**We play the following methods that may require advance preparation:**

2NT opening = unusual for minors (6-11, 5+/5+)  
Opposite a 10-12 NT opening, bids of 2D thru 3C are relays to the next suit--not necessarily transfers--bidding on after relay is completed shows other hand types

**Our general bidding style is:**

Precision, 5 card Majors, 10-12 NT 1/2 NV, 14-16 3/4 NV and all vul  
We tend to open all 10-counts when in a "10-12" seat, but relatively sound otherwise

**Our defensive signaling philosophy is:**

Our carding is "standard"--high encourage, low discourage. Count is on a "need to know" basis. Suit preference is generally a higher priority than count

**Our leads are:**

Vs NT, 4th best, with many exceptions: Will tend to lead top or 2nd from bad four-card holdings. Honor leads are Rusinow on opening lead, std thereafter (no Rusinow in partner's bid suit or at 5-level or higher)

Vs suit contracts, 3rd & low. Honor leads are Rusinow on opening lead, std thereafter (no Rusinow in partner's bid suit or at 5-level or higher)
