Meet your TDs

After a day off because of the heavy schedule on Saturday night, here is another in the series of profiles of tournament directors working at NABCs.

For a significant part of his adult life, when Bob Hendricks went to work, he did so under water. A 26-year veteran of the U.S. Navy, he spent time on four different nuclear-powered submarines.



Nowadays, his job is all about bridge.

Here in Chicago, the Virginia Beach VA resident is working at his sixth NABC as a tournament director and enjoying himself immensely. "I work about 70 days a year for the ACBL," he says, "and I would like to work more."

Hendricks was born in Milwaukee but grew up in Des Moines IA. As a youngster, he watched his parents play bridge every Friday night with friends. He and his siblings were encouraged to learn card games, so he knew about bridge at an early age.

He graduated from Iowa State University with a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering, then, as an ROTC student, went to the U.S. Navy post graduate school in California, where he earned a master's degree in the same discipline.

Upon graduation, he entered the nuclear power program – that is, submarines.

He did mostly engineering work, but was also commanding officer of the USS Flying Fish, a

Michigan wins collegiate crown

Michigan defeated Princeton in yesterday's final of the 2006 Collegiate Bridge Championship 56-54. Playing for Michigan were Kevin Fay, Ilya Podolyako, Jeremy Vosko and Jonathan Zimbler. Princeton's lineup was Dan Recht, Jon Ullman, Eric Mayeksky and David Lin.

In the playoff for third/fourth, UCLA topped Berkeley 70-63.

For the winners, Fay, 21, is studying biophysics and biochemistry. His teammates have all recently graduated. Podolyako, 21, earned a degree in psychology, economics and linguistics; Vosko, 22, got his degree in industrial operations engineering; Zimbler, 22, earned his degree in actuarial math and economics.

The Collegiate Championship began in February of this year when 30 teams played a qualifying game online. The top eight squads earned the right to play here in Chicago.

First-time partners are tops in von Zedtwitz LM

Bart Bramley and Bjorn Fallenius, who had never played together before last Friday, surged from fourth place with a session to go to win the von Zedtwitz Life Master Pairs by more than a board.

The final-round score of 63.24% gave them a total of 1720.53, good enough to pass three other pairs for the championship. Second place went to Martin Fleisher of New York City and Bill Pollack of Basking Ridge NJ, who were 58 matchpoints behind on a top of 51.

Bramley, of Dallas TX, and Fallenius, of New York City, attended the World Bridge Championships in Verona, Italy, last month. While there, Bramley mentioned that he was looking for a partner for the six-session LM Pairs in Chicago.

Last Tuesday, Bramley said, he went to work and found an e-mail from Fallenius saying he was available if Bramley had not made other arrangements. Bramley quickly confirmed the date.

Both players normally employ complicated systems with their regular partners, but they settled on a relatively simple scheme for their first effort.

"We were very much in tune," said Bramley. "We had no system troubles."

In fact, said Bramley, there were several occasions during the competition that he thought to himself that it would be awkward if certain bids came up in their auctions "and they never came up."

Said Fallenius, "We got along great."

Neither player had won the LM Pairs previously but both have had success at high levels with more than 15 North American championships between them.

Cassel, Kaufman take Bruce LM title

Mike Cassel and Andy Kaufman paired two solid performances in the final round of the Bruce LM-5000 Pairs to narrowly win the six-session contest by fewer than four matchpoints. Cassel, of Roseville MN, and Kaufman, of Smyrna DE, scored 54.44% in the first final session and 55.92% in the second final. Their total was 408.10.

In second with 404.17 was Al Blinder of Torrance CA and Craig Zastera of Woodinville WA. Zastera was also second in the Bruce LM-5000 Pairs in 2003.

Cassel, an online stock trader, and Kaufman, a chemical engineer for Dupont, first played together in the 1990 Fall NABC in San Francisco. After a long hiatus, the two began playing again online, and have done so for the past five years. They still get to play live bridge annually at the Cherry Hill Regional, and the occasional NABC.

Cassel and Kaufman were in sixth place going into yesterday's final round, and were in fifth after

The Bruce LM Pairs is limited to players with fewer than 5000 masterpoints.

Convention card reminder

Each player is required to have a convention card filled out legibly and on the table throughout a session. Both cards of a partnership must be identical and include the first and last names of each member of the partnership.

If a director determines that neither player has a substantially completed card, the partnership may play only the ACBL Yellow Card and may use only standard carding. This restriction may be lifted only at the beginning of a subsequent round after convention cards have been properly prepared and approved by the director. Further, the partnership will receive a 1/6-board matchpoint penalty for each board played, commencing with the next round and continuing until the restriction is lifted. In IMP team games, penalties shall be at the discretion of the director.

