Noticed via Email on January 29, 2023

An email notice was sent to the Full Board by President Joann Glasson on Monday, January 29, at 11:19 a.m. ET requesting that all Board members vote by email on three items:

1. New Event for Fall 2023 NABC (23E1-01) – Permitting the addition of a 0-6000 four-session NABC Pair event to the final weekend of the Fall 223 NABC in Atlanta. This is proposed by the Competitions and Conventions Committee and will be only for this one NABC on an experimental basis and will be evaluated by C&C at the conclusion of the event.
2. Expanding the use of Multi 2D (23E1-02) – Allowing the use of the Multi 2D convention showing a preempt in either major in the Platinum Pairs and the Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams. Current regulations allow this convention only in NABC+ team events of more than six boards.
3. Membership Retention (23E1-03) – Awarding of small fractions of Masterpoints to 0-5 players who play in “Just Declare” Daylong Games on BBO. This motion allows BBO to go forward with their programming for these games, with specific details to be worked out later.

In order for an email vote to be valid, according to New York State law, voting in favor of what is being proposed must be unanimous.
