

ACBL Bridge Connect (Updated Find a Teacher)

In order to facilitate players finding classes (and teachers) to begin or continue learning bridge, the ACBL has added filters to the search options for the Find a Teacher Database. Prospective students can now filter search results by:

- Student Experience Level
- Lesson Type
- Online/ In Person

One of the biggest changes is the ability to include specific information about your classes. The initial search results listing now has a column for schedule and if a teacher has provided any details an eye (👁) icon appears so students can quickly see what you are offering.

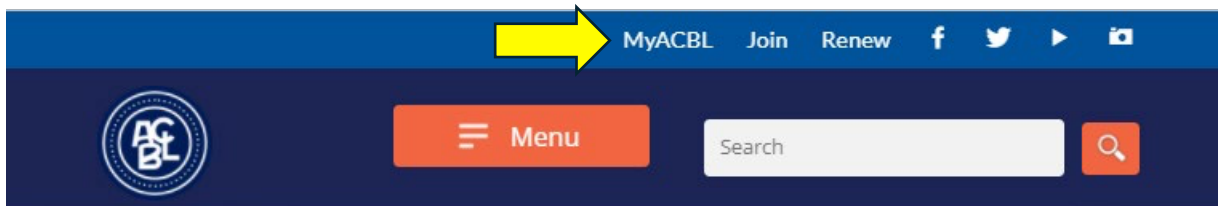

STEP 1

- Go to www.acbl.org
- Click My ACBL.



STEP 2

- Login with your ACBL Member # and password.
- Click SUBMIT.
- Please use “Forgot Password?” if you don’t remember it, or “Register” if you do not have a password.

STEP 3

Under “MY ACBL” on the left side of screen, scroll down and click on “Teacher Registration.”

You can also upload a photo which is optional but recommended.

Information at the top will auto-populate from your Member Profile.

If you do not want your email or phone listed or you want to use a different one – edit those fields.

“Details” is where you put your teacher bio.

Tick all boxes that apply for Level, Type, and Location.

Class Schedule is where you should list details on upcoming classes.

Teachers who provide this information will have an  icon on their listing that allows students to quickly preview.

If you wish to list a second teaching location, click the check box, and enter information.

If this is a new Profile, click CREATE PROFILE.

After clicking CREATE the form will close – go back to ‘Teacher Profile’ on your MYACBL sidebar and click to open your profile – now you will see the option to set it to ‘Visible’ (just under Member #).

If you are updating an existing profile – make sure it is set to ‘Visible’ and you must scroll to the bottom and click SUBMIT for it to save.