If the director determines the partnership has at least one substantially completed convention card but has not fully complied with ACBL regulations, the director may give warnings or assign such penalties as he deems to be appropriate under the circumstances.

The objective of these warnings and penalties is the encouragement of full compliance with ACBL regulations.

Bridge detective – or who's got the queen

West starts with the ♦K.			



North's 6NT bid is a reasonable gamble that West didn't overcall with the ♦A K. After the diamond is led, declarer, with only one diamond stopper, is feeling somewhat nervous. She counts her sure winners and finds three spades, three hearts, one diamond and two sure club winners.

She needs three more to make 12 tricks. She recognizes instantly that everything depends on locating the ♣Q and getting three extra tricks in the club suit.

Short of peeking at the opponents' hands, what are her options? Does she simply finesse, praying and guessing all the while? Does she recite the nursery rhyme "Eight ever, nine never" in the hope that the ♣Q will drop? Nursery rhymes work for

children, but not always at the bridge table! Alternatively, since West preempted 3♦, he probably has a shortage in clubs. Should declarer therefore expect East to have ♣Q x x (x)?

Perhaps there is something declarer can do to make guessing unnecessary. When faced with the possibility of a finesse, try to postpone that action until you have more information about the deal. After all, finesses work only 50% of the time unless you have the ear of the Big Guy, of course!

Declarer should plan to play clubs, the problem suit, last, and extract as much information as possible along the way. To start with, South should duck the ♦K at trick one. There is absolutely no hope of scoring 13 tricks on this deal. So South ducks trick one and West continues with the ♦Q. East shows out and South wins the second trick.

Counting is arduous at any level. When counting out a hand, it is much easier to focus on one opponent, generally the one with the known long suit. When East shows out in diamonds, declarer knows that West started with seven diamonds. Declarer can focus all her attention on West from now on.

Declarer continues by playing three rounds of spades, a non-problem suit, noting that West shows out on the third round. Next she plays three rounds of hearts. West shows out yet again on the third round. Let's tally up the known cards to date: West started with seven diamonds, two spades and two hearts; ergo, he is marked with only two clubs.



Since declarer and dummy have a total of nine clubs, we now know that clubs are breaking 2-2. We can play the club suit with impunity, certain that the ♣Q will fall under the ace and king. That ensures 12 tricks and the contract! The full deal:

Thinking bridge

Opening lead: ♥Q.

Bidding commentary: 3♦ is a game-forcing splinter jump. It describes a game-forcing spade raise with a singleton diamond. 4♣ is a cuebid, and 4NT was Five Ace Blackwood! Playing this convention, the king of the agreed suit counts as an ace! So there are five aces! The 5♣ response shows one ace (the ♠K), and East bids slam expecting West to have both black kings.

If you like this version of Blackwood, you will probably like Key Card Blackwood as well. In that version both the king and the queen of the agreed suit can be shown or denied.

Defensive commentary: Although a diamond

lead would have defeated the contract, a heart lead looks normal.

Play commentary: It looks for all the world as if there is a diamond and a heart loser, but there is a chance! Declarer must hope that the defender with the ♦A has fewer than three hearts.

Declarer wins the opening lead, draws trump, strips clubs, cashes a second heart (key play) and exits a diamond, an equal length suit. Sure enough, South, the player with the ♦A, had two hearts and is

forced to lead a diamond, allowing West to discard his remaining heart while ruffing in dummy.

Holding the A-K-x-(x)-(x) opposite three low cards in a side suit in a trump contract does not necessarily mean a loser! If the hand can be stripped and the ace and king cashed before the throw-in, the player being throw in may be void in the A-K suit (South has no more hearts) and be forced to concede a ruff and a sluff. Something to think about.

A great way to learn: Lesson Games

Another great feature of the NABCs are Lesson Games that are held several times during the tournament. Typically, a two-hour lesson is followed by a two-hour game, specially created for newer players. The next Lesson Game is scheduled for today at 10 a.m., with play to follow at 12:30 p.m. The location (subject to change) is Grand Ballroom B. Questions? submarine that he says is no longer. "It's now razor blades," he says.

His longest stint under water was 76 days. "We were hiding from the Russians," he says.

Hendricks got serious about duplicate in 1983, when the Navy sent him to Bremerton WA and his family, on the East Coast, were not scheduled to join him right away. "I needed something to do," he says. He found a bridge club "and I made my executive officer play with me."

Hendricks retired from the Navy in 1995 and started a bridge club in Virginia Beach to stay busy in retirement. His wife, Lila, does not play. "We have an agreement," he says. "I don't touch her sewing machine and she doesn't play bridge."

