

Club Manager Meeting for June 13 (Face-to-Face Focus)

Setting up a NAP game

NAP is stratified by HIGHEST player, not by average. *(For NAP purposes, a player's masterpoints are determined by the total according to the May 6, 2023 masterpoint update.)*

NAP games have exactly 3 legal upper limits: Open, or 2500, or 500 NLM.

- If you have a Flight A Open, the only other possible strata are 2500 and 500.
- If you have Flight B 2500 game, the second stratum MUST BE 500, and you may add any lower stratum below that if you wish. ("Qs" will not be issued for anything that isn't OPEN or 2500 or 500 NLM.)
- If you have a Flight C 500 NLM game, you may add any lower strata below that if you wish. ("Qs" will not be issued for anything that isn't OPEN or 2500 or 500 NLM.)

WHEN YOU USE ACBLSCORE, IT WILL SUGGEST THE CORRECT STRATA.
ACCEPT THE DEFAULTS.

Any illegally stratified games will be sent back to you for correction and re-posting.

Additional NAP Details

If you hold an NAP game online, you cannot choose the strata. Please ensure your upper limits adhere to the NAP rules, and we will re-stratify your game after the fact, according to the NAP rules.

For VACB games, use +nap+ to rate the game correctly. There are no robots allowed as partners in the game.

VACBs must remember not to try an NAP game during a Virtual Club global special event. The NAP hack will not work on Longest day weekend in June, or during Silver Linings week in August. And if the [schedule](#) is amended at any point to include other like events, do not attempt to hold an NAP game on any of those days.

For each platform, you may hold two NAP games per sanctioned session in each of the months June, July and August.

There will be NO MINI-SESSIONS allowed where both are NAP games. Keep the NAPs out of the mini-sessions, please.

For both platforms, there will be an automatic charge of \$5.10/table (instead of the usual \$1.10/table) for all NAP club games.

We have been fielding some games uploaded with illegal game ratings for the month in which they're held. We will send any illegally-rated games back to you and have you re-rate them, so please be vigilant.

Don't forget to register for ACBL-wide Summer Instant Matchpoint Game (using digital materials only), on July 10, 2023. Do this soon and advertise it to your players.
