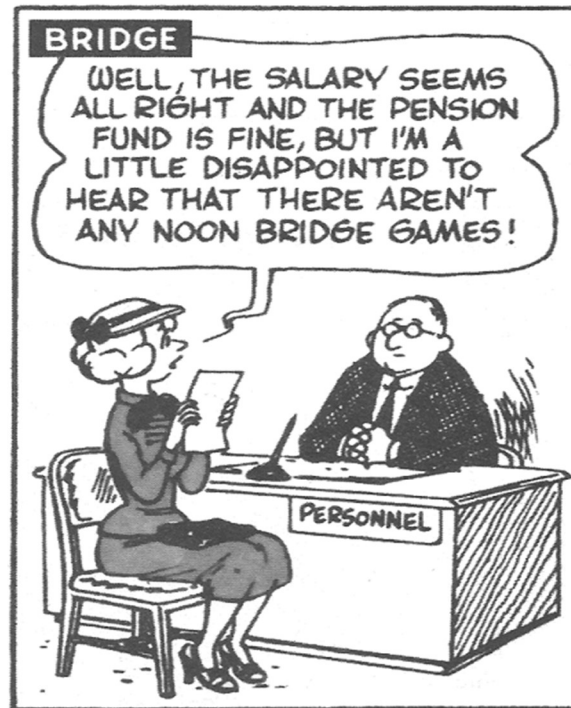
Travel Directions