He says his military background has helped him as a TD – most of the time. "Sometimes the players don't want to be told what to do," he says.

Hendricks says his TD career has been influenced by Edith McMullin and other directors in the area, including Michael Carroad, Doug Grove and Millard Nachtwey.

He says he especially enjoys working regionals where Nachtwey is the director in charge. "Millard lets you do everything," Hendricks says.

Keep them in the dark

This deal, reported by Andy Stark of the winning Grand National Teams, Flight A, squad, shows the importance of not giving away too much information as declarer. Stark's teammates, Daniel Korbel, playing with David Grainger, was the hero.

The pushy game was reached, and South led a low diamond: 10, king, ace. Korbel could see he had his work cut out for him, so he embarked on a path that would provide the least information to the opponents.

At trick two, he ran the ♠10 to North's queen. North returned the ♦5 to the 8 and jack. South could see that if North could get in again, another diamond through would scuttle the contract. From the play to that point, it appeared to South that declarer was planning two finesses in spades, and if so, North had the ♠K. As you can see, a low heart switch would have resulted in six more tricks for the defenders, but South played a spade instead.

That gave Korbel his shot, and he played expertly from there. He won the ♠K in hand, cashed the ♣K and played a club to dummy's ace, noting the 10 from South. After he ran the spades, Korbel played a club to the 9. The ♣K was trick number nine for plus 400 and a gain of 6 IMPs because at the other table East-West played 3♠ making three.

He was quick off the mark to praise Peter Weichsel on this deal from the second qualifying session of the von Zedtwitz Life Master Pairs. Weichsel was playing with Hansa Narasimhan (hands rotated). Ferguson was East.

Weichsel reached the heart game after opening the South hand, and Ferguson's partner started with a club, allowing the defenders to take the first three tricks. At trick four, Ferguson exited with a diamond to dummy. Weichsel cashed the ♥A and ♥K, then played the *diamond queen* to dummy's ace, then played a spade to the queen and West's ace. On the spade return, this was the position:

When Weichsel played low from dummy, Ferguson assumed declarer had started with 3=5=2=3 shape, so it could not cost to put in the ♠9. He knows better now.

Had Weichsel gone two down, the result would have been one matchpoint out of 25. One down was average.

Want to play Mid-Chart conventions? Read this first!

Players who wish to use Mid-Chart methods (in events that permit them) must check the ACBL Defense Database for rules governing their use.

If you choose to play a method permitted by the Mid-Chart, you are required to do the following:

1. Pre-Alert the opponents about your method prior to the auction on the first board.
2. Have a complete written description of the method available for your opponents.
3. For certain methods, you must provide your opponents with an approved defense from the database. Visit the ACBL web site at www.acbl.org for details.

ACBL players: help players from outside North America who wish to use Mid-Chart methods to be aware of these rules.

Wagar KO starts today

The Wagar Women's Knockout Teams begins today, and at stake is the Wagar Trophy, which honors one of the all-time great players.

Margaret Wagar (1902-1990), inducted into the ACBL Bridge Hall of Fame in 1999, became Life Master #37 in 1943, the fifth woman to earn the rank. She and Kay Rhodes share one of the most remarkable achievements in ACBL history — they won the Women's Pairs four consecutive years: 1955, 1956, 1957 and 1958.



Wagar and Rhodes share another record — one of frustration. They were second in the Women's Teams for seven consecutive years, 1952-1958.

Wagar's impressive record spans three decades and includes wins in women's and open competition. Her open wins include the Reisinger in 1941, the Open Pairs (the forerunner of the Blue Ribbon Pairs) in 1947 and 1948 and the Spingold in 1946 and 1948.

Wagar served on the ACBL Board of Directors from 1960 to 1972 and was named *ACBL Honorary Member* in 1979. She was non-playing captain of the U.S. World Women's Teams in 1968 and 1972.

Until 1976 the Women's Teams was a four-session event scored by Board-a-Match. It was contested as a three-session championship until 1972 and again in 1975.

The Women's Teams was held at the Fall NABC until 1963. In 1976 the event became a Women's KO with Swiss qualifying.

Spingold Knockout

The historic Spingold Knockout Teams gets underway today. Following is a look at the history of this prestigious event.

History of the Spingold

The Spingold Master Knockout Teams, first known as the Challenge Knockout Teams, was contested for the Asbury Park Trophy in the early days.

The runner-up team in the regularly scheduled portion of the event had the right to challenge the winners to a playoff. This right was never utilized.

