

Hi:

My name is Henry Cukoff and I will be the director of the District 1 November (16th – 22nd) STAC.

For this STAC we will be using the following Stratification limits for open pairs and for 299er events.

| <u>Open Games</u> | <u>299er Games</u> |
|-------------------|--------------------|
| A: 1000+ | A: 100 – 300 |
| B: 300 – 1000 | B: 50 – 100 |
| C: 0 – 300 | C: 0 – 50 |

For Swiss Team events or other Novice Pair events you may use any stratification you wish. Swiss team events are ranked separately. Other like I/N events will be combined. Invitational clubs use the same limit as open games and will be combined with other invitational clubs

Reporting the game:

- a) The sanction number for the STAC is **ST0911102**
- b) For pair games' event codes please to the following:
 - 01OP is the code for Monday morning
 - 02OP is for Monday afternoon
 - 03OP is for Monday evening, etc. through
 - 21OP Sunday evening

For 299er pairs, it is the same except add the letters LP instead of OP. For invitational games use IP.

- c) For Swiss Teams use the session number and add T1 for a 1 session team game and T2 for a 2 session one.
- d) For all other events simply use the session number and add an X.

As soon as you can after your sessions is finished (and no later than 24 hours after) please send me the ACBLscor Game file. Simply attach it to an e-mail and send it to myraandhenry@aol.com,
