to avoid rectifying the count, Berkowitz would retain the lead in dummy and exit with the ♥Q to endplay South in diamonds. Either way Berkowitz has his eight tricks and his contract.

Facts: 3♣ was down four, minus 1100. The Tournament Director was called two rounds after the play of the hand. West did not use the Stop card, North did not pause after 2♥, East paused 5-8 seconds, and West doubled quickly.

Director's Ruling: The hesitation by East demonstrably suggested a double while pass was a logical alternative. The result was changed to 3♣ by North, minus 400.

The Appeal: Although the Stop card was not used, the 2♥ agreement had been pre-Alerted prior to the start of the round. E/W said that North bid after four seconds. South passed immediately. West contended that she was systemically obligated to reopen with shortage when playing these methods since a double by East would have been negative. N/S estimated the pause after 3♣ at 5-8 seconds. It was only after the round that N/S worked out that minus 400 would be a good matchpoint score. They called the TD at that time.

The Decision: The committee determined that the 2♥ agreement at this vulnerability had a range of 4 - 10 HCPs. The committee reasoned that 1) the fast pass by North passed some responsibility to East not to bid too fast; 2) in the context of a competitive auction 5-7 seconds is the recommended tempo; 3) the reopening double was systemically obligated in the context of South's fast pass, even if East had been judged to have taken a clear break in tempo. The fact that the TD was called two rounds after play was completed did not terminally damage the N/S case, but it did weaken the contention that there had been an obvious break in tempo. The table result was restored for both sides, 3♣ doubled by North, minus 1100.

Facts: 4♥ +420. The Tournament Director was called at the end of the play period. No questions were asked at the table. N/S had no agreement, but had discussed that doubles of artificial calls show the suit bid.

Director's Ruling: Failure to ask questions does not constitute unauthorized information (UI). The table result stood.

The Appeal: E/W believed that North had UI from his partner's failure to ask the meaning of 3♣. They felt that 4♣ could show a better hand for clubs than a double of 3♣. Although North had club length it was still possible, though unlikely, that South had long clubs.

The Decision: The committee determined that N/S had a documented agreement that a double of an opponent's artificial bid always showed length and strength in that suit. N/S further explained that after an earlier accident involving a similar artificial call, they had agreed that a cuebid would be a two-suiter, not natural, regardless of whether the artificial call might or might not show the suit bid. The committee found that N/S were under no obligation to ask questions. They found no infraction. E/W were assigned an Appeal Without Merit Penalty (AWMP).

Changing directions

The bidding on this deal was strange. On the first round, West and East bid and supported diamonds while North and South bid and supported spades. But at the end East-West took a save in clubs, not diamonds, against North-South's heart game, not spades.