In 1934, 1936 and 1937, the Masters Teams-of-Four and the Asbury Park Trophy were separate events, providing two sets of winners.

In 1938 the event became the Spingold Master Knockout Teams and a part of the Summer NABC.

At one time, the Spingold was a double elimination event, usually lasting nine or 10 sessions. It was scored by International Match Points and was restricted to players with 100 or more masterpoints.

In 1965, the double elimination method was replaced by three qualifying sessions (subsequently reduced to two), followed by single elimination knockout matches. The preliminary qualifying session were dropped in 1970.

The Spingold Trophy, donated by Nathan B. Spingold in 1934; the Vanderbilt Trophy, awarded to the winners of the Vanderbilt Knockout Teams at the Spring NABC, and the Reisinger Memorial Trophy, donated by the Greater New York Bridge Association in memory of Curt H. Reisinger and awarded to the winners of the Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams, are ACBL's most highly prized team trophies.

Spingold (1886-1958), a New York publicist, motion picture executive and patron of the arts, was one of the most influential men in bridge administration from 1937 to 1943.

Born in Chicago, he became a reporter on The Chicago Examiner, *The Chicago Record Herald* and *The Chicago Tribune*. Spingold's interest in show business brought him to New York City in the Thirties.

In 1932 he joined Columbia Pictures in a public relations capacity. He was named to the board of directors in 1940 and three years later was appointed vice president in charge of advertising, publicity and development. He became a vice president of the company in 1954.

Active in bridge from its earliest days, Spingold was named ABL Honorary Member in 1936. He was instrumental in effecting a peaceful merger between the American Bridge League and the United States Bridge Association in 1937 and became president of the newly formed American Contract Bridge League the following year.

He served for many years on the League's Board of Governors and Board of Directors. Spingold was also president of the Cavendish Club in New York.

A look back at Chicago 1998

When Chicago last hosted an NABC, I had been playing tournaments only about two years. For the most part, I had results of varying levels of mediocrity. However, there was one bright light, in the final session of the Red Ribbon Pairs (now held during Spring NABCs). After miraculously qualifying to the final with two below-average games, and a slightly above-average first session, my partner and I proceeded to have a near 70% game and vault high into the overalls. This huge set prompted me to record all of the hands from the session, as it's something I do from time to time. This board was one of many good results.

The 3♣ bid was Alerted, but we didn't ask. I led the ♣8.

Years later, looking back at the hands and comments written, I realized how much I have advanced. On this deal, I had added the wise-guy comment, "The double diverted us from our best lead, hence South made 12 tricks instead of 12 tricks after a heart lead." Upon seeing this, I immediately saw that this statement was not accurate! In practice, declarer made only 12 tricks, but 13 are there for the taking.

After a club lead, suppose South runs six diamonds, discarding clubs from dummy. The exact discards East and West make will vary, but the position should come to something like this:

♠ A Q 5 3	♠ J 10

South at the table did not realize it, but there is a double squeeze, of the more unusual variety of being sequential, with each opponent being squeezed on a different trick. First, South cashes the ♣A. In order to guard spades, West discards a heart. Now, declarer cashes three rounds of spades. On the third spade, East must commit to either a club or heart discard. Declarer, discarding behind East, keeps the other suit and claims the rest of the tricks.

On the more natural lead of a heart, declarer cannot make 13 tricks. The trick is, without the ♥A for transportation, declarer can squeeze only one of the opponents. Being able to see how the play goes, the defense can always score a trick.

A player who Alerts or announces a bid should make sure his opponents are aware that an Alert or announcement has been made.

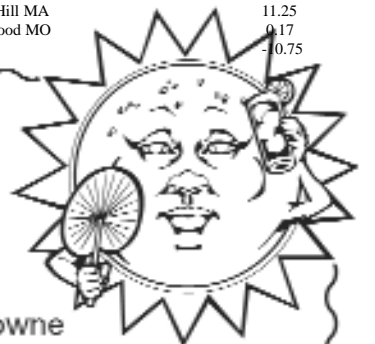

Chicago Mercantile Exchange Day

The Chicago Mercantile Exchange (CME or, simply, "The Merc") is the largest futures exchange in the United States. The CME was founded in 1898 as the Chicago Butter and Egg Board. Originally, the exchange was a not-for-profit organization. The exchange demutualized in Nov. 2000, and went public in Dec. 2002, becoming the first United States exchange to do so. CME has four major product areas: short term interest rates, stock market indexes, foreign exchange, and commodities. CME has the largest options and futures contracts open interest (number of contracts outstanding) of any futures exchange in the world, which indicates a very high liquidity. This is vital to the success of any stock or futures exchange.
