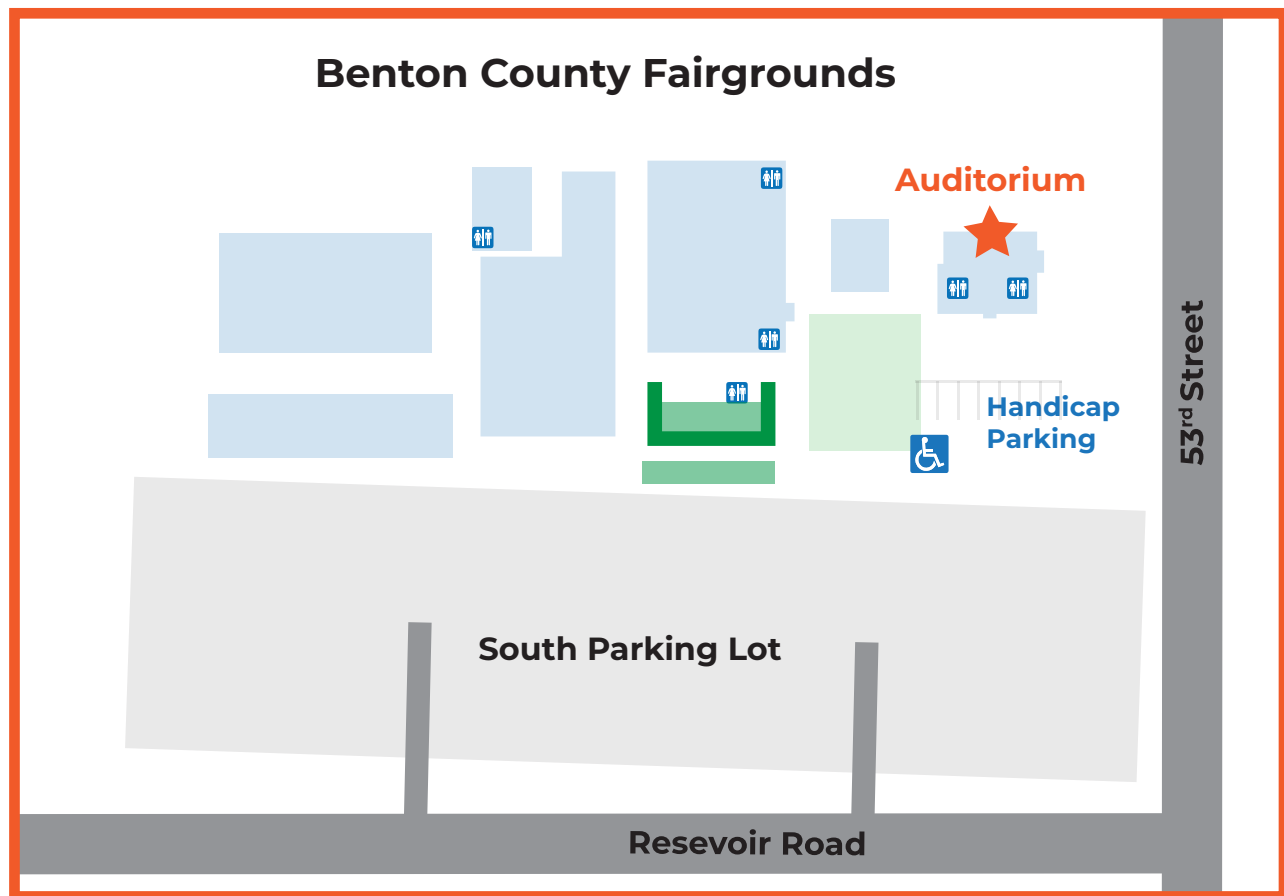

Directions to Benton Co. Fairgrounds on back



110 SW 53rd St, Corvallis, OR 97333

The Fairgrounds is easy to find - in fact we suggest you DON'T USE YOUR GPS because that may send you down Campus Way which is a limited vehicular access road owned by Oregon State University.

From I-5 (north or south) there is ONLY ONE Corvallis Exit (Exit 228). When you take the exit from I-5, head WEST toward Corvallis (not east toward Lebanon) on Highway 34/20 for approximately 11 miles from I-5. When you cross over the bridge and enter Corvallis, the road becomes Harrison Blvd. Stay on Harrison Blvd for approximately 5 miles through Corvallis to 53rd Street. Turn left at 53rd Street. The Fairgrounds will be on your left in less than a quarter mile.

To avoid driving through town, turn left onto the Hwy. 34/20 bypass before you cross the Willamette River bridge. Follow the bypass for approximately 3 miles to 53rd St. and turn right. From there, the Fairgrounds is approximately a mile and will be on your left. This route has a traffic circle and dips under a train trestle.

From Highway 99W (from the south): Hwy 99W becomes 3rd St. in Corvallis. Just before entering the downtown, you will cross over the Marys River Bridge and under the Hwy. 34/20 bypass. Get into the left lane and take the first left at SW Avenue B. Turn left 1 block later onto 4th St. Get into the right lane, which will take you onto the Hwy. 34/20 bypass. Follow that until you get to 53rd St. and turn right. From there the Fairgrounds is approximately a mile and will be on your left. This route has a traffic circle Western Blvd. and dips under a train trestle.

From Highway 99W (from the north): As you enter Corvallis, turn right at Walnut Blvd. Follow Walnut Blvd for 4.6 miles (it will curve to the left). The Fairgrounds will be on your right.
