**DISTRICT 15 STaC CONDITIONS OF CONTEST**  
**SANCTION NUMBER ST0911065**  
**November 2-8, 2009**

1). All games will be stratified. Strata are:

- A - 1500+
- B - 300 - 1500
- C - 0 - 300

2). Clubs may hold a ONE or TWO SESSION SWISS TEAM EVENT and may, at the local director's discretion, use the above strata or adjust the strata to achieve three teams in the lowest strata.

3). GAMES MUST HAVE THREE (3) TABLES TO QUALIFY FOR DISTRICT OVERALL RANKING.

4). District wide hand records will not be used.

5). We encourage invitational games to open their sessions for this event. Restricted games will be scored as side games. We also encourage clubs to add sessions at any time during the STaC that do not conflict with established games in the area.

6). STaC GAME SETUP.

- Set up as usual until you get to Event Rating.
- Choose Option (9) the Sectional Tournaments at Clubs for game rating
- Associate with a club by putting in your club number.
- Enter the number of strats for your game (3) and enter the strat limits for the tournament.
- Choose proper event restrictions. For the open pairs, the correct number will be 0.
- Enter the number of sessions. This will be one unless you are playing a two-session swiss.
- Designate this event as a Multi-Site event.
- Enter the tournament Data.

Use the sanction number above.

Enter the Event Code from the list below.

The Event Codes you are to use are as follows:

The first two digits are the number of the session in which your club is sanctioned. The last two are for clubs entered in the stratified open pairs.

If your game is a limited or invitational game then, for the last two digits, enter IP for invitational events, LP for events with an upper masterpoint limit, T1 for a one session swiss, and T2 for a two session swiss. If you are running any other types of games, enter XX for the last two digits. In cases of doubt, feel free to call Mike Flader at 651 895-9395.

7). Game results must be e-mailed to the Director in Charge, Mike Flader, e-mail [jillandmikel23@comcast.net](mailto:jillandmikel23@comcast.net) within 24 hours of game end, 12 hours for the final session of the STaC. Put the following information in the subject line of your e-mail: Your club name, your club sanction number, and the file name. For example: Jim's DBC, 987654, 091102M. This will greatly assist the DIC to put your game in the proper session and speed the process of posting and accuracy of the results. Failure to report will result in your game being ranked separately as a side game and reduced masterpoint awards for your players. After your game is completed, make a backup copy of the game file and send a copy of that backup copy to the DIC.

If you use ACBLSCOR, you may use the BACK command to backup your game file. Save it to your root directory(c:\). The file will have a 0911xx.acm, 0911xx.aca, or 0911xx.ace filename where xx will be the session number of your game. Attach it to the email and send to Mike. If you have yet to enter the computer age, you may call Mike with your results. Make sure you have a copy of the short press in front of you so that you can give him all the necessary information. This includes the ACBL number for all participants who won masterpoints in your game and their percentage score. He will also need names of all non-members participating. Results and schedule will be posted on the WEB at the following address: [www.acbl15.com](http://www.acbl15.com). The results and hand records (if used) will be available on ACBL's web site.

8). Some type of profit will be returned to the Unit as designated by the District 15 Board. A payment of 7.00 per table is due within 24 hours of the conclusion of the last session in which your club participates. Failure to remit the fees in a timely basis may result in your game's being disqualified from overall ranking. Send a check for \$7 per table made out to John E.
